LINE CAMP

Offensive and defensive line campers will learn the basic fundamentals and techniques of line play. This instruction will take place in the classroom and on the field. Techniques that will be highlighted are:

- Tackling techniques
- Specialized strength training

SKILL CAMP

Offensive and defensive skill campers will learn the basic fundamentals and techniques of the following positions: Quarterback, Running Back, Tight End, Wide Receiver, Linebacker and Defensive Back. This instruction will take place in the classroom and on the field. Techniques that will be highlighted are:

- Catching
- Blocking
- Route running
- Pass defending skills (man/zone)
- Tackling techniques

WEIGHT PROGRAM

Each camper will be physically tested and the results will be given to each camper on the final day. Campers will receive detailed technique instruction from Memphis' Strength Coordinator, Mike Stark.

Each camper will be exposed to all the disciplines necessary to improve in the areas of passing, receiving, blocking, tackling, running and strength development. (It is our intention to blend fundamental football instruction with the newest methods designed to test, evaluate and program your physical skills as it directly relates to your position in football.)

WHERE

The camp is conducted at the Murphy Athletic Complex on the University of Memphis' South Campus. The complex is complete with four practice fields, an indoor practice facility, a state-of-the-art weight room and numerous meeting rooms.

WHO

Camp participants will consist of 2nd through rising 12th graders. Team campers will be part of their school team in camp or individual campers will be welcomed and assigned to a team.
