Miami's 1955 team boasted the most dominant defense in Miami football history, surrendering just 47 points or a paltry 5.2 points per game through nine games. The Ara Parseghian-coached team, which went 9-0 and won the MAC Championship, blanked four opponents and allowed just two foes to score more than once.



In 1977, a Dick Crum-coached Miami team went 10-1 and captured the MAC Championship. On the season, the team ran a then-program record 871 plays from scrimmage, which stood until 2002, and rolled up 3,954 yards total offense, a record that stood until 1986.



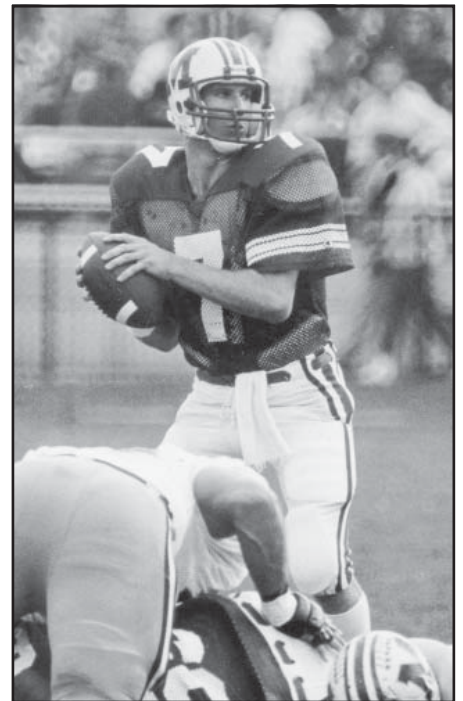
Miami's 2003 MAC Championship team, coached by Terry Hoepfner, crushed the program's previous standards for offense, averaging a whopping 501.1 yards of total offense and 43.0 points per game. The RedHawks' 7,016 yards of total offense for the season crushed the previous record by 2,134 yards. Miami's totals for total offense, scoring and passing yardage were also all MAC records.

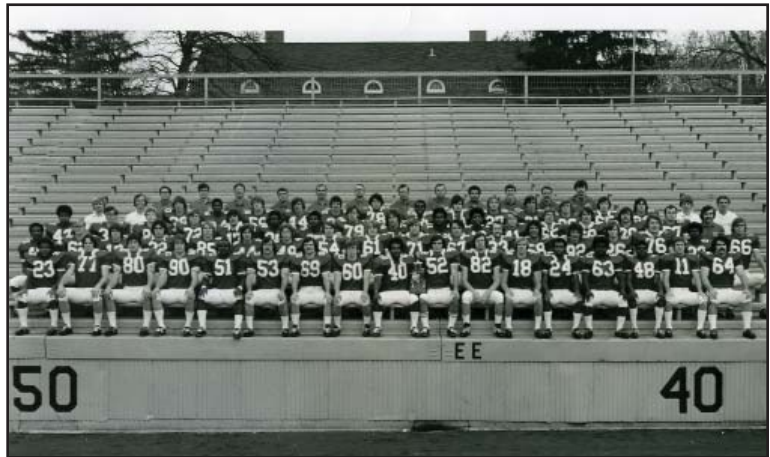

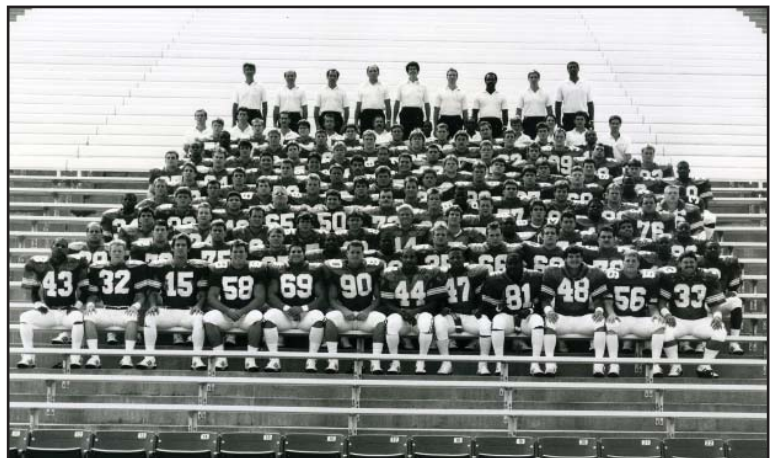
In 1986, Terry Morris led Miami to its 13th MAC 38 Championship by guiding the most efficient passing attack in program history at that time. As a team, Miami completed 195-of-320 passes for a .609 completion percentage. Morris boasted a .627 completion rate on his own. 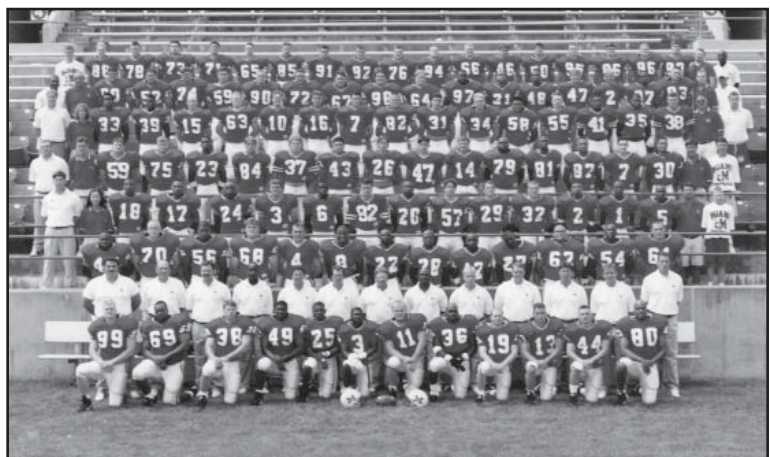

Miami's 1973 team restricted its opponents to a meager 161.3 yards of total offense per game on the way to a MAC Championship and the first of three Tangerine Bowl victories. The team blanked three opponents over the course of an 11-game season and allowed just 1.8 yards per rush.



In 1986, Miami forced a whopping 44 turnovers, including a program-best 23 fumbles, on the way to a MAC Championship and a berth in the California Bowl. The team, which also totaled 21 interceptions, forced an average of 3.7 turnovers per game.



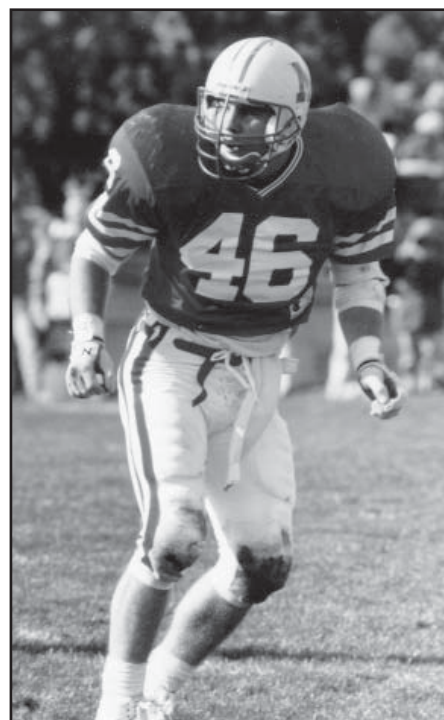

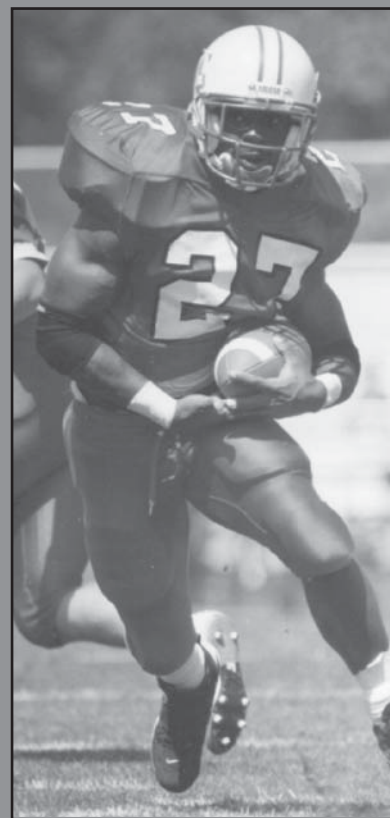
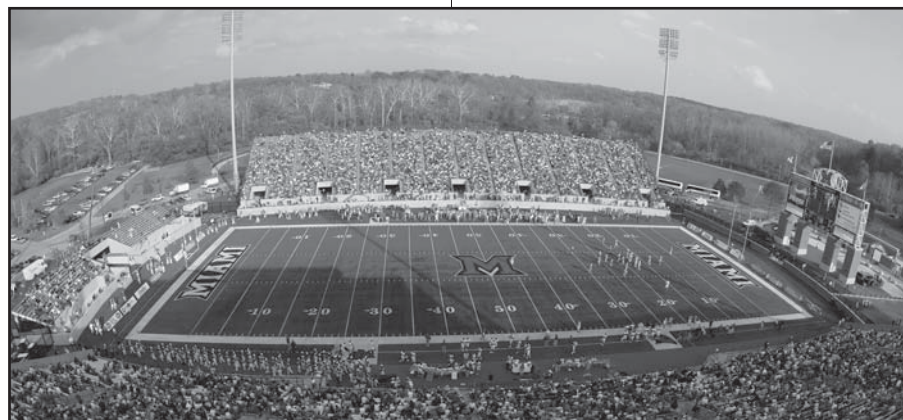
