

MIAMI ICE HOCKEY
2009-2010 Postseason Ticket Purchase Opportunities

CCHA 1st or 2nd Round (Oxford, OH – Goggin Ice Center) – March 5th – 7th or March 12th – 14th

Current Miami hockey season ticket holders will have the first opportunity to purchase tickets for the 1st or 2nd round CCHA playoff games should we secure a spot in either round (see the enclosure for pricing and date information). We will honor your regular season ticket location so long as you have completed and returned the ticket order form and paid in full by February 24th. You may also take this opportunity to request additional tickets for this series. We will confirm additional tickets AFTER the deadline. Additional seats will be provided in the best available location. For those season ticket holders who purchased playoff tickets when you secured your season seats (summer of 2009), your order will be filled for the appropriate home playoff series the team secures. Red & White Club members and other Miami fans who are not season ticket holders will have the first opportunity to request tickets if quantities are still available. If you are not a Red & White Club member, you may join by completing the information on the enclosure when you request your tickets.

CCHA Championship (Detroit, MI – Joe Louis Arena) – March 19th – 20th

All Miami fans are afforded the opportunity to purchase tickets for the CCHA Championship (semi-final and final) hockey games in Detroit, MI at Joe Louis Arena (home of the Detroit Red Wings). Tickets must be ordered by March 15th (see the enclosure for pricing and date information). Orders will be filled and seat assignments will be made based on your Red & White Club membership first followed by season ticket holders. Miami reserves the right to limit ticket order quantities.

NCAA Regional (see order form for possible sites) – March 26th – 28th

Active Red & White Club members (as of February 24th) will have the first opportunity to request tickets for the NCAA Ice Hockey Regional, should Miami advance. All-session ticket prices (which includes three games) vary and are determined by the possible venues listed on the reverse side of the order form. Tickets will be sold and allocated based on annual giving levels to the Red & White Club as of February 24, 2010:

- \$2,500 and above = maximum of six (6) tickets per membership;
- \$1,000-\$2,499 = maximum of four (4) tickets per membership;
- \$100-\$999 = maximum of two (2) tickets per membership.

Regional ticket orders and Red & White Club memberships (if new or increased) must be paid in full by February 24th to make an order request. All orders will be confirmed, when filled. If tickets remain after all Red & White Club members have had the opportunity to order, current hockey season ticket holders will have the next order opportunity.

NCAA Frozen Four (Detroit, MI – Ford Field) – April 8th and 10th

Active Red & White Club members will have the first opportunity to request tickets for the NCAA Ice Hockey Frozen Four, should Miami advance. Tickets are \$189 each (an all-session ticket, which includes three games) to for the Frozen Four, located in Detroit, MI at Ford Field (home of the Detroit Lions). They will be sold and allocated based on annual giving levels to the Red & White Club as of February 24, 2010:

- \$2,500 and above = maximum of six (6) tickets per membership;
- \$1,000-\$2,499 = maximum of four (4) tickets per membership;
- \$250-\$999 = maximum of two (2) tickets per membership

Like the Regional ticket orders, Red & White Club memberships and the actual ticket order itself must be paid in full by February 24th to make an order request. All orders will be confirmed, when filled. ONLY active Red & White Club members will be able to request tickets for this round. Ticket orders will only be filled should Miami advance to this round of play.

Note: Miami University Athletics will only charge your ticket request once the team has advanced to that level of play.

MAC Tournament (Cleveland, OH) – March 10th – 13th

The Mid-American Conference has instituted a new format with institutions hosting games who do not receive a bye in the first round. Therefore, the top-four seeded teams will receive byes and move directly on to Cleveland. All other teams will either host a tournament game or travel to a conference opponent for the opportunity to play in Cleveland. The following information presumes a trip to Cleveland. Details on potential hosting of an earlier round is on the enclosed order form.

All Miami fans are afforded the opportunity to purchase tickets for postseason basketball. Tickets must be ordered by February 24th (see the enclosure for pricing and date information). Orders will be filled and seat assignments will be made based on your Red & White Club membership first followed by season ticket holders. Miami University reserves the right to limit ticket order quantities. While tickets are also available through Quicken Loans Arena, purchasing them through Miami ensures: 1. You are seated in the Miami section with other MU fans; 2. Financial support for Miami that otherwise goes elsewhere.

NCAA 1st and 2nd Rounds AND Regionals (numerous locations)—Beginning March 18th

Active Red & White Club members (as of February 24th) will have the first opportunity to request tickets for the NCAA Basketball 1st and 2nd Rounds and Regional, should Miami's women's and/or men's team advance. All-session ticket prices vary and are determined by the possible venues listed on the reverse side of the order form. Tickets will be sold and allocated based on annual giving levels to the Red & White Club as of February 24, 2010:

- \$2,500 and above = maximum of six (6) tickets per membership;
- \$1,000-\$2,499 = maximum of four (4) tickets per membership;
- \$100-\$999 = maximum of two (2) tickets per membership

First and 2nd Rounds, Regional ticket orders and Red & White Club memberships (if new or increased) must be paid in full by February 24th to make an order request. All orders will be confirmed, when filled. If tickets remain after all Red & White Club members have had the opportunity to order, current basketball season ticket holders will have the next order opportunity.

NCAA Final Four (men-Indianapolis, IN OR women-San Antonio, TX) – April 3rd and 5th OR April 4th and 6th

Active Red & White Club members will have the first opportunity to request tickets for the NCAA Final Four, should Miami advance. Only all-session tickets (which include three games) are available for the Final Four, located in Indianapolis, IN (men) or San Antonio, TX (women). They will be sold and allocated based on annual giving levels to the Red & White Club as of February 24, 2010:

- \$2,500 and above = maximum of six (6) tickets per membership;
- \$1,000-\$2,499 = maximum of four (4) tickets per membership;
- \$250-\$999 = maximum of two (2) tickets per membership

Like the 1st/2nd Rounds and Regional ticket orders, Red & White Club memberships, and the actual ticket order itself, must be paid in full by February 24th to make an order request. All orders will be confirmed, when filled. ONLY active Red & White Club members will be able to request tickets for this round. Ticket orders will only be filled should Miami advance to this round of play.

Note: Miami University Athletics will only charge your ticket request once the team has advanced to that level of play.
