HEAD LACROSSE COACH AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND, HE LED THE TERPS TO BACK TO BACK ACC CHAMPIONSHIPS IN 2004 AND 2005. THE TERPS FINISHED THEIR 2009 SEASON RANKED 5<sup>TH</sup> IN THE COUNTRY. ## PHILOSOPHY

DAVE COTTLE'S LACROSSE CAMP IS A TEACHING CAMP DESIGNED TO MAKE YOU A BETTER PLAYER. WE WILL NOT ONLY WORK ON YOUR CURRENT SKILLS BUT WILL INTRODUCE YOU TO THE SAME TECHNIQUES WE TEACH OUR OWN PLAYERS HERE AT MARYLAND. CAMPERS ARE ORGANIZED WITH RESPECT TO AGE AND ABILITY. ## TRANSPORTATION

WE PROVIDE TRANSPORTATION FROM BALTIMORE-WASHINGTON INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT TO AND FROM CAMP AT A COST OF \$40 PER CAMPER. A ROUND TRIP OPTION IS ALL THAT IS AVAILABLE. ON THE FIRST DAY THE BUS WILL LEAVE THE AIRPORT WITH TIME TO ALLOW YOUR SON TO CHECK-IN AND SETTLE INTO HIS ROOM BEFORE THE FIRST SESSION. ON THE LAST DAY OF CAMP, ALL CAMPERS WHO REQUIRE THE BUS WILL MEET IT OUTSIDE THE DORMITORY. AS YOU MAKE TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS PLEASE DO NOT SCHEDULE AN ARRIVING FLIGHT ANY LATER THAN 10:00 AM OR A DEPARTING FLIGHT ANY EARLIER THAN 12:00 NOON.

## HOUSING

ALL CAMP ACTIVITIES WILL BE CONDUCTED ON THE CAMPUS, NO ONE IS ALLOWED TO LEAVE CAMPUS GROUNDS. ROOMMATE REQUESTS WILL BE HONORED WHENEVER POSSIBLE.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

EACH CAMPER MUST BRING HIS OWN STICK, HELMET, GLOVES, PADS, SNEAKERS, CLEATS, AND MOUTHGARD. IN ADDITION, SHEETS, PILLOW, TOWELS, TOILETRIES, SNACKS, AND EXTRA BEVERAGES ARE ALSO ITEMS A CAMPER SHOULD BRING FOR THEMSELVES. FANS ARE HIGHLY RECOMMENDED AS NOT ALL OF THE DORMITORIES ON CAMPUS HAVE AIR CONDITIONING IN THE ROOMS.

ALL CAMPERS MUST REMAIN ON THE CAMPUS AT ALL TIMES. IF A CAMPER MUST BE REMOVED FROM CAMP BY THEIR PARENTS OR A DESIGNATED GUARDIAN A NOTE MUST BE SENT TO THE CAMP OR HANDED IN BY THE CAMPER AT CHECK IN.

ALL CAMPERS WHO ENROLL WILL BE REQUIRED TO ATTEND ALL SESSIONS AND COMPLY WITH THE RULES OF THE CAMP AND CONDUCT OF THE PARTICIPANTS, WHICH ARE POSTED BY COACH SLAFKOSKY ON ALL FLOORS OF THE DORMITORY. ANY VIOLATION OR ABUSES OF THE RULES WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE DISMISSAL FROM CAMP WITHOUT A REFUND.

IF YOUR SON IS INJURED PRIOR TO HIS ARRIVAL AT CAMP, ONCE MEDICAL DOCUMENTATION IS PROVIDED A REFUND IS POSSIBLE MINUS THE DEPOSIT PRIOR TO 6.1.2010.

AFTER RECEIVING YOUR DEPOSIT AND PRIOR TO THE START OF CAMP, THE CAMP WILL MAIL YOU A PACKET WITH DIRECTIONS, CAMP SCHEDULE, CHECK-IN/OUT LOCATION, WHAT TO BRING LIST, AND ANY OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION.
