2008-09 SEASON IN REVIEW



BASTEL AND WOOD TABBED ALL-AMERICA SCHOLARS AGAIN:

For the second consecutive year, seniors **Ben Wood** and **Ben Bastel** were named Cleveland Golf All-America Scholars by the Golf Coaches Association of America. Wood graduated with a degree in marketing at Miami, while Bastel earned his degree in finance.

NOT ONLY HONOR FOR BASTEL: Being a All-America Scholar was not the only major award Bastel won in 2009. At the conclusion of the Mid-American Conference Championships he was awarded the Earl Yestingsmeier Sportsman of the Year trophy, as voted on by his fellow MAC competitors. The Sportsman of the Year award recognizes the senior golfer whom other players most enjoy playing or conversing with; has good rapport with his own team; is supportive of his own team, but also respects the competition; makes players feel comfortable to be around him; commands respect and esteem rather than merely being popular and would consider to be worthy of representing men's intercollegiate golf to others.

SUTHERLAND EARNS GOLFER OF THE WEEK HONORS:

The Mid-American Conference office named sophomore **Nathan Sutherland** MAC Co-Golfer of the Week for his fifth place performance at the Pinehurst Intercollegiate March 15-17. It is the first weekly honor of Sutherland's career.

Sutherland shot 68 and 72 during the first two rounds of the tournament to finish in first place each day. That was especially impressive considering the tournament featured an elite field that included four Big Ten schools, as well as schools from the BIG EAST and ACC. He shot a 74 in the final round to finish at two-under par, alone in fifth place. The RedHawks as a team finished tied for ninth out of 20 schools.

REDHAWKS WIN 2008 GEORGETOWN INTERCOLLEGIATE:

Senior **Aaron Crist** fired 70-74=144 to finish in second place, while three other RedHawks finished among the top 20 to propel Miami University's golf team to a first-place finish among the 12-team field at the Georgetown Intercollegiate. This was Miami's first tournament win since seizing the Jim Colbert Intercollegiate Sept. 24-25, 2008. The RedHawks bettered second-place William & Mary by five strokes at the Georgetown Intercollegiate and third-place Richmond by a nine-stroke margin. The RedHawks had two others finish among the top 10. Sophomore **Nathan Sutherland** shot 73-74=147 for the tournament and tied for fourth place, while senior **Ben Bastel** shot 72-77=149 to tie for sixth place.
