PACKET PICK-UP

- To expedite the bib pick-up process, please look up your bib number Saturday morning by <u>proceeding to the registration site by clicking here</u>. In the 'Find a Participant' box, type in your name to look up your bib number.
- If you desire to pick up the bib and tech shirt for your family member, friend, etc., you will need to come with the confirmation email. If you find yourself in need of resending the registration confirmation email, the individual who registered should simply:
 - 1. Go to runsignup.com, type in your login information
 - 2. On your "Profile" page, click the button for "My Registered Races"
 - Go to "View Registration". Under the "Registration" tab, click on the link for "Resend Confirmation E-mail"
 - 4. The confirmation email will be sent to the email address associated with that registration

Saturday, April 8 - Packet Pick-Up from 12-5pm

- We strongly encourage participants to pick up packets on Saturday from 12-5pm. All parking lots (SC4, SC5, SC6 & SC7) around Crisler Center and Michigan Stadium are available for parking.
- Join us for the Men's Lacrosse game against Ohio State in Michigan Stadium at 11am. Free admission.

Sunday, April 9 - Race Day

- Free parking is provided on a first come, first serve basis in lots SC6 & SC7 (near Crisler Center/5K start) and SC36, SC35 & SC2 (near stadium entrance/finish line).
- Once the parking lots are full, parking attendants will direct vehicles to overflow lots including other University lots and Pioneer High School.



TECH SHIRTS AND MEDALS

- 5K participants will receive tech shirts when picking up race bibs.
- Requested sizes are not guaranteed to those that registered after March 1st.
- Participants will not be able to switch sizes on-site.
- Finisher's medals will be provided to registered participants in the 5K after crossing the finish line.

STARTING GATE INFO

Runners will be asked to line up at the starting line based upon their estimated per-mile time. Those with strollers or baby joggers will be asked to start behind all runners towards the back of the start line for safety reasons.

NOTE: The race will begin promptly at 8:30am. The race starting gate will close at 8:45am and no one will be able to begin the course after 8:45am.

AWARDS

Awards will be presented to the 5K overall male and female, master (Ages 40+), grand master (Ages 50+) and senior grand master (Ages 60+) shortly after the completion of the race. These will be presented at the award table in the north end concourse.

Age group awards will be posted in the north end concourse. Participants can retrieve their awards from the Guest Services window, located next to Champions Grill. **Age group awards must be picked up on-site.**

MEDICAL/WATER

Huron Valley Ambulance will be on-site for any medical related issues that may occur. Water will be provided at the water stop mid-way through the 5K at Ingalls Mall in addition to the finish line.

SPECTATORS



Spectators can access Michigan Stadium through Gate 10, which is on the North side of the stadium. Gates will open at 8am. Spectators will be able to view the finish line from designated sections on the north side (Sections 33 and 34) of the stadium. Unfortunately, only race participants are permitted on the field but spectators will be able to see the finish line from the stands. Additionally, runners will be shown on the stadium video boards as they cross the finish line!

RACE RESULTS

Gault Race Management is returning as the official race timer in 2017. Race results for award winners will be available after 9am at the Race Results kiosk on the North concourse. No printed results will be available outside of award winners.

RACE BIBS

To help insure you will get an accurate finish time please pin race number horizontally on the OUTSIDE of any jacket or clothing on the FRONT, as close to the waist as possible. Water carriers or gel packs near the number can also affect the read. Wearing the number visibly on the front will ensure a finish time.

FINISH FESTIVAL

The Finish Festival will be held after the race in the North Concourse area of Michigan Stadium between Gates 8-10. Included will be music, awards, post-race fuel station for participants, race sponsor tents, beneficiary tents and more! Participants are invited to stop by after exiting the field.
