THE SNIP NALAN SCHOLARSHIP FOR WRESTLING

Jim Kamman enjoyed great success at the University of Michigan, both as a student and as a wrestler. He achieved championship status and following graduation translated that into a successful career in the practice of law. Jim's attendance and experiences at Michigan were greatly influenced by Snip Nalan, an outstanding wrestler who had attended Kamman's high school and preceded him at Michigan. Nalan was Michigan's first two-time NCAA champion, capturing the 130-pound honor in 1953 and '54. He boasted a career mark of 44-3 (.936), including back-to-back undefeated seasons in his junior and senior campaigns. Nalan's outstanding traits led him to tremendous individual success and served as a baseline for Michigan's development into a national power. To honor Snip Nalan, Jim and his wife, Judy, have endowed a scholarship for wrestling. The recipient of the 2009-10 Snip Nalan Scholarship is Kellen Russell.
