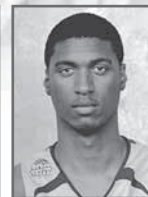

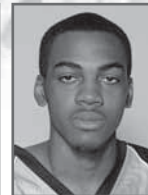

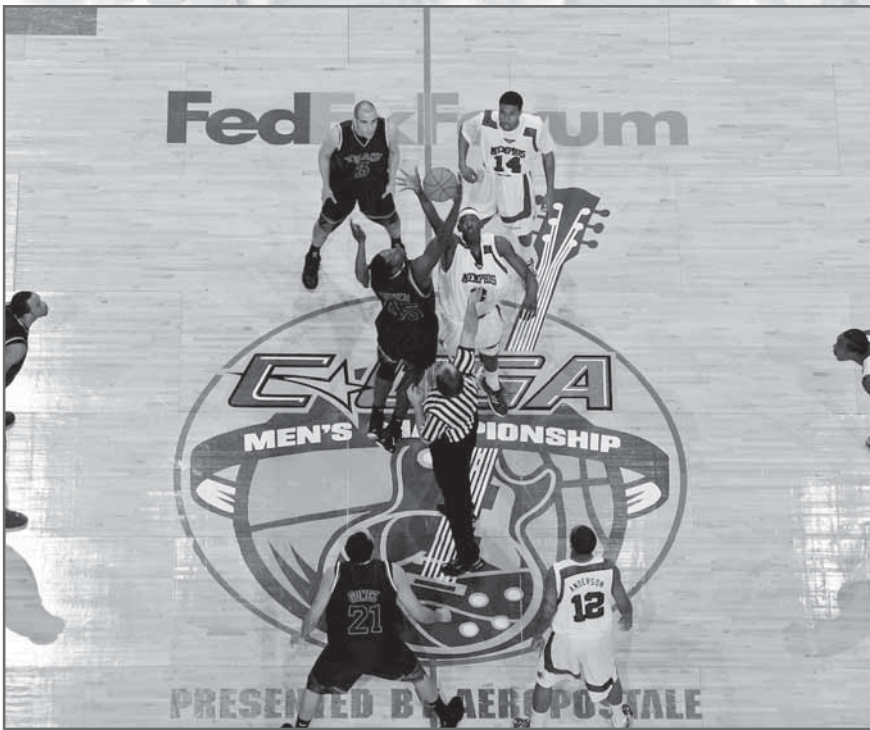

The 2008 Conference Men's Basketball Championship presented by Aéropostale is slated for Mar. 12-15 in Memphis, Tenn., at the state-of-the-art FedExForum. It is the fourth-straight year the league's postseason tournament will be held in the Bluff City.
