NFHCA ALL-AMERICANS

**BRYN BAIN**

All-America Second Team • 2011

Bryn Bain earned All-America honors after her senior year in the Maize and Blue. The Berlin, N.J., native scored seven goals and had nine assists for 23 points in 2011, helping the Wolverines to a Big Ten regular-season championship and a berth in the NCAA quarterfinals. Bain earned All-Big Ten and All-West Region first team honors while controlling the midfield for U-M. In her four year career, Bain scored 17 goals and had 16 assists for 50 points while playing in 75 games for Michigan. She had four game-winning goals in her Wolverine career, including a pair in 2011. Bain played in the NFHCA Senior Game in Louisville, Ky.

**LUCIA BELASSI**

All-America First Team • 2007

Lucia Belassi turned in a career year as a senior captain in 2007, boasting career-high totals in all offensive statistical categories and leading the Wolverine squad -- for the second year in a row -- in goals and points with 13-9-35 totals. Belassi, a native of Paysandu, Uruguay, upped her goal output in each of her collegiate seasons and completed her career with 33 goals, 19 assists and 85 total points. A consummate playmaker, she registered 10 game-winning markers over her career, including three overtime winners in her senior campaign. Belassi appeared in every U-M game during her career, accumulating 91 total appearances with 55 consecutive starts among her final three seasons. A two-time All-Big Ten first team selection, Belassi was named the Big Ten's co-Offensive Player of the Year in 2007 and garnered her first NFHCA All-America citation, earning first team honors.

**JULIE FLACHS**

All-America First Team • 1997

Julie Flachs completed her collegiate career with the most productive campaign in Michigan field hockey history, establishing a pair of new U-M single-season records with 29 goals and 64 points -- records she still holds 10 years later. Nicknamed "Hat Trick Flaxie," she boasted five three-goal games in her career, including four during her senior season when she led the Wolverines to the 1997 Big Ten title -- the first in program history. A three-time All-Big Ten selection, including a first-team choice as a senior, Flachs was named the Big Ten Offensive Player of the Year and an All-America first team selection in 1997 -- another pair of firsts for the U-M program, setting a standard for individual success that would become commonplace for the Wolverines in the decade to follow. She finished her career with 47 goals, 12 assists and 106 points and still ranks among the Michigan's top-five career leaders in the goal and point categories.

**CATHERINE FOREMAN**

All-America Third Team • 2000

All-America Third Team • 2001

A prolific passer, Catherine Foreman led the Wolverine squad -- or shared the team lead -- in assists in three of her four collegiate seasons, accumulating 61 in her career to establish the program's all-time record in the category. A two-time NFHCA All-America third team selection, Foreman shined in the 2001 NCAA Tournament, scoring the decisive marker in a 2-1 overtime win over Michigan State in the quarterfinal round, sending U-M to the Final Four, before capping off her career with an assist on the Wolverines' second goal in a 2-0 win over No. 1 Maryland for the NCAA title. She found equal success in the Big Ten Tournament, helping Michigan to a pair of tournament crowns over her tenure and twice earning a spot on the conference's all-tournament team. Foreman, a native of Happy Valley, South Australia, finished her career with four goals, 61 assists and 69 points.

**MARY FOX**

All-America Second Team • 2006

Known for her speed and playmaking abilities, Mary Fox capped her collegiate career with a selection to the NFHCA All-America second team. Fox was a two-time All-West Region first team choice after listing among the Wolverines' leading scorers in her final two seasons. A four-year mainstay on the U-M forward line, Fox boasted 28 career helpers over her four collegiate seasons and ranks fifth among the all-time Wolverine leaders in the category. She was named All-Big Ten Conference three times, including a consensus first-team pick as a senior in 2006, and was selected to participate in the NFHCA Senior All-Star Game. She competed with the USA Field Hockey junior teams for three seasons and participated in the 2005 Pan American Junior Championships in Puerto Rico. A biomedical engineering major off the field, Fox was a three-time NFHCA All-Academic and Academic All-Big Ten selection.

**APRIL FRONZONI**

All-America First Team • 2003

All-America First Team • 2002

All-America Third Team • 2000

The 2002-03 University of Michigan Female Athlete of the Year, April Fronzoni was a three-time All-America honoree and two-time Honda-Broderick Award finalist -- the Wolverines' lone repeat selection as one of the nation's top collegiate players. As a junior, she was named the Big Ten's Athlete of the Year and Offensive Player of the Year and claimed the latter award again as a senior in 2003. Michigan's leading scorer in each of her four seasons, including career-high 20-7-47 during her senior campaign, Fronzoni graduated with U-M standards in career goals (68) and career points (155). A member of USA Field Hockey junior teams since 1998, Fronzoni earned a silver medal at the 2000 Junior Pan American Championships and spent four years on the women's national team, accumulating 60 international caps and 15 international goals.

**KELLI GANNON**

All-America First Team • 2000
 All-America First Team • 1999
 All-America Second Team • 1998

The first three-time All-American in U-M field hockey history, Kelli Gannon helped carry the Wolverine squad to national prominence with NCAA Tournament appearances in 1999 and 2000. She was the team's leading scorer in each of her final three seasons, accumulating 49 goals, 28 assists and 126 points for her career. A 2000 Honda Broderick Award finalist and Michigan Female Athlete of the Year, Gannon bracketed her career with prestigious conference honors, earning the 1997 Big Ten Freshman of the Year award before claiming the Big Ten's Offensive Player of the Year award and the Medal of Honor in 2000. A two-time All-Big Ten first team selection, she was named the 1999 Big Ten Tournament MVP after leading the U-M to its first-ever conference tournament crown. Gannon played four years with the U.S. Women's National Team, earning 60 international caps and 12 goals.

**KRISTI GANNON**

All-America First Team • 2003
 All-America First Team • 2002

One of only four players in Big Ten history to be named to the All-Big Ten first team in four straight seasons, Kristi Gannon claimed conference awards in two of those seasons, taking home the Big Ten Freshman of the Year award (2000) before completing the cycle with the Athlete of the Year trophy as a senior (2003). A two-time NFHCA All-America first team selection, Gannon was a pivotal member of the Wolverines' 2001 NCAA Championship team, earning All-Tournament team honors after scoring Michigan's second goal against Maryland in the championship game. Gannon ranks among the top-10 leaders in all U-M career offensive categories with 37 goals, 26 assists and 100 career points. She spent four years with the USA Field Hockey women's national team, boasting 45 international caps and a pair of international goals. She contributed to U.S. silver medals at the 2004 Pan American Cup and 2001 Americas Cup and competed in the 2004 Olympic Qualifying Tournament.

**LORI HILLMAN**

All-America First Team • 2005
 All-America Third Team • 2004

Shrugging off an injury that could have spoiled her senior year, Lori Hillman guided Michigan to its seventh straight NCAA Tournament appearance in 2005, earning NFHCA All-America first team honors for her effort in the U-M backfield. It was the second All-America citation for Hillman in her career, adding to her third-team recognition the previous season. A four-year defensive starter, Hillman was named the Big Ten's Defensive Player of the Year in 2004 and twice selected the Big Ten Tournament's Most Valuable Player as U-M held its opposition to a combined 1.00 goals per game en route to back-to-back tournament trophies during her final two seasons. Named the 2002 Big Ten Freshman of the Year, she was a two-time all-conference first team selection. Hillman started every appearance of her U-M career, missing four contests while competing at the 2005 Junior World Cup with the USA Under-21 team. She ended her career with seven goals, 27 assists and 41 points.

**ADRIENNE HORTILLOSA**

All-America First Team • 2004

Adrienne Hortillosa concluded her four-year stint at Michigan with the best performance of her collegiate career, establishing personal standards in nearly all statistical categories en route to the Big Ten's 2004 Athlete of the Year award and NFHCA All-America first team honors. The midfielder ranked among the Wolverines' leading scorers in each of her seasons, capping her career with highs in goals (16) and points (43). She led U-M in assists for three consecutive seasons and graduated holding the third spot among the career leaders with 38. Hortillosa also ranks fourth on the all-time points list with 108. A three-time All-Big Ten selection, Hortillosa began her U-M career on a similar note, claiming the 2001 Big Ten Freshman of the Year award. She led the Wolverines with six game-winning goals in 2001, including the eventual gamewinner against Maryland in the NCAA championship game, coming off a corner tip with just two minutes remaining in the first half.

**STEPHANIE JOHNSON**

All-America Second Team • 2003
 All-America Third Team • 2002

A dependable force in the Michigan backfield, Stephanie Johnson did not miss a game -- nor a start -- during her collegiate career, establishing the U-M record for career games played (95) despite a back injury that forced her to redshirt her sophomore season. Among the Wolverines' most decorated players in program history, Johnson was a two-time NFHCA All-America and three-time All-Big Ten first team selection. She was twice named Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year, becoming the third player in conference history to claim the distinction it twice and only the second to receive it in back-to-back seasons. Over her four years, she quarterbacked the Michigan defense, which limited opponents to 1.28 goals per game and claimed 30 shutout victories, and, as one of the team's primary strikers in each of her seasons, she finished her career with 36 goals, seven assists and 79 points.

**PAIGE LAYTOS**

All-America Third Team • 2010
 All-America Third Team • 2007

Paige Laytos was named to the All-Big Ten teams four times and earned All-America distinction twice in her U-M career. Laytos was named a Third Team All-American in both 2007 and 2010, helping the Wolverines to Big Ten regular-season titles and NCAA appearances in both seasons. Laytos ended her U-M career with 12 goals and 27 assists, which put her tied for seventh on U-M's career assist list. Laytos also earned honors for her efforts in the classroom, as she was named a three-time Academic All-Big Ten selection, a two-time NFHCA National Academic Squad honoree and a four-time U-M Athletic Academic Achievement Award recipient. Laytos earned All-Big Ten Tournament team honors in 2007 and 2010 and helped the Wolverines to the 2010 Big Ten Tournament title.

**RACHAEL MACK**

Michigan's first four-time All-American in program history, Rachael Mack garnered first-team accolades as a senior and was named the 2013 NFHCA West Region Player of the Year, Big Ten Player of the Year, Big Ten Offensive Player of the Year and a finalist for the prestigious Honda Award. She was a four-time All-Big Ten honoree, earning first team honors in each of her final three seasons. As a freshman, she was named the Big Ten Tournament MVP. Mack compiled career stats of 73 goals, 20 assists and 166 points, establishing Michigan program records for career goals and career points. She broke the records in dramatic fashion, scoring both goals in a 2-1 overtime victory at rival Ohio State.

**MOLLY POWERS**

All-America Third Team • 2002

Molly Powers capped her collegiate career at Michigan with selection to the NFHCA All-America third team after posting 15 goals, including four gamewinners, two assists and 32 points. Powers listed among the Wolverines' leading goal scorers in each of her four seasons and ended her tenure with 44 career markers, listing fifth among the all-time leaders in the category. She added nine assists, including two in NCAA Tournament action, to wrap her career with 97 points. A two-time NFHCA All-West Region selection and 2003 All-Big Ten first team pick, Powers spent two years with USA Field Hockey's women's national team.

**COURTNEY REID**

All-America First Team • 2000

As a key member of the Wolverines' penalty-corner unit for three seasons, Courtney Reid left Michigan with the program's career record for assists (56) and still ranks second on the all-time list. Reid tallied 22 helpers in each of her final two seasons -- matching the U-M single-season record in the category -- and, after leading U-M to a sweep of the Big Ten regular-season and tournament trophies in 2000, netted NFHCA All-America first team honors to cap her collegiate career. Reid headlined the Wolverines' performance at the 2000 Big Ten Tournament, earning the event's MVP distinction after scoring a pair of goals in U-M's 3-2 championship-game victory over Penn State. A two-time NFHCA All-West region and All-Big Ten first team selection, Reid concluded her career with 20 goals, 56 assists and 96 points -- the latter mark also ranks among the Wolverines' all-time leaders in the category.

**ASHLEY REICHENBACH**

All-America Second Team • 1999

Ashley Reichenbach anchored the Wolverine backfield over her tenure, tallying seven goals while helping to establish one of the top defenses in school history. A second-team All-America selection as a senior, Reichenbach was on the field for one of the most memorable seasons in U-M history, earning a spot on the NCAA All-Tournament team while leading the squad to the national championship game during the school's first-ever appearance in the postseason. She scored the dramatic game-winning goal against No. 3 Wake Forest in the NCAA quarterfinals off a penalty stroke in double overtime, propelling the Wolverines into the Final Four. Her final year in the Maize and Blue was full of accolades as she earned 1999 Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year honors and was selected to the All-Big Ten second and Big Ten All-Tournament teams. Reichenbach also netted All-West Region first team and Big Ten All-Tournament team laurels as a junior. She returned to her alma mater as an assistant coach and spent three years on the Wolverine staff (2001-03), contributing to the program's first NCAA championship in 2001.

**MICHELLE SMULDERS**

All-America Second Team • 1996

Michelle Smulders became the Michigan field hockey program's first All-American in 1996, earning second-team selection after leading the Wolverines with 17 goals and 36 points during her senior campaign, including an impressive 14 goals over an eight-game stretch in October. Smulders also headlined Michigan's scoring efforts during her sophomore season with eight markers. A two-time All-Big Ten, she ended her career with 33 goals, four assists and 70 points, listing among the program's top-five all-time scoring leaders at the time of her graduation. Off the field, Smulders was a three-time Academic All-Big Ten selection.

**MEREDITH WAY**

All-America Third Team • 2010

Meredith Way earned All-American honors her senior year as she scored five goals and dished out three assists in 22 games in the backfield. The All-Big Ten First Team honoree in 2010, Way scored both goals in a 2-0 win at Iowa and had the game-winning goal in an overtime win over James Madison. Way currently is eighth on U-M's all-time goals scored list with 38 and 10th on the Maize and Blue career points list with 91. Way was a two-time first team all-conference honoree and earned second team honors in 2008. She also earned back-to-back All-West Region first team selections in 2009 and 2010.

The Wolverines' field general during their transitional years into national prominence, Loveita Wilkinson was the first Michigan player to earn repeat All-America recognition, earning third team honors as a junior (1997) before claiming first-team selection in her final season (1998). A two-time selection to the All-Big Ten first team, Wilkinson tallied three goals and an assist in Michigan's back-to-back runner-up showings at the Big Ten Tournament (1997, '98) and earned a spot on the Big Ten All-Tournament team as a senior. She finished her Michigan career with 15 goals, 10 assists and 40 points.

2001 NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP

KENT, Ohio -- Goals by freshman forward Adrienne Hortillosa and sophomore defender Kristi Gannon, plus the stellar play of senior goalkeeper Maureen Tasch, gave the University of Michigan its first NCAA team championship in a women's sport as the Wolverine field hockey team posted a 2-0 win over top-ranked Maryland on Sunday (Nov. 18) in the NCAA championship game at Kent State's Dix Stadium.

With the win, seventh-ranked Michigan (18-5) becomes the second team from the Midwest to capture the NCAA title, joining 1986 champion Iowa. In addition, the Wolverines avenged a 2-1 loss to the Terrapins in the 1999 NCAA championship game.

The Wolverines' defense, which has held opponents to just six shots per game this season, survived a shelling by Maryland as the Terrapins unloaded 20 shots, including 11 in the second half. Eleven of the Terps' total shots made it on net, where Tasch was there to knock them away en route to her eighth shutout of the season, setting the U-M school record for shutouts in a single campaign.

Michigan was on the defensive for the majority of the first period as Maryland peppered the U-M defense with nine shots and had the Wolverines pinned in their own end for the bulk of the first 35 minutes. Michigan suffered a blow to its defense when sophomore Stephanie Johnson was taken out of the game after she was hit in the face on a Maryland penalty corner, but the Wolverines held on as Tasch made seven saves in the first 35 minutes to keep the Terrapins scoreless.

With time winding down in the first half and the Wolverines attempting a penalty corner, Hortillosa put U-M up 1-0, tipping in a pass from sophomore Kristi Gannon. Gannon received the ball from senior defender Catherine Foreman and fed it across the circle to a wide-open Hortillosa, who tipped it into the empty cage.

The Wolverines took a 2-0 lead just under six minutes into the second half on its only penalty corner attempt of the period when Gannon unleashed a blast from the top of the circle, which caromed off Maryland keeper Ashley Hohnstine into the back of the cage. Foreman and senior midfielder Ali Balmer were credited with assists.

Maryland had a chance to pull within one late in the second half when sophomore forward April Fronzoni was issued a yellow card at 11:33, giving the Terrapins a one-player advantage for over five minutes. Maryland took a number of its seven second-half penalty corners during that time, but each time the defense stepped up and cleared the ball.

Tasch, Gannon, Hortillosa, Johnson and Fronzoni were named to the NCAA All-Tournament team, joining Maryland's Dina Rizzo, Autumn Welsh, Colleen Barbieri and Caroline Walter, as well as Wake Forest's Kelly Doton and Heather Auginbaugh.

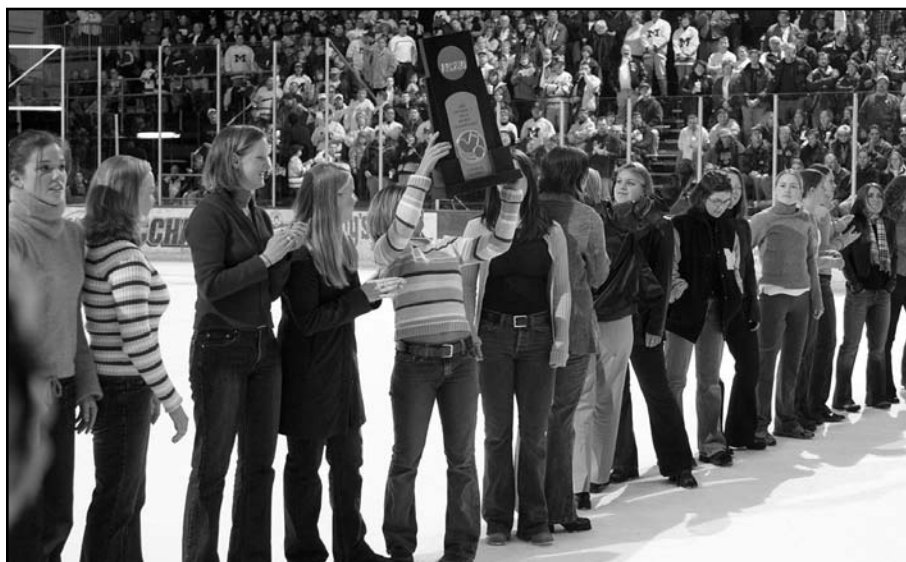

PHYLLIS OCKER FIELD

Phyllis Ocker Field was unveiled to the University and Ann Arbor communities in September 1995. The Wolverines have an all-time record of 122-42 at Ocker Field, which translates to a .744 winning percentage. In 2000 and again in 2002, the Wolverines were flawless on their home turf, posting 11-0 and 10-0 records, respectively.

Designed by Jagdish Janveja and Tom Keast of the U-M Facilities Planning and Design Plant Extension Office, Ocker Field is a seamless artificial turf surface with a carefully constructed substratum that absorbs all shocks. The playing surface encourages good ball control skills and a faster, more powerful game of field hockey. Bleachers on the north side of the field offer seating for 500 fans. The facility was constructed jointly with the Michigan Varsity Soccer Field, which saw its final season in 2007 and was replaced with a new football indoor practice facility in 2009.

Ocker Field is named for former University of Michigan teacher, athletics administrator and field hockey coach Phyllis Ocker and was formally dedicated on Oct. 8, 1995. Ocker directed the Wolverine field hockey program through five of its early seasons (1974-78). She also served as the University's third director of women's athletics (1977-90) and was a member of the 1973 Burns Committee that developed the architecture for the Wolverines' women's varsity sport programs.

The Ocker Field site is one of historical significance in Michigan athletics. The field hockey facility is built partially on the site that was home to Regents Field from 1893-1905. Michigan's famous early 20th Century "Point-A-Minute" and national champion football teams of coach Fielding Yost played at Regents Field, later called South Ferry Field when athletic teams began competing at other venues.

Ocker Field is the fifth home site for Michigan field hockey. The Wolverines played at Michigan Stadium (1973-75), Ferry Field (1976-86), the Tartan Turf (1987-90) and Oosterbaan Field House (1991-94) before moving to Ocker Field for the 1995 season.

Since its debut in 1995, Ocker Field has served as the host site for several conference and national tournament events, including the 2000 and 2006 Big Ten Tournaments and the 2001 NCAA Regional that ushered the Wolverines into the Final Four and to their first NCAA crown. U-M has hosted NCAA Regional play at Ocker Field in three of its last six tournament appearances. In 2012, Michigan will play 7 regular-season competitions at Ocker Field, bringing in several of the top field hockey programs from all areas of the country.

In 1997, an impressive addition was made to the Michigan field hockey complex with the completion of the South Ferry Sports Services Building. Used by both the field hockey and women's soccer teams, the facility has separate locker, coaches and meeting rooms for each team, in addition to a satellite athletic training room, officials' room and storage. The field hockey locker room features spacious individual lockers, while the Maize and Blue team meeting room has state-of-the-art audio-visual equipment for opponent scouting and teaching. The locker room and team room were redone over the course of 2009 and 2010.

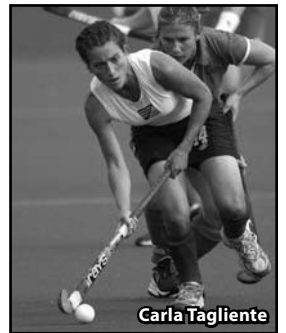
