2009-10 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

NCAA TOURNAMENT NOTES

- Michigan has competed in 20 consecutive NCAA Tournaments -- a national record -- dating back to 1991.
 - Michigan's 33 collective NCAA Tournament appearances lead the nation. U-M had been tied with Minnesota (32).
 - During Michigan's 20-year run in the tournament it has collected at least one win 16 times. Michigan reached the Frozen Four 10 times, earning national championships in 1996 and 1998.
 - Michigan is 47-26 in the NCAA Tournament. With a record of 26-20, Coach Berenson is third all-time in wins as he trails Jerry York (33, Bowling Green and Boston College and Jack Parker (30, Boston University).
 - The Wolverines are 1-3 vs. CCHA teams in the NCAA Tournament. While still a member of the WCHA, U-M beat Bowling Green in 1977. Since joining the CCHA in 1981-82, Michigan has lost its three intra-conference meetings in overtime. U-M lost to Lake Superior State in 1994, Notre Dame in 2008 and Miami in 2010.
 - U-M is 5-10 in overtime in the NCAA Tournament. The game vs. the RedHawks was the second-longest for U-M. Michigan lost in triple overtime to Maine in 1995.
 - U-M's win over Bemidji State was its second against a CHA school in the NCAA Tournament. Michigan beat Niagara in 2008.
 - U-M NCAA Tournament statistics are on pages 14-15.
- ### CCHA TOURNAMENT NOTES
- Michigan captured its ninth CCHA Tournament championship and is 9-6 in title games. U-M's other eight championships came in 1994, 1996, 1997, 1999, 2002, 2003, 2005 and 2008.
 - Michigan became the first team seeded lower than fourth to win the CCHA Tournament. U-M entered the sweepstakes as the No. 7 seed.
 - Michigan made its 21st consecutive appearance in the CCHA semifinals. The Wolverines are 15-6 in semifinal match-ups, having advanced to the title game in nine of the last 10 years.

- The Wolverines scored 28 goals in six CCHA Tournament games. Fourteen players had goals and all 19 skaters that participated had at least one point. U-M allowed nine goals in six games.
- LOUIE CAPORUSSO, CARL HAGELIN, STEVE KAMPFER and SHAWN HUNWICK were named to the CCHA All-Tournament Team. Hunwick was the MVP; he was the ninth Wolverine to earn the Bill Beagan Award, but just the first U-M netminder.
- LOUIE CAPORUSSO led U-M with seven goals and four assists in six CCHA Tournament games.
- U-M earned a two-game sweep at Michigan State in the quarterfinal round. It was the first time U-M had posted consecutive wins in East Lansing since the calendar year of 1975 (3/1/75 and 12/6/75).
- U-M CCHA Tournament statistics are on pages 12-13.

COACH BERENSON NOTES

- Red Berenson earned career win No. 690 to take over sixth place on the NCAA Hockey All-Time Coaching Wins List with U-M's 4-0 home triumph vs. Bowling Green on Feb. 9, 2010. He passed Len Ceglarski, who coached Clarkson and Boston College from 1954-92.
- Berenson is one win shy of career victory No. 700. He heads into the 2010-11 season with a record of 699-328-69 (.669 winning percentage). He is 45 wins behind Bob Peters (North Dakota, Bemidji State) for fifth place on the all-time coaching wins list.

TEAM NOTABLES

- Michigan reached the 20-win mark for the 23rd consecutive season.
- Michigan's 26 wins ranked sixth in the country. National champion Boston College tied with Miami for the most (29).
- Michigan's seven-game winning streak from March 5-27 was the team's longest since winning nine in a row from Dec. 1, 2007-Jan. 19, 2008.
- Senior defensemen CHRIS SUMMERS and STEVE KAMPFER finished their careers on the top 25 career games played list by U-M defensemen. Summers

appeared in 163 games, tying him for sixth place with David Harlock (1990-93), Matt Hunwick (2004-07) and Rob Palmer (1974-77). Kampfper skated in 147 games, good for 22nd along with Tim Manning (1978-81) and Jay Vancik (1999-2002).

- Junior CHAD LANGLAIS heads into 2010-11 as U-M's "Iron Man" with 129 consecutive games played. He has not missed a game in his career. The longest games-played streak at U-M is 166, set by Tim Miller and Travis Turnbull in 2008-09.

- Michigan took part in its second outdoor hockey game on Feb. 6, 2010, at the Camp Randall Hockey Classic. U-M lost to Wisconsin, 3-2, in front of 55,031 fans.

- On Jan. 28, 2010, Michigan announced that it will play its third outdoor hockey game, entitled "The Big Chill at the Big House," against Michigan State at Michigan Stadium on Dec. 11, 2010.

- CHRIS BROWN was named to the CCHA All-Rookie Team and was a finalist for CCHA Rookie of the Year. In league play, he had 10 goals and 11 assists for 21 points, putting him second among freshman scorers in the CCHA. His seven power-play goals were tied for the most by any CCHA player. Overall, BROWN had 13 goals and 28 points, which rank third and fourth, respectively, on U-M's roster.

Since 1998, Michigan has had 20 players named to the CCHA All-Rookie Team. U-M has had at least one player on the team in 11 of the 13 campaigns during that span.

- Against Alaska on Jan. 16, Michigan played to overtime for the first time in 66 games. U-M was the only team in the country that did not play an overtime contest in 2008-09. It had not played to overtime since the Frozen Four semi-finals on April 10, 2008. Michigan took part in its first shootout as its game against UAF on Jan. 16 was still tied after overtime. U-M lost a 1-0 decision to the Nanooks.

OFFENSE

- U-M averaged 3.29 goals per game, which ranked 12th in the country. Michigan had been among the top five in national scoring average in five previous seasons.

- Michigan scored a season-high six goals on five occasions. The Wolverines tallied four-plus goals 20 times, including eight of the final 11 games. U-M was 20-0-0 in those games.

- The Maize and Blue scored three goals in a single period 18 times this season, including six outbursts that came in the playoffs. U-M won all 16 games in which it had a three-goal stanza.

- Michigan scored first 27 times in 45 games, posting a 23-4-0 record when doing so.

- U-M was nearly flawless when leading after 20 minutes (19-1-0). Conversely, it was 2-11-1 when trailing after the first period.

- The Wolverines have had at least one player reach the 50-point plateau in six consecutive seasons. CARL HAGELIN finished with exactly 50 points (19-31-50).

- Three Wolverines hit the 40-point bench-

mark for the third straight year. In addition to Hagelin's 50 points, LOUIE CAPORUSSO had a 21-22-43 line and MATT RUST had 13-27-40 totals.

- LOUIE CAPORUSSO reached the 20-goal mark for the second straight season. Under Coach Berenson, Michigan has had at least one 20-goal scorer on its roster in 25 of the 26 seasons he has been behind the bench. The only exception came in the 2005-06 season.

- Michigan loses 18.2% of its offense -- 24 goals and 49 assists -- with the graduation of Steve Kampfper (3-23-26), Brian Lebler (14-10-24), Chris Summers (4-12-16) and Anthony Ciraulo (0-1-1) and the early departure of Robbie Czarnik (3-3-6).

- Linemates for 39 of 45 games this season, left wing CARL HAGELIN (19-31-50) and center MATT RUST (13-27-40) rank first and third, respectively, on the U-M scoring chart. Each soared past his previous career highs for goals, assists and points. Hagelin had 13-18-31 totals in 2008-09, while Rust's best year was a 12-11-23 line in 2007-08 as a rookie.

- CARL HAGELIN had a point in 35 out of 45 games. His career-best 11-game point streak from Jan. 29-Feb. 27 was U-M's longest since Kevin Porter (16 games in 2006-07).

- Hagelin was among the nation's top 15 in points and assists. His 50 points were tied with three others for 11th place. His 31 assists were tied with two others for 12th place.

- A Hobey Baker finalist in 2008-09, LOUIE CAPORUSSO had just 5-9-14 totals in the first 20 games of the 2009-10 season. In the 23 games since Jan 1, he had 16 goals and 13 assists for 29 points, making him the most productive Wolverine in the season's second half. He finished the season as U-M's leading goal scorer (21) and second on the points list (43).

- Defenseman STEVE KAMPFER set career highs for goals, assists and points (3-23-26) as well as multi-point games (7). His assist and point totals are the most by a Wolverine defenseman since 2006-07 when Jack Johnson had 16-23-39 totals.

- CHAD LANGLAIS had five goals to lead U-M's defense corps in lamp lighters.

- KAMPFER, a senior, and LANGLAIS, a junior, are tied with each other for 23rd on the U-M defenseman career assists chart. Both have 53 helpers. Langlais has averaged 17.67 assists per year. If he keeps up that pace he will finish 12th all-time.

- In addition to Hagelin, Rust and Kampfper, six other players set career highs for points.

Sophomore wing LUKE GLENDENING set career highs for goals, assists and points (7-14-21) after posting 6-4-10 totals as a freshman.

Senior left wing BRIAN LEBLER set career highs for goals, assists and points (14-10-24) for the second season in a row. He had 9-7-16 totals as a junior.

Junior defenseman TRISTIN LLEWELLYN set career highs for goals, assists and points (2-6-8). He had one goal in 2008-09 and five assists for five points in 2007-08.

Per the CCHA's new scoring system, teams winning in regulation or overtime will now receive three points. The winning squad in a shootout will earn two points in the standings, while a shootout loss garners one point. In addition, a loss in regulation or overtime will result in no points for the losing team.

Sophomore defenseman GREG PATERYN scored his first career goal and had a career-best six points. He tied his high of five assists set as a freshman.

Junior forward SCOOTER VAUGHAN, who had played two years at defense, scored his first two career goals and had a career-high six points. He had five assists for five points in 2008-09.

Junior forward BEN WINNETT had career highs for assists (8) and points (14). He tied his career high for goals (6), set in 2007-08. Winnett had seven assists in 2008-09 and 11 points in 2007-08 and 2008-09.

POWER PLAY

- For the season, Michigan was 48-for-251 (19.1%), which ranked 21st in the country. In 2008-09, U-M's power play was 35th in the country (15.8%).
- Michigan was 21-9-1 when it scored a power-play goal. The Wolverines were 12-2-0 when scoring multiple power-play goals.
- 32.4% of Michigan's overall goal total came via the power play (48 out of 148).
- Eighteen players had a point on the power play; 15 had a power-play goal.
- CARL HAGELIN (6-12-18) and LOUIE CAPORUSSO (5-13-18) tied for the team lead in power-play scoring.
- CHRIS BROWN had a team-best seven power-play goals.
- U-M permitted three shorthanded goals this season: at FSU (Jan. 23), vs. MSU (Jan. 30) and at Notre Dame (Feb. 27). U-M lost all three games. It's the third year in a row that Michigan has yielded three shorthanded goals.

DEFENSE

- U-M allowed 2.27 goals per game, which ranked fifth in the country. The Wolverines have been among the top five teams defensively over each of the last three seasons. In 2008-09, U-M gave up 2.05 gpg (4th). In 2007-08, U-M allowed 2.07 gpg (4th).
- The Wolverines had six shutouts, which were the most since 2003-04 season when Al Montoya finished with a half-dozen blankings. All six shutouts this season occurred at Yost Ice Arena. Four

were by BRYAN HOGAN, one was by SHAWN HUNWICK and one was shared.

- U-M permitted two or fewer goals in 23 of 45 games, earning a 20-3-0 record when doing so.
- SHAWN HUNWICK earned the final 10 decisions of the season, starting each of the last nine games. He had an 8-2-0 record, 1.77 goals against average and .921 save percentage. He replaced the injured BRYAN HOGAN at 10:49 of the first period on Feb. 25 vs. Notre Dame.
- Hunwick made a career-high 32 saves in U-M's double-overtime loss to Miami in the Midwest Regional final on March 28. His high for saves in a 60-minute game is 28, which he achieved vs. Lake Superior State on March 6 for his career shutout.
- HUNWICK had made just two relief appearances in his three-year career before his 10-game run: vs. Nebraska-Omaha on March 14, 2008 (2 saves, no decision) and vs. RPI on Dec. 29, 2009 (3 saves on 4 shots, loss).
- Prior to his groin injury on Feb. 25 vs. Notre Dame, BRYAN HOGAN led the nation in minutes played (2,087:58). He still finished ninth in the country in minutes played despite not playing in the final nine games of the season. Including the Feb. 25 game, Hogan made 41 straight starts dating back to March 13, 2009.
- HOGAN was 11th in the nation in goals against average with a 2.3276 mark. He was one of seven goalies to notch four shutouts, which was tied for fifth in the country.
- HOGAN'S four shutouts are tied for fifth on U-M's single-season shutout list.

- HOGAN set a career high with 39 saves vs. the Badgers on Nov. 28. Hogan is 3-2-0 for his career when making 30-plus saves after posting 32 saves in a win vs. Niagara (Oct. 22) and 35 saves in a win at LSSU (Oct. 31).

- HOGAN enters his senior season chasing a number of U-M career goalie marks. His current rankings and statistics are as follows:

- U-M's shot blocking leaders were STEVE KAMPFER (49), BRANDON BURLON (46) and CHRIS SUMMERS (37).

- MATT RUST was a finalist for the CCHA Best Defensive Forward award. RUST led U-M in plus/minus +22, won 51.3% of his faceoffs and blocked 23 shots.

PENALTY KILL

- Michigan's penalty-kill rate was 86.0% (208-242), which was ninth-best in the country and eighth-best at Michigan all-time (since 1970-71). In 2008-09, U-M was sixth nationally at 88.1%.
- U-M was 17-4-0 when not allowing a power-play goal. Michigan also had 21 perfect PK games in 2008-09.
- U-M stopped 25 straight power plays over five-plus games from Nov. 21 into Dec. 11.
- The Wolverines were 1-8-0 when yielding multiple power-play goals.
- Michigan scored five shorthanded goals: two each by MATT RUST and CARL HAGELIN and one by LUKE GLENDENING.
- HAGELIN has five career shorthanded goals, which ties him with three other Wolverines for 14th on the Michigan career shorthanded goals list.

- Michigan went 12-5-1 this season at Yost. U-M out-scored opponents 64-33. U-M's power play was 17.0%, while its penalty kill was 91.6%.
- U-M had a record of 11-1-1 at Yost since a Nov. 27 win vs. Minnesota. Six of those wins were shutouts.
- 2009-10 was the 37th season for U-M at Yost. Michigan has had 21 consecutive winning campaigns at home. From the 1973-74 campaign -- when U-M hockey first began play at Yost Ice Arena -- through 2009-10 season, the record stands at 496-185-32 (71.8%).
- U-M's leading scorers at Yost were LOUIE CAPORUSSO (9-12-21), CARL HAGELIN (10-9-19), and MATT RUST (4-13-17).
- Goalie BRYAN HOGAN was 9-5-1, with a 1.97 GAA and a .919 save percentage with four shutouts. SHAWN HUNWICK was 3-0-0 with a 0.71 GAA, .969 save percentage and one shutout.

TEAM NOTES

- Michigan was picked to finish first in the CCHA this season by both the media and coaches in the league's preseason polls on Sept. 30. Notre Dame and Miami closely followed U-M in both polls, earning second and third place, respectively.
- By placing seventh in the CCHA, U-M finished outside the top three in the conference for the first time since 1989-90, when it was fourth. It was U-M's lowest finish since 1986-87 when it was also seventh.

- Michigan was ranked No. 4 in the preseason USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine poll. U-M was fifth in the final USA Today poll of 2008-09.
- The USCHO.com/CBS College Sports preseason poll slotted U-M No. 3 in the nation. The Wolverines finished the 2008-09 poll also at No. 3.

JOHNSON EARNS OLYMPIC SILVER MEDAL

- JACK JOHNSON (U-M 2006-07) earned a 2010 Olympic silver medal as a member of Team USA. The Americans lost to Team Canada, 3-2 OT, in the gold medal game. Johnson is the first former Wolverine to receive an Olympic medal since 1994, when David Harlock earned silver with Team Canada. Counting Johnson, six U-M alumni have won medals -- three with the U.S. and three with Canada. Willard Ikola and John Matchefts got silver medals in 1956 with Team USA. For Canada, Bob White earned bronze in 1956 and Todd Brost earned silver in 1992. In six games, Johnson had one assist and earned a +2 plus/minus rating. His 119:45 of ice time ranked third among the seven defensemen that the U.S. carried on its roster.

HEAD COACH RED BERENSON



A 17-year veteran of the NHL, Red Berenson (U-M, 1962) has spent 25 seasons at the helm for the Wolverines, where he owns a 699-327-69 record. In 2007-08, he was honored with the Spencer Penrose Award as college hockey's top coach. Berenson is in seventh place on college hockey's coaching wins list and is one of eight head coaches in college hockey history to accumulate 600 wins. A former Michigan captain and two-time All-American for U-M from 1960-62, Berenson has averaged more than 26 wins per season in his collegiate coaching career. He has led Michigan to a pair of NCAA Championships (1996, 1998) and 19 consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament, the longest active streak of any school in college hockey. He spent three seasons (1980-82) as head coach of the NHL's St. Louis Blues before coming back to Michigan, earning NHL Coach of the Year honors in 1981. For his "outstanding service to hockey in the United States" Berenson was given the NHL's Lester Patrick Award on Nov. 6, 2006.
