- Michigan is making its sixth consecutive NCAA appearance. In **Mark Rosen's** 13 years as head coach, the Wolverines have made 11 tournament appearances.

WOLVERINE STORYLINES

Dancing...Again!

For the sixth consecutive season, the Wolverines (20-12) are headed to the NCAA Tournament. Michigan has made the tournament 12 times, 11 of those appearances coming under head coach **Mark Rosen**. U-M is 12-11 all-time in the Big Dance, advancing to three Sweet 16s (2007, 2008, 2009) and the 2009 Elite Eight.

Wrapping Up the Regular Season

Michigan went 1-1 over the final week of the regular season, knocking off Michigan State in four before falling to Ohio State in four sets. U-M finished the regular season with a 20-12 overall record and 8-12 mark in the Big Ten, tying for eighth place.

Looking at Baylor

Baylor (18-14) is making its fourth NCAA appearance in program history and the second in the past three years. The Bears lost four of their five final matches, finishing the season with an 18-14 overall record and a 5-11 mark in Big 12 action. Baylor puts down 13.18 kills per set on a .212 attack percentage, led by Brianna Tolbert's 2.80 kills a frame. Kate Harris (6.20 assists/set) and Brittany Ridenour (8.89 assists/set) split the setting duties and Allison King leads the defense with 5.11 digs a set. Michigan and Baylor have never met on the volleyball court.

Scouting No. 11-seed Stanford

Stanford (21-7) received the No. 11 seed for the NCAA Tournament and is making its 31st consecutive appearance in the tournament. Rachel Williams (4.32 kills/set) and Carly Wopat (3.22 kills/set) lead the Cardinal offense, which hits .246. Karissa Cook directs the offense, handing out 11.36 assists per set and Hannah Benjamin leads a trio of players with at least 300 digs on the season, averaging 3.36 per set. Stanford leads the all-time series, 2-1, but Michigan won the previous meeting, 3-1, in the 2009 NCAA regional semifinal in Palo Alto.

Glancing at Sacred Heart

The Pioneers (27-7) are making their second consecutive NCAA appearance after winning the Northeastern conference for the second straight year. Sacred Heart is led by Kimmee Roler's 3.94 kills per set, with Dianis Mercado chipping in 2.76 kills a set. Setter Alisa Mesa leads the team at 8.32 assists per set and libero Jessica Colberg was named the Northeastern Conference's Libero of the Year after recording 4.14 digs per set. Michigan and Sacred Heart have never met.

Playing the Best

Michigan has faced 12 of the 63 other teams in the tournament, including eight of the 16 seeded teams. U-M is 8-10 against tournament teams, squaring off against Michigan State, Dayton, Texas A&M, Penn State, Purdue, Morehead State, Florida State, Minnesota, Illinois, Ohio State, Pepperdine and Nebraska.

Making It To 20

With a 3-1 win against Michigan State, the Wolverines reached the 20-win plateau for the sixth consecutive season. U-M has recorded 20 wins in eight of head coach **Mark Rosen's** 13 seasons in Ann Arbor.

Dannemiller, Hunt Earn All-Big Ten Honors

Michigan put two on All-Big Ten teams with freshman setter **Lexi Dannemiller** being named to the All-Freshman team and senior outside hitter Alex Hunt earning All-Big Ten honorable mention. In addition, senior libero **Sloane Donhoff** was named Michigan's sportsmanship honoree.

Dannemiller led the conference in total assists (1,394) and ranked No. 2 in assists per set (11.62) at the conclusion of the regular season. She was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week four times and racked up 13 double-doubles (assists/digs). Dannemiller, a starter in all 32 matches, handed out a career-best 65 assists against Minnesota on Oct. 7 and recorded at least 50 assists in 11 matches. Dannemiller is the seventh freshman in U-M history to earn the honor, joining Hunt and sophomore middle blocker **Jennifer Cross** as current Wolverines to be named to the team.

Hunt was honored by the Big Ten for the third consecutive season after earning honorable mention in 2009 and first-team honors in 2010. The outside hitter averaged 3.23 kills per set on a .221 attack percentage, putting down at least 20 kills in five matches and going for at least 10 terminations in 20 matches. With 12 kills against Ohio State in the regular-season finale on Nov. 25, Hunt moved into second place on Michigan's all-time kills list with 1,573.

Donhoff, a three-time captain, was named Michigan's sportsmanship honoree for the first time in her career. Donhoff ended the regular season ranked No. 3 in the Big Ten in digs per set (4.53) and has recorded 544 digs this season, the fourth-best season mark in U-M history. For her career, the libero has reached the 10-dig plateau 105 times and ranks second on the all-time digs list at Michigan with 1,866.

Hunt Moves Into Second Place

With 12 kills against Ohio State last weekend, senior **Alex Hunt** moved second place on the all-time kills list, passing **Jennifer Gandolph** (2001-04), who racked up 1,562 kills during her career. Hunt now has 1,573 kills during her tenure in the Maize and Blue.

Starts With the Block?

In Michigan's 3-1 win over Michigan State, the Wolverines recorded 10.0 blocks, the seventh time this season U-M has recorded at least 10 blocks in a match. U-M is 6-1 in those matches.

Balanced Across the Board

Last season, Michigan had someone in double-figure kills 53 times, led by **Alex Hunt's** 27 matches with at least 10 kills. This season, Michigan has put someone in double-figure kills 83 times. **Lexi Erwin** leads the way with 22 matches with at least 10 kills, followed by Hunt (20), **Courtney Fletcher** (14), **Claire McElheny** (14), **Jennifer Cross** (10) and **Molly Toon** (3).

Five with 10

In Michigan's 3-2 win over Northwestern on Nov. 18, the Wolverines put five players in double-figure kills for the first time since the 2008 season. **Claire McElheny** and **Lexi Erwin** both put down 16 kills in the win, with the trio of **Jennifer Cross**, **Courtney Fletcher** and **Molly Toon** each going for 11.

Three with 20

For the first time this season, Michigan had a trio of Wolverines go for at least 20 digs in a single match. **Sloane Donhoff** (30), **Ally Sabol** (23) and **Lexi Dannemiller** (20) all reached the 20-dig plateau in U-M's 3-2 win over Northwestern on Nov. 18. The Maize and Blue recorded 108 digs as a team, the second time this season the Wolverines have eclipsed the century mark. Michigan is 2-0 in those matches, knocking off the Wildcats and Iowa on Nov. 5.

And Yet More Balance

With **Courtney Fletcher**, **Molly Toon**, **Lexi Erwin** and **Jennifer Cross** each putting down 11 kills in Michigan's 3-1 loss to No. 7 Illinois on Nov. 19, it marked the 10th time U-M put at least four in double figures. U-M is 5-5 when at least four go for 10-or-more kills, knocking off Santa Clara, Pepperdine, Toledo and Northwestern twice, while falling to No. 14 Minnesota, No. 11 Purdue, No. 2 Nebraska, Wisconsin and No. 7 Illinois. Michigan had four players in double-figures just once during 2010.

When the Offense is There...

Michigan is 19-0 this season when recording a higher attack percentage than its opponents. The Wolverines have just one win when recording a lower attack percentage than their opponent after taking a 3-2 win at Iowa on Nov. 5. U-M hit .131 while the Hawkeyes hit .187 in that five-set affair.

Beating a Ranked Team and It Feels So Good!

Michigan's 3-0 win at Minnesota on Nov. 13 marked the first win for U-M in Minneapolis since a 3-2 win on Sept. 26, 1997. Prior to Sunday's triumph, a **Mark Rosen**-coached team had not won in the Sports Pavilion during his 13-year tenure. The victory was also the Wolverines' first win over a ranked Big Ten opponent this season.

Double Dip

Michigan has had three players record a total of 27 double-doubles this season. Setter **Lexi Dannemiller** leads the way with 13 double-doubles (assists/digs), with **Lexi Erwin** recording nine double-doubles (kills/digs) of her own. **Alex Hunt** rounds out the trio with five double dups (kills/digs). **Courtney Fletcher** is the only other current Wolverine to record a double-double, going for 14 kills and 10 total blocks at Toledo in 2010.

Donhoff Keeps Digging

After recording 15 digs against Michigan State and another 17 against Ohio State, senior libero **Sloane Donhoff** ran her career total to 105 matches with at least 10 digs. She now has 1,866 digs during her tenure at Michigan, placing her second on the all-time list and 12th all-time in Big Ten history. Her 34 digs at Iowa marked the sixth-highest single-match total in U-M history. The libero has also recorded 129 service aces in her career, putting her eighth all-time at Michigan.

Dig, Dig and Dig Some More

For the first time since the 2008 season, the Wolverines recorded 100 digs in a match when they went for 102 against Iowa on Nov. 5. Five players reached double-figures, led by career-best nights from **Sloane Donhoff** (34) and **Ally Sabol** (25). It was also the first time the Wolverines had two players over 20 digs since **Megan Bower** (2006-09) and Donhoff accomplished the feat on Sept. 5, 2009 against Xavier. Michigan's previous season high in digs was 88 against Pepperdine on Sept. 10.

Cutting Down on the Blocks

In Michigan's 3-0 win at No. 16 Minnesota, the Wolverines hit into a season-low 3.0 blocks. The previous low for Michigan was 4.0 at Indiana in the Big Ten season opener. U-M also out-blocked the Gophers (8.0-3.0), marking just the ninth time this season the Wolverines have had more blocks than their opponents. Michigan is 9-0 in those matches.

Dannemiller Named Big Ten Co-Freshman of the Week

Freshman setter **Lexi Dannemiller** earned her fourth Big Ten Freshman of the Week honor after U-M after helping Michigan go 1-1 during a Big Ten road weekend. In Michigan's 3-0 sweep of No. 16 Minnesota, Dannemiller recorded her 11th double-double of the season with 32 assists and 10 digs to go with three kills and a service ace. The Wolverines hit .291 against the Gophers, including hitting into a season-low 3.0 blocks. In a 3-1 loss at Wisconsin Nov. 11, the freshman recorded 59 assists and eight digs while leading U-M to a .302 attack percentage. For the weekend, she averaged 13.00 assists and 2.57 digs a set.

Trio Signs to Join Wolverines in 2012

Head coach **Mark Rosen** and his staff announced the signing of **Ally Davis** (*Hinsdale, Ill./Hinsdale Central*), **Krystalyn Goode** (*River Hills, Wis./Nicolet*) and **Kelly Murphy** (*Marietta, Ga./Walton*) to National Letters of Intent during the early signing period. All three are Senior Aces according to Prepvolleyball.com. U-M will lose the senior class of **Karlee Bruck**, **Sloane Donhoff**, **Alex Hunt**, **Michelle McMahon** and **Courtney Fletcher** to graduation following the 2011 season.

First to 1,000

With 37 assists in Michigan's 3-0 win over Indiana, freshman setter **Lexi Dannemiller** became the first Big Ten setter this season to eclipse 1,000 assists. She is the eighth Wolverine in program history to hit that mark and now has 1,394 on the season after last weekend's action. Her total marks the 13th consecutive season a U-M setter has reached that plateau and 17th time overall. Head coach **Mark Rosen** has had a setter record 1,000 assists in each of his 13 seasons at the helm of Michigan volleyball.

Fletcher Turns It Up

In her final season, senior **Courtney Fletcher** has taken her game to a new level. She is averaging 2.42 kills per set on a .330 attack percentage, which is the seventh-highest percentage in the Big Ten. She has recorded 14 matches with at least 10 kills after having just six in her career before this season. Fletcher is also second on the team in service aces (35) and third in total points (369.5).

Every Match

The Wolverines feature three players who have played in every match during their career in **Sloane Donhoff**, **Jennifer Cross** and **Lexi Dannemiller**. Donhoff has seen the court 137 times, the most of any current player. Cross has played in all 65 matches the past two seasons and Dannemiller has started all 32 matches of her young career.

20-20...or 23-21, To Be Exact

In Michigan's 3-2 loss to Minnesota on Oct. 7, **Lexi Erwin** and **Alex Hunt** became the first teammates since 2005 to each record at least 20 kills. Erwin put down a career-best 23 kills with Hunt chipping in 21. **Katie Bruzdinski** (33) and **Danielle Pflum** (20) were the last teammates to accomplish the feat, coming against Georgia on Sept. 16, 2005.

13-0...For the Fourth Time

With a 3-0 win at Indiana, Michigan equaled its best start in program history with a 13-0 record. U-M went 13-0 to begin the 2006, 2007 and 2008 seasons before dropping its 14th match in all three seasons. The same thing happened this season as Michigan fell to No. 13 Purdue in the 14th match of the season. The 13 consecutive wins also marked the program's longest winning streak.

One of the Last To Go Down

Michigan was one of the last teams to suffer a loss this season in Division I. Before losing to Purdue on Sept. 24, Michigan was one of four remaining undefeated teams (Purdue, Illinois and Northern Arizona).

Unscathed In Non-Conference

For the fourth time under head coach **Mark Rosen**, the Wolverines ended the non-conference season unbeaten with a 12-0 record. U-M also went undefeated during the non-conference season in 2006, 2007 and 2008. Michigan has won 21 consecutive matches against non-conference teams in the regular season.

250 at Michigan

Head coach **Mark Rosen** won the 250th match of his tenure at Michigan with a 3-1 win over Xavier on Sept. 16. He is the seventh active coach to record 250 wins at Michigan, joining Carol Hutchins (softball), Red Berenson (ice hockey), Rich Maloney (baseball), Bev Plocki (women's gymnastics), Matt Anderson (water polo) and Kurt Golder (men's gymnastics). Rosen is 258-163 in 13 years at Michigan.

Serving It Up

The Wolverines recorded 35 service aces over three matches in Utah, averaging 3.50 per set. Against Utah Valley, U-M found the floor 19 times from the service line, which was one off the program record of 20. It was the highest single-match total of the **Mark Rosen** era.

From All Over

The 2011 Wolverines hail from nine different states and one Canadian province. For the second consecutive season, seniors **Alex Hunt** and **Sloane Donhoff** will serve as captains for the 2011 season.

Hunt Earns Preseason All-Big Ten Honors

For the second consecutive season, senior outside hitter **Alex Hunt** was named to the Preseason All-Big Ten team. In 2010, the lefty led the Big Ten in points (5.04) and kills (4.41) per set as the only player in the conference to record more than five points a frame.

Lucky No. 13

Head coach **Mark Rosen** is in his 13th year at the helm of the Michigan volleyball program in 2011. Since taking over in Ann Arbor, Rosen has led the Wolverines to 10 NCAA bids, three Sweet 16's, an Elite Eight appearance and a 254-157 record. His wife, **Leisa Rosen**, joins him on the sidelines for the 13th consecutive season while new assistant coaches **Erin Virtue** and **Craig Boller** joined the program in the offseason.

Virtue Coaches For USA Volleyball

First-year assistant coach **Erin Virtue** served as an assistant coach for the 2011 USA Volleyball High Performance Indoor National Girls' Select A1 program (GSA1) during July. It was the third time Virtue coach for USA Volleyball (2008, 2009). It was the second straight year that the Michigan volleyball program has ties to USA Volleyball. Last spring, head coach **Mark Rosen** served as a head coach for the U.S. Women's National A2 Program and led his Blue Team to a gold medal in the Open Division National Championships.

Rosen Enters His 13th Year at Michigan

Mark Rosen enters his 13th year at Michigan in 2011, compiling a 259-164 mark in Ann Arbor. He has coached four All-Americans in **Erin Moore**, **Lexi Zimmerman**, **Juliana Paz** and **Alex Hunt**. Rosen is joined on the sidelines by his wife and associate head coach, **Leisa Rosen**, and new assistants **Erin Virtue** and **Craig Boller** (volunteer).

Winningest Coach at Michigan

With a 3-1 win over Purdue during the 2008 season, **Mark Rosen** became the program's winningest coach. The victory was his 178th at Michigan, passing **Sandy Vong's** previous mark of 177 triumphs. With a 3-0 win over Marquette during 2009, Rosen became the first coach at Michigan to win 200 matches.

How He Stacks Up

With his 448 career wins at four-year colleges to enter the 2011 season, **Mark Rosen** ranks 25th among the winningest active coaches. He is the fifth Big Ten coach on the list behind Penn State head coach Russ Rose, Nebraska head coach John Cook, Wisconsin head coach Pete Waite and Ohio State coach Geoff Carlston.

Best Big Ten Finish...For A Second Straight Season

For the third consecutive season, the Wolverines went through the Big Ten slate with a 12-8 record. U-M tied for fourth place, marking the second straight fourth-place ending for the Maize and Blue. The fourth-place finishes are the highest ever during the **Mark Rosen** era.

First Elite 8

Mark Rosen became the first coach in history to lead the Wolverines to the NCAA Regional Final when U-M reached the Elite Eight in 2009. Michigan knocked off No. 4 Stanford in Palo Alto to advance before falling to No. 3 Hawai'i.

Big Ten Honors

Mark Rosen has had at least one player earn All-Big Ten honors in each of the past five seasons, led by **Lexi Zimmerman's** three consecutive first team honors (2008, 2009, 2010). In his 13 years at Michigan, Rosen has coached players to 10 All-Big Ten citations, in addition to **Stesha Selsky's** Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year honor in 2007.

Getting Respect

For the third consecutive season, the Wolverines garnered a preseason ranking after coming in at No. 24 in 2011. Despite losing three-time All-American **Lexi Zimmerman**, Michigan moved back into the poll after missing the top 25 in the final rankings of 2010.
