TOMMY WEST - The University of Memphis head football coach completed his eighth season at the helm of the Tiger football program in 2008. West, who coached the Clemson football team for seven seasons, was hired as the defensive coordinator for Memphis in December of 1999 and led his 2000 unit to a number five national ranking in total defense and the number one spot in rushing defense. West served as Clemson's head coach from 1993 through the 1998 season and led the Clemson Tigers to post season-bowl appearances four times during his tenure.

As Head Coach at the University of Memphis, Tommy West has generated new enthusiasm and excitement for the Tiger football program and long-time fans as well. Under his leadership, Memphis has played in five bowls in the last six years; the New Orleans Bowl in 2003 and 2007, the GMAC Bowl in 2004, the Motor City Bowl in 2005 and the St. Petersburg Bowl in 2008 and has placed 59 players on the All-Conference USA team in the last eight years. In addition, the University of Memphis has set attendance records at Liberty Bowl Memorial Stadium as well as numerous other records. Coach West's ninth year as Tiger Head Coach promises even greater excitement for Memphis football fans.



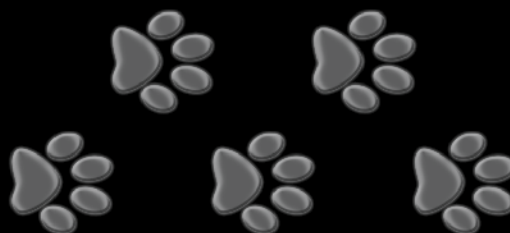
