

# 2006 *Terps* Football Ticket Information

Maryland's home slate expands to 7 games in 2006 as the Terps welcome ACC rivals **MIAMI**, **FLORIDA STATE**, **NC STATE**, WAKE FOREST, plus non-conference foes **FLORIDA INTERNATIONAL**, **MIDDLE TENNESSEE** and **WILLIAM & MARY** to Byrd Stadium. Overall, the 2006 schedule features contests against 8 bowl teams from last season.

Maryland concluded 2005 with a record 32,000 football season ticket holders and averaged an all-time high of 52,426 fans per game. Only 3,000 season tickets remain available for purchase before Byrd Stadium is SOLD OUT.

<sup>1</sup> ACC game times are determined by the league's TV partners: ABC, ESPN, ESPN2, ESPNU and Jefferson-Pilot. Games may be selected for broadcast up to 12 days prior to game day (and the 12-day window is dropped to only a 6-day window a few times each season). Maryland generally schedules early season home games at 6:00 PM due to warmer temperatures, Homecoming at 1:00 PM for the University, and late season home games at 1:00 PM due to cooler temperatures and loss of daylight. Fan feedback over multiple seasons has communicated the following: night games are generally popular for (1) students and (2) parents who must often juggle youth football, youth soccer, and other activities with their children. Day games are generally popular for (1) fans who travel greater distances (NY, NJ, PA, VA, WV, NC, eastern and western MD) and (2) our older patrons -- these two groups of fans have consistently communicated their dislike of long-distance drives home late at night. Day games also help to avoid the inevitable weather deterioration that occurs each November. However, television selections override other considerations.

### Renewing Football Season Tickets

- (1) **The deadline to renew football season tickets is June 1, 2006 (postmarked).**
- (2) Hardcopy season ticket renewal forms will be mailed on or about March 1, 2006 and customers may also renew season tickets online at [www.umterps.com](http://www.umterps.com).

### Ordering New Football Season Tickets

- (1) General Public may purchase new season tickets in all general public seating areas of Byrd Stadium on a first-come, first-served basis, while supplies last.
- (2) Terrapin Club members who order new season tickets prior to June 1, 2006 will have their seats assigned in Terpoint priority order in the best available seat location for which their membership level qualifies (see 2006 Byrd Stadium Seating Map) after all season ticket renewals have been processed (by June 30, 2006).
- (3) Terrapin Club members who purchase new season tickets after June 1, 2006 will be assigned by date of order in the best available seat locations for which their membership level qualifies (see 2006 Byrd Stadium Seating Map).

### Season Ticket Holder Benefits

- (1) Same preferred seat location for entire season.
- (2) Priority consideration for purchase of Bowl Game tickets.
- (3) Priority consideration for purchase of single-game Football tickets.
- (4) Priority consideration for purchase of single-game Men's Basketball tickets.
- (5) Terrapin Club members earn Terpoints for status as a season ticket holder.
- (6) Additional ticket discount specials (Women's Basketball, Olympic sports, etc.).

## Ordering Single Game Tickets and Mini-Paks

### **Pre-Orders for Terrapin Club Members and 2006 Football Season Ticket Holders**

- (1) Only Terrapin Club Members and 2006 Football Season Ticket Holders may Pre-Order Single Game Tickets and Mini-Paks.
- (2) **The deadline to Pre-Order Single Game Tickets and Mini-Paks is *June 30, 2006* (postmarked).**
- (3) **Pre-Orders for Single Game Tickets and Mini-Paks are NOT GUARANTEED and if tickets remain available, will be assigned by July 21, 2006 in priority order (see below chart).**
- (4) **Customers will be charged upon placing their Pre-Orders and will receive a refund for any Pre-Orders that cannot be fulfilled by July 21, 2006.**
- (5) All Pre-Orders are limited to 25 Single Game Tickets or Mini-Paks per game, per account.
- (6) Customers who Pre-Order more than their priority limit (see below chart) will have their Pre-Order split, unless they request that all seats be assigned on a non-priority basis.

### **Purchases by General Public**

If tickets remain available, Single Game Tickets and Mini-Paks will go on sale to the General Public on **Monday, July 31, 2006** and will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis in the best available seating locations, while supplies last.

## Additional Single Game Ticket Information

### **(1) Group Ticket Purchases**

Single Game Ticket orders of between 15 and 25 tickets qualify for the Group discount of \$25 per ticket. Group orders are limited to a maximum of 25 tickets per game, per account. The Group discount does not apply to Mini-Paks.

### **(2) Location of Group Tickets**

All Group tickets will be assigned in the General Public and General Public Discount sections of the 300-level or the General Public Discount sections of the lower-bowl, based on availability (see 2006 Byrd Stadium Seating Map).

### **(3) Group Seating Requests**

The Terrapin Ticket Office will make every effort to honor group-seating requests, but cannot guarantee that all groups will be seated together. Customers are reminded that each member of a group must request to be seated together for the request to be considered.

### **(4) Away Game Tickets**

Maryland receives a sizeable allotment of tickets for each away football game. For most games, Maryland fans can purchase as many away game tickets as they desire. Should demand exceed supply for any away game, tickets will be assigned in the following priority order: (a) Terrapin Club members in Terpoint priority order, (b) Season Ticket Holders by date of order and (c) General Public by date of order.
