MEMPHIS-TULANE SERIES

Friday's Conference USA Tournament semifinal game will be the 45th overall meeting between the two schools. Memphis holds a 35-9 series advantage. The Tigers won the last encounter 95-51 on Feb. 10 of this season. That game was played in Memphis. The Tigers have won 12 straight in the overall series. In games played in the Bluff City, the Tigers hold a 21-2 lead and have won nine straight over Tulane at home.

The Tigers have met the Green Wave one previous time in the C-USA Tournament, with that meeting coming in the 2006 league postseason tournament. Memphis posted a 75-56 win over Tulane in last year's C-USA Tournament quarterfinals.

CALIPARI AMONG COACHING ELITE

John Calipari already counted himself among the coaching elite in terms of coaching wins in the first nine, 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14 years. Well, he jumped into the No. 10 spot for most coaching victories in his first 15 years with the Tigers' 111-69 victory over Jackson State Nov. 16, and has been making his move up the chart since then.

Calipari now has 365 wins, and with the Tigers' victory over Marshall Mar. 8, he moved into a tie with current Kentucky head coach Tubby Smith for the No. 5 spot. With Memphis' next win, Calipari will take sole possession of the No. 5 position.

MARCH IS WHAT'S IT'S ALL ABOUT

John Calipari's teams always improve as the season progresses toward March, which is the month all college teams play for. And, Calipari's teams are ready to play in March and that can be seen in his career record in the month.

Calipari has a 70-26 record (.729 winning percentage) in games played in March. In his previous 14 years as a collegiate head coach, Calipari has guided his teams to 13 postseasons (eight NCAA, five NIT). He led UMass to the 1996 NCAA Final Four and Memphis to the 2002 NIT championship.

STREAKING TIGERS

With Memphis' win over Gonzaga combined with Florida's loss at Vanderbilt Feb. 17, the Tigers took over the top spot on the nation's longest winning streaks list.

Entering the Conference USA Tournament semifinals, Memphis has a 20-game winning streak, which is the longest in college basketball. The following shows the nation's top-five winning streaks:

NATION'S LONGEST WIN STREAK BELONGS TO TIGERS

The Tigers did it! Three teams — Clemson, Florida and Wisconsin — before Memphis had 17-game win streaks earlier in the 2006-07 season, but failed to extend the streak to 18 straight.

With their win over UTEP Mar. 1, the Tigers extended their win streak to 18 straight. After its win over Marshall in the Conference Tournament quarterfinals on Mar. 8, Memphis' streak now stands at 20 straight.

The win streak is not only the longest current win streak, but also the longest win streak for the 2006-07 season.

MORE ON STREAKS FOR TIGERS

For the fifth time in the **John Calipari** era, the Tigers have hit double digits in a winning streak. The 2006-07 streak is at 20 straight, which ties the mark for the longest streak in Memphis basketball history.

The 2006-07 team's 20-game win streak ties the mark set by the 1985-86 squad. The current 20-game win streak is the longest for the Tigers under Calipari. The following lists the top win streaks in Tiger basketball history:

TIGERS STREAKING AT HOME

Don't look now, but the Tigers are putting together another homecourt winning streak. Memphis has a 30-game homecourt winning streak, and that is currently the second-best in the nation. BYU has the nation's longest homecourt win streak at 31 straight.

TIGER THIEVES ON THE COURT

Memo to Memphis opponents — take care of the basketball or the Tigers will take it away. The Tigers have increased their intensity on the defensive end in recent games, as the Memphis defense has forced its opponents to turn the ball over 18.9 times (265 total turnovers) in the last 14 contests (Jan. 20-Mar. 8). In fact, seven of the last 14 opponents committed 20 or more turnovers (East Carolina 24, UCF 22, UAB 20, Tulane 21, Rice 20, UTEP 21, Marshall 22).

NO. 5 BECOMES NO. 42

Senior **Jeremy Hunt** entered the Feb. 22 game versus Rice needing 16 points to reach 1,000 for his career. Well, give it up to his fellow teammates for knowing what the Memphis, Tenn., native needed to accomplish the feat. After Hunt hit a trey at the 4:53 mark to give him 15 points, the other Tigers made it a mission to get him the milestone, and a little over a minute later, Hunt scored point No. 1,000 on a free throw with 3:23 left in the game.

Hunt is the 42nd player in Tiger basketball history to accomplish the feat. He now has 1,063 career points and is in the No. 34 spot on the Memphis career scoring list. The following is an abbreviated list of the Memphis 1,000-point club:

MACK NETS CAREER HIGH VS. MARSHALL

The college basketball analysts say you need to raise your play in the postseason. Well, Tiger freshman **Doneal Mack** must have been listening. The 6-foot-5 guard netted a career-high 19 points in Memphis' win over Marshall in the Conference USA Tournament quarterfinals Mar. 8. The 19-point performance broke his previous high of 18 points that he scored against Middle Tennessee Dec. 23. The Charlotte, N.C., native hit a career-high seven field goals and tied a career best with five treys.

MACK MAKING MOST OF HIS MINUTES

Talk about making the most of your playing time. Well, **Doneal Mack** has in his freshman year at Memphis.

In his 29 game appearances, the 6-foot-5 guard has played 412 minutes and scored 217 points, which averages out to 0.53 points per minute. However, if you take it further and only look at the contests in which he scored double figures, Mack's points-per-minute (PPM) rises to 0.86.

JOEY'S DOUBLE DIGIT BOARDS EQUAL WINS FOR TIGERS

The equation may look a little funny, but it's added up to success for the Tigers the past two-plus seasons. Since arriving at Memphis, **Joey Dorsey** has hit the double-digit plateau in rebounds 34 times, and the Tigers have won 31 of those games.

The 6-foot-9 sophomore forward and the Tigers are looking to carry that trend to 2006-07. So far, so good, with Dorsey grabbing double-digit rebounds in 18 games this year. BENCH COMING UP BIG FOR TIGERS

The last two seasons (2005-06, 2006-07), **John Calipari** has been using a deep bench to wear down opponents, and in turn, keep his players fresh to finish games. It worked last season, and it seems to be doing the same in 2006-07.

In fact, this year's bench is producing more offense than last season. The 2006-07 Tiger bench is accounting for 40 percent of the offense (993 of 2484 points), while last year's bench pitched in with 28.5 percent of the offense (844 of 2961 points).

Furthermore, at least one reserve has scored in double figures in 26 of the Tigers' 31 games this year (Hunt, 24 times; Mack, eight times; Cooper, three times; Allen, two times; Willis, one time). The Tigers are 26-2 when the bench scores 20 or more points this year.
