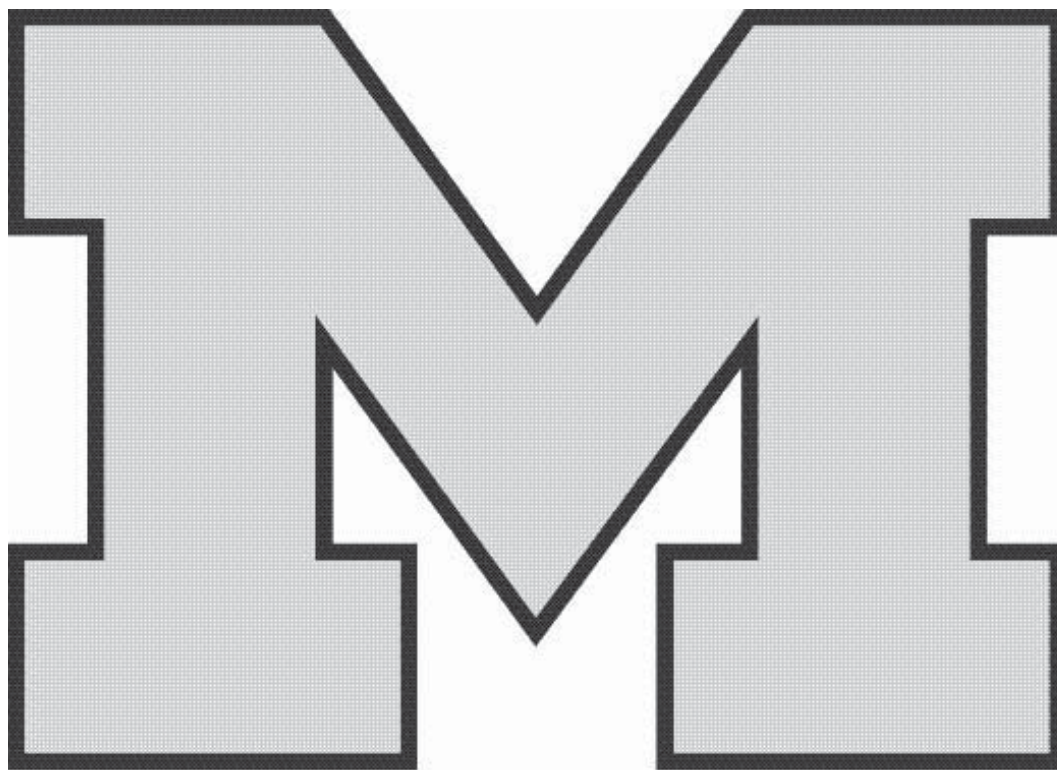

The 19th-ranked Wolverines advanced to the second round of the NCAA Championship for the third straight season, earning a 4-0 sweep of No. 69 Furman before dropping a 4-1 decision to host and No. 13-ranked Clemson.

Michigan claimed its 18th doubles point of the year and followed with three straight-set singles wins to finish off the Paladins in first-round action. Freshman **Whitney Taney** delivered the match-clinching victory in her NCAA debut, securing a commanding 6-3, 6-1 triumph over Monica Arguello at No. 2 singles.

U-M was unable to duplicate its doubles success against Clemson, and the Tigers went on to claim three of the first four singles matches completed and deny the Wolverines their first trip to the NCAA Team Championship since 1997. Freshman **Rika Tatsuno** posted a 6-1, 6-2 victory over Federica van Adrichem at No. 5 singles for Michigan's lone team point.

Junior **Chisako Sugiyama** became just the fifth Wolverine to move past the first round at the NCAA Singles Championship. The 50th-ranked Sugiyama tallied a 6-3, 6-4 victory over Georgia Tech's No. 38-ranked Maya Johansson before exiting the tournament with a 6-3, 6-2 setback to Northwestern's No. 5-ranked Maria Mosolova.

The 15th-ranked Wolverines advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16 for the third consecutive season. Michigan similarly hosted the first and second rounds of the NCAA Tournament for third straight year, defeating Illinois-Chicago and Texas A&M at the Varsity Tennis Center.

U-M cruised past the Flames, 4-0, in the opening round, winning a lopsided doubles point before claiming straight-set decisions from **Emina Bektas** at No. 1, **Mimi Nguyen** at No. 3 and **Michelle Sulahian** at No. 6. The Wolverines' semifinal match against No. 19 Texas A&M came down to the final match, where **Brooke Bolender** rallied to win in three sets at the No. 2 position to propel U-M to a 4-3 decision and its third berth in the Sweet 16.
