Career

Has played in 35 contests ... Averaging 0.3 points and 0.4 boards ... Has 10 assists ... Shooting 44.4 percent from the field.

Team Accomplishments

Helped guide the Tigers to three-straight 30-win seasons and three-consecutive postseason appearances (3 NCAA) ... Team posted a combined record of 104-10 during his three seasons (.912 winning percentage) ... The 104 victories are tied for the most wins in a three-year span in NCAA Division I history (Kentucky won 104 from 1996-98) ... The 71 victories in the last two seasons (2006-07, 2007-08) are the second-most in a two year span in NCAA Division I history (Montana State won 72 from 1928-29) ... Tigers advanced to the 2008 NCAA title game and 2007 and 2006 NCAA Elite Eights ... Helped lead Memphis to a 38-2 overall record and the NCAA championship game, where the Tigers finished as national runner-up to Kansas ... The 38 wins are the most for a single season in NCAA Division I history ... Tigers climbed to the No. 1 spot in both national polls for first time since 1983 ... Memphis held on to No. 1 national ranking for a school-record five-straight weeks ... Tigers began 2007-08 season with a 26-0 record, the longest win streak and best start to a campaign in school history ... Memphis won three-straight Conference USA regular season and tournament titles (2006, 2007, 2008) ... In 2006-07 and 2007-08, Memphis posted undefeated 16-0 records in C-USA play – a first in league history ... In 2005-06 and 2006-07, Memphis posted back-to-back 33-4 overall records.

2007-08 Season (Junior)

Saw action in 14 games ... Averaged 0.6 points and 0.7 boards per contest ... Had five assists and one steal ... Shot 57.1 percent from the field ...

Postseason (NCAA/C-USA Tournaments): Played in three postseason contests ... Saw game action vs. Texas-Arlington in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament ... Played three minutes vs. Tulsa in the Conference USA Tournament championship game ... Grabbed one rebound vs. the Golden Hurricane ... Also played vs. Tulane in the C-USA Tournament quarterfinal ...

Conference USA play: Played in six Conference USA games ... Averaged 0.7 points and 0.3 rebounds in league play ... Shot 50 percent from the floor ... Played three minutes in the regular season finale vs. UAB ...

Scored two points and pulled down one rebound in the Tigers' win at Tulane ... Played a career-high tying six minutes in a home victory over SMU ... Netted two points vs. Southern Miss ... Grabbed one board in five minutes of action vs. East Carolina ...

Non-conference play (regular season games only): Saw action in five non-Conference USA games ... Pulled down a career-high tying three rebounds vs. Pepperdine ... Also tied a career high with two assists vs. the Waves ... Scored a career-high three points (1-of-2 FG, 1-of-3 FT) vs. Siena ... Grabbed a career-best three boards and also had one assist vs. the Saints ... Played a career-high six minutes vs. Siena ... Scored two points and added an assist vs. Austin Peay ... Dished out one assist vs. Arkansas State ... Had one rebound and one steal vs. Tennessee-Martin in the 2k Sports College Hoops Classic/Memphis Regional.

2006-07 Season (Sophomore)

Saw action in 10 games ... Averaged 0.1 points and 0.1 boards per contest ... Had three assists ...

Postseason (NCAA/C-USA Tournaments): Played in one postseason contest ... Saw two minutes of game action vs. Tulane in the Conference USA Tournament semifinal ...

Conference USA play: Played in five Conference USA games ... Averaged 0.2 points in league play ... Played one minute in regular season home finale vs. Houston ... Logged a season-high four minutes in a home victory over Tulane ... Netted first collegiate point on a free throw (1-of-2 FT) vs. the Green Wave ... Also recorded an assist vs. Tulane ... Saw two minutes of action in a home win over SMU ... Played three minutes

in a road victory at UCF ...

Non-conference play (regular season games only): Saw action in four non-Conference USA games vs. Middle Tennessee, Manhattan, Arkansas State and Jackson State ... Grabbed one rebound vs. Middle Tennessee ... Dished out a career-high two assists in season-opening win over Jackson State.

2005-06 Season (Freshman)

Saw action in 11 games, including four postseason contests ... Averaged 0.2 boards per contest ... Had two assists ...

Postseason (NCAA/C-USA Tournaments): Played in four of the Tigers' seven postseason contests ... Saw game time action against both Bradley (Oakland Regional semifinal) and Bucknell (second round) in the NCAA Tournament ... Played against Houston (semifinal) and Tulane (quarterfinal) in the Conference USA Tournament ...

Conference USA play: Saw action in three Conference USA games ... Grabbed one board and played a season-high three minutes in a home victory over Southern Miss ... Also played vs. Tulsa and UCF ...

Non-conference play (regular season games only): Played in four non-Conference USA games ... Recorded an assist vs. Purdue and Jackson State ... Saw first collegiate action in season opener vs. Wisconsin-Milwaukee in the NIT Season Tip-Off ... Had one rebound vs. the Panthers.

A basketball letterwinner at Dr. Phillips High School ... Helped lead the squad to a 20-7 record in 2004-05 ... Averaged 16.2 points and 6.1 assists as a senior ... As a junior, helped lead Dr. Phillips High to a 24-6 record and a spot in the Florida state tournament regional ... Team also won a district championship ... For his career, averaged 15.7 points and 5.8 assists ... Played for Coach Theo White.
