Miami Heads to Florida For Spring Break Trip

After back-to-back weekends in the Carolinas, Miami heads to Florida for its annual spring break trip. The RedHawks will play eight games total over eight days, March 5-12.

The first four contests take place in the first three days. Miami faces Mount St. Mary's on Saturday, Lehigh in a doubleheader on Sunday and Yale on Monday.

The RedHawks evened their record at 3-3 this past weekend, winning two of three at the Hughes Bros. Tires Challenge. Victories came over West Virginia (12-5 on Friday) and Marist (8-1 on Sunday), while host UNC Wilmington captured a 7-3 decision on Saturday.

Kyle Weldon led the offensive charge, batting .667 with six RBIs in his two appearances. He hit a pair of solo home runs against the Seahawks and had a bases-loaded double in the finale. Bryan Beaver hit .500 in three

starts, driving in five runs. Overall, they are hitting .450 and .429, respectively.

On the mound, Tyler Melling continues to impress, holding a 2-0 record and 1.50 ERA. He has allowed just one run in each of his six-inning appearances and leads the team with 12 strikeouts.

Mac Thoreson (1-0, 3.46 ERA) stands second on the team in strikeouts with 10 in his 13.0 innings of work. The duo is holding opponents to batting averages of .205 and .213 respectively.

As good as the starting pitching has been, the RedHawks' bullpen has been even better. In six combined relief appearances (19.2 innings), Miami has allowed just two earned runs for a 0.92 ERA. Opponent have just 17 hits and eight walks, compared to 15 strikeouts and a .239 average.

Series Histories

Miami has never faced Mount St. Mary's in baseball, but has played the other two schools it will play in the early part of the week. In fact, the RedHawks shared the same spring break week last year with Yale and Lehigh defeating both of them.

A 14-3 win over the Mountain Hawks last March 9 evened the series at 1-1 all-time. Lehigh won the opener 10-4 in 2003.

Miami and Yale have split four games following a 14-10 on March 10 of last year.

A Carolina Split

Miami stands 3-3 after back-to-back trips to the Carolinas the last two weeks. The .500 start after six games is the second in three years and the fifth since 2002. That year, the RedHawks won four of their first six contests.

Coming out Party

Redshirt freshman Bryan Beaver had a big weekend in just his second, third and fourth career games. He batted .500 (five hits in 10 ABs) with five runs batted in. Against West Virginia last Friday, he earned his first multiple-hit game (three) with a triple and three RBIs.

Repeat Performers

A total of six RedHawks have started all six games this season. Ryan Brenner and Bryce Redeker are the outfielders on the list, while there are four players in the infield. Second baseman Jon Edgington, shortstop Ryan Kaup, third baseman Brad Gschwind and catcher Adam Weisenburger have six starts on the season.

Preseason Picks

Miami was tabbed second in the Mid-American Conference East Division in the annual preseason coaches' poll. The RedHawks received 53 points behind unanimous choice Kent State. Defending regular-season champion Central Michigan was the favorite to win the West Division.

The league coaches also chose a potential tournament champion with the RedHawks receiving one vote.

Ryan Brenner leads the club with nine stolen bases (on 11 tries), while Jon Edgington is a perfect five-for-five.
