### RESIDENCE INN INVITATIONAL

No. 9/10 Oklahoma hosts Memphis in a three-team tournament on Saturday and Sunday at the OU Softball Complex in Norman, Okla. North Texas is also competing in the tournament. Memphis will begin the invitational against North Texas on Saturday at 12:15 p.m. and will then play the tournament host at 4:45. On Sunday, Memphis plays North Texas at 11 a.m. and Oklahoma at 1:15 p.m.

### MEMPHIS vs. RESIDENCE INN INVITATIONAL FIELD

The Tigers will meet No. 9/10 Oklahoma and North Texas for the first time in the program's history. Memphis is 0-3 all-time in the state of Oklahoma with all three losses coming against C-USA foe Tulsa in 2006. Memphis is 1-6 all-time against teams from Oklahoma and 5-6 against teams from Texas.

### TIGERS AGAINST THE NATION'S BEST

Memphis will face No. 9/10 Oklahoma two times in this weekend's tournament. The Sooners are the second team Memphis has faced in the top 10 this season and third in the Top 25. Memphis lost to then No. 13/13 Florida State, 7-0, and No. 4/5 Arizona State earlier in the year. The Tigers are 0-7 all-time against top 25 teams, but the U of M beat two teams last season that later spent time on the top 25. Memphis opened the season with two wins against Missouri, who ended the year ranked No. 25. The U of M also beat South Carolina who went on to spend time in the national rankings.

### NEXT WEEK

Memphis will play seven games next week with a midweek doubleheader at Alcorn State on Tuesday, March 4, and one at home to open up the Tiger Softball Complex against Central Arkansas on Wednesday, March 5. Memphis will then open up its conference schedule with a three-game set at home against Marshall beginning on Saturday.

### LAST WEEK

Memphis finished second in its second annual Blues City Classic with a 3-1 record. The only loss was a 2-1 defeat to tournament champion Morehead State. The Tigers beat Southeast Missouri, 3-1; Alabama A&M, 6-0; and Arkansas-Pine Bluff, 16-2. Leila Dolfo, Melissa Nance and Janelle Valle were named to the all-tournament team.

### HOME RUN MEMPHIS

Memphis hit at least three home runs in two of the four games this week and has done it in four of the last six games. As a team, Memphis hit eight home runs in the four days and totals 17 on the season for a 1.3 average per game. The Tigers hit a program record four home runs against Alabama A&M with four different players going yard. The Tigers then hit three against Arkansas-Pine Bluff with all of them coming in the second inning and two being hit by junior Leila Dolfo.

### ONE BIG INNING

Memphis scored 13 runs in the second inning against Arkansas-Pine Bluff on 10 hits. Among the 10 hits were three home runs, including two by Leila Dolfo, who totaled five RBI in the inning. The 16 runs in the game ranks fourth-all time in Memphis history as do the 17 hits and 13 RBI.

### THEES INDUCTED INTO MESA MOUNTAIN VIEW HIGH HALL OF FAME

Memphis head coach Windy Thees was inducted this past year into the Mesa Mountain View High School Hall of Fame. Thees graduated from the school in 1993 after lettering in both basketball and softball.

### GUNNING THEM DOWN FROM CENTER

Senior Lindsay Kelso made the move at the beginning of the season from catcher to center field. Last season she spent the year sharing the catching duties with Kimmi Hayden, making 28 starts behind the plate. The move has already paid off with Kelso throwing a runner out at the plate against South Florida. She then prevented a run from scoring in a scoreless game against Bethune-Cookman. On a sacrifice fly opportunity, Kelso fired a ball in from center to keep the runner at third.

### WHAT SOPHOMORE SLUMP?

Sophomore Leigh Rowan began the year where she left off 2007 after being selected to the C-USA All-Freshman team. The outfielder hit two two-run homers against Florida Gulf Coast to help Memphis earn a 7-4 victory. Rowan finished 3-for-4 in the game with four RBI and led the team in the tournament with five hits.

### PITCHING ROTATION

The Tigers used four different starting pitchers in its five games in the USF Wilson Invitational. Freshman Kimber Bossom had two starts and freshmen Rayna McClinton and Janelle Valle and junior Lyndsey Sterling had one as the Tigers experiment with its three new freshman pitchers. Valle led the team with a 2.33 ERA and 1-0 record,

### TWO-SPORT STAR

Senior infielder Melissa Nance focuses for the first time this season only on softball. Nance spent the last two seasons playing both softball and volleyball. The Frankfort, Ind., native lettered four years with the Memphis volleyball team from 2003-06 where she also wore No. 10. She served as the team co-captain from 2004-06. Nance came to Memphis for the opportunity to join the softball team when it was created in 2006.

### DOLFO EARNS PRESEASON HONOR

Junior infielder Leila Dolfo was named for the second-straight year to the C-USA Preseason All-Conference team selected by the league's coaches. Dolfo earned First Team All-Conference honors last season after leading the team in nearly every offensive category.

### TIGERS PICKED TO FINISH SEVENTH

After a sixth place finish in 2007, Memphis was selected seventh in the C-USA Preseason Poll by the league's coaches. Houston, East Carolina and UCF were picked to finish first, second and third.

### AN IMPROBABLE FINISH

To those on the outside, Memphis' attempt to become one of six Conference USA teams earning a trip to the league's championship in Orlando, Fla., was over after the Tigers were swept in three games at Marshall in mid April. Memphis needed to win all six of its remaining C-USA games against UAB and UCF to earn a top six finish. One loss would eliminate the team.

But Memphis took on a playoff mentality. For six-straight games, the Tigers knew a loss would end its season and a win would keep the team alive. And the team, led by its six seniors, refused to lose.

Sweeping UAB and UCF proved to be a difficult task with all of the games decided by a run and five of the six going down as 2-1 games. Two of the games went a Memphis record 11 innings with the Tigers using walk-off hits to earn the victories.

Senior pitcher Jenna Kubesch earned five of the six victories and allowed just three runs in 35 and a third innings for a microscopic 0.59 ERA. The Memphis career leader in nearly every pitching category struck out 43 batters, while allowing only 17 hits.

### LIVE WEB AUDIO & VIDEO BROADCASTS FOR HOME GAMES:

Memphis would go on to beat Middle Tennessee three times in the season and also earned doubleheader sweeps against Belmont, Lipscomb, UT Martin. The Tigers split doubleheaders with Tennessee State and Austin Peay and fell to No. 1 Tennessee in Knoxville, 4-1, after facing the 2007 USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year, Monica Abbott.

### CONFERENCE USA CHAMPIONSHIP

As the No. 6 seed in the Conference USA Championship in Orlando, Fla., Memphis faced third seeded Tulsa in the opening game. Tulsa came into the tournament having swept the Tigers in all six previous meetings between the two schools. Senior Jenna Kubesch gave up a leadoff home run in the first inning to give Tulsa an early lead. The dinger would be the only hit Kubesch would give up in the game.

Down 1-0 in the seventh inning, the Tigers scored two runs to take the lead for the eventual victory without the benefit of a hit. Brittany Gooch scored from third on a wild pitch to tie the game. Tori Gross then brought in Christi Morrison with the game-winning run on a suicide squeeze bunt.

Later that day, Memphis squared off against second seeded East Carolina in another pitching duel. Kubesch retired the first 27-consecutive batters against the Pirates and carried a perfect game into the ninth, but the Tigers failed to score when the opportunities were given, losing 1-0 to ECU in 10 innings. The loss snapped a program record eight-game winning streak.

### MEMPHIS DEDICATES NEW STADIUM:

Although the final result of the University of Memphis and Tulsa softball game did not bode well for the Tigers, the lasting effects of the day will be felt in the program for years to come. The U of M officially dedicated its new softball complex on the school's Park Avenue Campus on April 7, 2007 before the final contest of the three-game series with Tulsa. University of Memphis President Dr. Shirley C. Raines threw out the ceremonial first pitch to sophomore Kimmi Hayden to officially open the \$1.7 million complex in front of full house.

### 100 PERCENT GRADUATION

Under head coach Windy Thees' tenure, all six of her seniors have earned their diploma and 2008 senior infielder Melissa Nance received her degree in December 2007. In addition, the Tigers have earned two CoSIDA All-District first team selections, five NFCA Scholar Athlete selections and two C-USA All-Academic team selections. In 2007, former pitching standout Jenna Kubesch earned one of 12 C-USA Postgraduate Scholarships and was the U of M's nominee for the NCAA Woman of the Year award.

### FOUR NAMED NFCA SCHOLAR ATHLETES

Memphis placed four players on the NFCA Scholar Athlete list in 2006-07. Seniors Lindsay Kelso and Melissa Nance, redshirt freshman Heather Mott and graduated pitcher Jenna Kubesch all maintained at least a 3.5 GPA during the academic year to earn the honor.

### THREE EARN ALL-CONFERENCE HONORS

Junior infielder Leila Dolfo became the first Memphis player to receive All-Conference USA first team honors in 2007. She was joined on the

### 14 GAMES IN A ROW

Kelso's streak lasted for nearly a month beginning on Feb. 25, 2007 in a 1-for-1 pinch hit effort against Evansville and ending on March 24 against Houston. The streak surpassed the previous Memphis best of nine games by Bridgette McNulty.

### LIPSCOMB GETS NANCED

Senior infielder Melissa Nance set a new Memphis single game RBI record with eight against Lipscomb in 2007. The eight RBI also ties the C-USA record. Nance hit two home runs in the game, including a grand slam. Nance had 11 RBI

and three home runs in the doubleheader. Nance hit .583 (7-for-12) on the week with three home runs, a double, four runs scored and 11 RBI. She recorded a slugging percentage of 1.417 and a .615 on-base percentage.

## WINDY THEES

Head Coach • 3rd Year • 72-56, 235-148



Left with the daunting task of starting a softball program from scratch, University of Memphis head coach Windy Thees has stepped up to the challenge. In just two seasons, Thees has built the Tigers into a winning program that

has progressively improved each year.

Now entering her third season in 2008, Memphis looks to build on its success, while competing in its first full season at the team's new \$1.7 million Tiger Softball Complex on the U of M Park Avenue Campus.

In the short two-year history of the Memphis softball program, Thees has compiled a 64-51 (.557) overall record and guided the team to its first Conference USA Championship Tournament in 2007. The Tigers finished sixth in C-USA last season with a 36-25 overall record and 10-12 in league play.

Memphis reached the league tournament in dramatic fashion in 2007 needing to win its final six conference games of the season to qualify for the event. With a postseason type mentality, Thees guided her Tigers to sweeps over UAB and UCF with all six games decided by a run and two needing walk-off scores in the 11th inning.

In the Tigers' first C-USA Championship trip, the team defeated third seeded Tulsa, 2-1, in the opening game. Despite only one hit in the game, Memphis scored two runs in the top of the seventh inning with the game-winning run coming home off a suicide squeeze bunt. The Tigers then lost a 1-0 10-inning battle to East Carolina with the Pirates breaking up a perfect game in the ninth.

Thees helped Memphis improve its win total by 29 percent in 2007, while losing one game fewer than its inaugural season totals in 2006. The Tigers' power numbers also saw an increase last season with the team finishing fourth in the league in home runs with 47, 14 more than the previous season and a 33 percent increase.

In her two seasons at Memphis, Thees' players have earned seven All-Conference awards and one NFCA All-South Region selection. This past year, Leila Dolfo earned her second All-Conference USA selection and became the first Tiger to be named to the first team. Bridgette McNulty also earned her second All-C-USA second team honor and Leigh Rowan became Thees' third player named to an All-Freshman team.

Thees' players have also found success in the classroom with all six of her seniors earning their diploma and 2008 senior Melissa Nance receiving her degree in December 2007. In addition, under Thees' tenure the Tigers have earned two CoSIDA/ESPN The Magazine All-District first team selections, five NFCA Scholar Athlete selections and two C-USA All-Academic team selections. In 2007, former pitching stand-out Jenna Kubesch earned one of 12 C-USA Postgraduate Scholarships and was the U of M's nominee for the NCAA Woman of the Year award.
