#### Tiger Baseball at UAB for Second Consecutive C-USA Weekend on the Road

After dropping a pair of midweek contests to Murray State, the University of Memphis baseball team will jump back into Conference USA play where it looks to make it three straight weekend series wins. The Tigers will make their second trip to Birmingham, Ala., this time to take on UAB in a three-game league set. With UAB currently sitting in fourth place, and Memphis in fifth in the C-USA standings, this series could be a pivotal one for the Tigers, who play three of the final four league series at home.

#### Tiger Tales

At 19-14 on the year, the 20th win has eluded Memphis after the Tigers ran off five straight wins over No. 29 Southern Miss and No. 21 Tulane. Since then, the U of M has been bested in three straight games. Despite the three-game losing skid, the Tigers are just a game behind its 2006 pace at this point in the year, as they chase the program's first NCAA Regional bid since 1994.

Memphis rides the strength of Michael Murray's team-best .347 batting average. Murray, who has started in all 33 games, leads the team in hits and is tied with K.K. Chalmers with nine doubles. Bill Moss checks in with a .342 average and nine homers, while fellow senior Joey Lieberman has five round-trippers and leads the team with 32 RBI. Chalmers is the league's leader in stolen bases with 19 inn 22 attempts. The junior hits .312 and has started in all 33 games.

#### Scouting the Blazers

UAB has swung the bats well this year, posting a team average of .300. The Blazers average 6.5 runs per contest. J.R. Bond leads a pack of five Blazers hitting over .330. Bond hits .376 and paced the UAB offense with 73 total bases, 47 hits and 11 doubles. He is tied with Ryne Lovdahl and Steven Turner with three homers. Lovdahl hits at a .367 clip and has driven in a team-best 32 runs. Brint Hardy is a perfect 11-for-11 in stolen bases.

On the hill, Mitch Kloskowski leads the staff with a 4-2 record, a 3.67 ERA, 49 innings pitched and 27 strikeouts. He holds opponents to a .230 clip at the plate in eight starts. Memphis Harding Academy product Shay Crawford is 3-2 with eight starts. He has logged a 4.36 ERA and 18 strikeouts.

#### All-Time Series vs. UAB

UAB leads the all-time series 35-26. The two schools split four games last year. UAB took two of three at Memphis in the regular season series, but the Tigers bounced back and eliminated the Blazers with a seven-inning 13-2 win in the Conference USA Tournament. Since 1996, UAB has won eight C-USA sets, including all five leagues series played in Birmingham.

## Birmingham Part II

This weekend's trip to Birmingham is the second of the year for the Tigers. However, Memphis hopes this time the road is more fortunate. The Tigers first trip to Birmingham resulted in a pair of lackluster losses (1-2; 0-1) at Samford on March 6-7. Despite Tiger pitching holding the Bulldogs to just three runs in the series, the Memphis offense was nonexistent, scoring just one run in 18 innings of play, including being shut out for the first time in over a year.

## Tigers on the Road

The road has been unkind to the Tigers in 2007. At 19-14, Memphis is just 3-12 on the road. In those contests, the U of M is batting .281 and has been outscored 120-84.

## Friday Night Lights

Over the past two seasons, Friday night's result has revealed the series outcome for Memphis. The Tigers are 13-4 in series openers, but ironically those four Friday night losses have all ended in sweeps. Memphis lost the series openers vs. Troy, Rice and Houston last year, and began the 2007 C-USA season with a Friday night loss at East Carolina. They were swept in all four series.

## Hold The Line

Tuesday's loss to Murray State marked the third time in 12 games that Memphis had squandered a lead of five or more runs. Ironically, all three of the lost leads have come on the road where Memphis is a dismal 3-12. Here is a look:

## Closing in on a Little History

Senior shortstop Michael Murray went 1-for-3 Wednesday night to extend his career-long hit streak to 19 games. Murray, who is 32-for-68 (.471) with 22 runs scored and seven doubles in the streak, has seen his average jump 162 points since the string started against Illinois State back on March 14. Murray is just four games shy of Memphis' all-time longest hit streak of 23 straight games set by Mark Little in the 1994 season.

## Murray Named C-USA Hitter of the Week

For the second consecutive week and third time this year, a Memphis hitter took home the Conference USA Hitter of the Week honor. Last week it was Bill Moss, this week it is senior Michael Murray that takes home the accolades after a near-perfect weekend at No. 21 Tulane. A native of Baton Rouge, La., Murray went 9-for-11 and led Memphis to its first C-USA series win over the Green Wave since 1996. Murray is the fourth Tiger to earn C-USA weekly honors this year.

## Wake Up that Sleeping Giant

Memphis' offense has gotten things going after struggling through the first 13 games of competition. The Tigers, who at one point were dead last in the league in hitting, have crept into the middle of the league with a .287 clip. Memphis hit just .233 through the first 13 games, but since has batted a combined .320 with 149 RBI, 42 doubles and 21 home runs.

He is now just three games shy of Memphis' consecutive games record of 149 straight, made by Mike Dlugach from 1970-73. In his career, Chalmers has played centerfield, third base, second base and pitcher.

## 2-2 Going for 3

Chalmers is also approaching another impressive career record at Memphis. Chalmers legged out his 11th career triple versus Middle Tennessee to move into a four-way tie for second on the Tiger's all-time list. He is now just two triples shy of the all-time record of 13 set by former Tiger Cary Fenton in the 1993-94 seasons.

## Winnin' 'Em Late

In eight of its 19 wins this year, Memphis has waited til the final at-bat to clinch victory. The Tigers, who have seven comeback wins, are 7-2 in one-run games, with four of the five wins coming the final inning. Here is a look at how the Tigers have won the close ones.

### Captain Kirk

Junior catcher Chris Kirkland has swung one the hottest bat in the Tigers lineup in the 20 contests. Since starting the season going hitless in the first five contests, Kirkland has hit .348 batting average. In the 20-game stretch, Kirkland has a .417 batting average to go with 13 RBI and three homers. The junior from Knoxville, Tenn. used a 10-game hit streak to boost his average up to as high as .370. In the streak, that ended on March 7, Kirkland batted .567 (17-for-30), with 14 runs scored and seven RBI.

### Long Time Coming

After a year of action, senior rightfielder Josh Irvin finally got on the home run board. Irvin hit his first Division I homer in the last game vs. Middle Tennessee. Irvin's towering blast came in his 119th career DI at-bat.

• Adam Amar got on the HR board in last week's series at Tulane. The Preseason All-American hit his first homer of the season on his 100th at-bat.

### Moss Rated as one of Country's top middle infielders

Senior second baseman Bill Moss has proven his worth in the Tiger lineup and now has received national recognition as rivals.com has tabbed him as one of the top middle infielders in the nation. Moss leads Memphis and Conference USA with a career-high nine home runs. The Germantown, Tenn. native is second on the Tigers roster in batting average (.342), hits (42), home runs (8) and RBI (31).

### Tigers vs. Top-30

Memphis' series at #21 Tulane marked the 11th, 12th and 13th times the Tigers will have faced a Top-30 team. The 22nd-ranked Pirates swept the Tigers in the opening C-USA series of the year, but Memphis evened the slate with a sweep of No. 30 Southern Miss last weekend. U of M is now 6-7 versus ranked teams this year. The Tigers' defeated #6 Clemson 6-4 in 10 innings. The last time Memphis had beaten a team ranked in the Top-10 was in 2003 when the Tigers used a 10th-inning walk-off homer to edge No. 9 Mississippi State.

### The Cruiser Steals the Show

With his steal of second base in the fifth inning of Wednesday's game versus Illinois State, junior K.K. Chalmers became Memphis baseball's all-time stolen base leader. Chalmers, who tied the single season stolen base record with 39 a year ago, swiped his 67th career base to surpass former record holder Tim Dulin. Dulin stole 66 bases from 1982-85.

### Moss Ties Single Game RBI Mark

Senior Bill Moss accomplished a feat that only three other Tiger players have ever accomplished in Wednesday's game against Illinois State. Moss went 2-for-4 with two homer runs to join the likes of Bill Dowdle, Collins Day and Dan Uggla as the only Memphis players to ever drive in nine runs in a single game. Both of Moss' homers were three-run shots. The senior added a sac fly, an RBI groundout and was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded to tie for the program record. Moss produced RBI's in each of his final five plate appearances. The two-home run outing was his first since his first collegiate game in 2003.

win against Northern Iowa. That win marked Schoenrock's 50th win since taking over the program in the Summer of 2004. The third-year coach won just 13 games in his first season, but led Memphis to one of the nation's top improvements with 32 wins a year ago.

### Power Outage

After banging out 10 home runs in 2006, senior Will Petersen has yet to get on the HR board this year in a team-high 133 at-bats. The Tiger leftfielder stroked 22 doubles last year and has just six in 2007.

### Amar's Resurgence

After getting off to a slow start to the 2007 season, senior All-American Adam Amar has picked up the pace since the beginning of the Conference USA season. Amar, who is hitting .455 in league play, is hitting .444 (20-for-45) in the last 13 games. He currently working on an eight game hitting streak.

### Amar Tabbed Pre-Season All-American

After a breakout junior campaign in 2006, the preseason recognition has begun to roll in for University of Memphis first baseman Adam Amar. Amar was named an National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) Pre-season Third Team All-American, as well as receiving recognition as a preseason candidate for the College Baseball Foundation's Brooks Wallace Award--the CBF's College Baseball Player of the Year Award. He becomes the first baseball All-American pick since former Tigers standout and current Florida Marlins All-Star Dan Uggla in 2001. A First Team All-C-USA performer in 2006, the 6-4 first baseman led the Tigers and Conference USA, as well as ranking 33rd nationally with a .395 batting average. His .459 in C-USA play is the third-highest conference average ever.

### Wow! What a Turnaround

After going 13-42 in 2005, Schoenrock guided Memphis to a 32-28 regular-season finish. The 19-game turnaround tied for second-best in the country and tied the 2001 team's 19-game turnaround for the best improvement in Tiger baseball history. The 2001 squad went 34-24 a year after going 15-37 in 1999. Here is a look at the top turnarounds in Memphis Baseball history and the top improvements in NCAA baseball in 2006.

### Hudgens Joins Tiger baseball

After suffering three injuries that cost him three football seasons, Tiger quarterback Will Hudgens made the decision to try his hand at making the Tiger baseball team. Hudgens, an accomplished prep pitcher at Ridgeway High, has had a significant role out of the bullpen. Hudgens earned All-Metro honors in high school and toss a memorable no-hitter against Ripley as a senior. Hudgens came on in the ninth against Eastern Illinois to record the save. In 10 appearances, Hudgens is 3-0 with a 1.65 ERA and a save. He has fanned 17 in just 16.1 innings. The baseball sophomore had one the best outings by a Tiger pitcher on Wednesday as he came on in relief to toss five innings of no-hit ball to go with a team and career-high eight strikeouts against Murray State.

### Senior Leadership

Head Coach Daron Schoenrock is afforded a luxury of returning 11 seniors from the 2006 team. Six of Memphis' seven returning starters are seniors; while four of the squad's top five hurlers are back for their final season. Tiger seniors combined for 363 RBI, 104 doubles, 49 home runs and six triples in 2006.

### Tigers Face Tough Test Early

Memphis' season-opener at No. 11 Ole Miss marked just the fourth time in Memphis baseball history that the Tigers opened the season against a team that finished the previous season ranked in the Top-25. Ole Miss wrapped up the 2005 season ranked as high as 10th in the country. Memphis opened the 2006 season at Alabama, who finished the previous season ranked 20th. The Tigers got 4.2 innings of scoreless work from Marcus Davis to hand Alabama its first home shutout loss since 1995-379 games.

Memphis' offense finished 30th in the country with a .315 batting average and 27th with a program-best 130 doubles a year ago.
