




2008 BASEBALL CHAMPIONSHIP

CORAL GABLES REGIONAL | GAME 1: (2) MISSOURI 7, (3) OLE MISS 0 FRIDAY, MAY 30, 2008 | NOTES

- Missouri leads the all-time series, 5-3, and also won the last meeting between the teams in 1987

(2) MISSOURI (39-19)

- Pitching his seventh complete game of his career and fourth of the season, RHP Aaron Crow, the Big 12 Conference Pitcher of the Year, improves to a school-record 13-0 with the win... With 10 strikeouts today, he moves into a tie for second in single-season strikeouts with 127 (tying John Dettmer, 1991).
- It was Crow's fourth shutout of the year and the seventh for the Tigers in 2008.
- Limiting Ole Miss to three hits, it marked the fourth time this season Crow has held an opponent to three-or-fewer hits.
- Trevor Coleman hit his fourth homerun of the season (all in May), scoring three in the bottom of the seventh, to extend Mizzou's lead to 7-0... Tied his career high with three RBI – third time this season and seventh time of career.
- Aaron Senne hit his 14th double of the season in the bottom of the fifth, scoring two to extend Mizzou's lead to 3-0... Kyle Mach hit his 12th double of the season.
- Mizzou turned its 48th double play of the season in the top of the eighth inning for the second and third outs.
- Jacob Priday extended his school records in career at bats (877) and runs batted in (239).
- With Senne and Coleman each being hit by a pitch on Friday, the Tigers have been hit by a pitch 97 times this season – just 11 shy of the school record of 108 set in 2005... Coleman has been hit a team-high tying 12 times this season, while Senne has been hit eight times.
- One of just 16 schools to be making sixth-straight NCAA Regional appearance... Coral Gables Regional participants Miami and Ole Miss are also among those 16 schools.
- Has won six of last eight games and will play the winner of the (1) Miami/(4) Bethune-Cookman game on Saturday, May 31, at 4 p.m.

(3) OLE MISS (37-25)

- Snapped nine-game NCAA Regional win streak with today's loss, falling to 11-7 in NCAA Regional play under head coach Mike Bianco since 2001.
- Making his third NCAA Regional and his 48th career start, RHP Lance Lynn picked up his first NCAA Regional loss, falling to 2-1 (2006: def. Tulane; 2007: def. Southern Miss).
- Lynn struck out seven in 6.1 innings) to run his career totals to 110 in season strikeouts (set Ole Miss single-season record in 2007 with 146 strikeouts) and extend his Ole Miss career record in strikeouts to 332.
- Ole Miss posted its 47th double play of the year to close the bottom of the eighth inning.
- 163-56-1 versus non-conference opponents under Bianco, including a 22-10 mark this season.
- Has advanced to an NCAA Regional in seven of eight seasons under head coach Mike Bianco and has won three straight NCAA Regional Championships heading into Coral Gables.
- Won four of last six entering NCAA Regional play.
