2006-07 IS THE 29TH YEAR OF EXISTENCE FOR THE MIAMI HOCKEY PROGRAM

- THE REDHAWKS COMPETE IN THE CENTRAL COLLEGIATE HOCKEY ASSOCIATION (CCHA) ALONG WITH ALASKA, BOWLING GREEN, FERRIS STATE, LAKE SUPERIOR STATE, MICHIGAN, MICHIGAN STATE, NEBRASKA-OMAHA, NORTHERN MICHIGAN, NOTRE DAME, OHIO STATE, AND WESTERN MICHIGAN.
- MIAMI HAS WON TWO CCHA CHAMPIONSHIPS (1992-93 AND 2005-06) AND HAS APPEARED IN FOUR NCAA TOURNAMENTS (1992-93, 1996-97, 2003-04, AND 2005-06)
- HEAD COACH ENRICO BLASI IS THE PROGRAM'S ALL-TIME WINNINGEST COACH AND HAS CAPTURED CCHA COACH OF THE YEAR HONORS THREE TIMES ALONG WITH NATIONAL COACH OF THE YEAR IN 2005-06.
- DURING THE 2005-06 REGULAR SEASON, MIAMI HOCKEY ASCENDED TO No. 1 IN ALL THREE NATIONAL POLLS, A FIRST FOR MIAMI ATHLETICS.
- SOME MIAMIANS CURRENTLY PLAYING IN THE NHL INCLUDE KEVIN ADAMS '96 (CAROLINA), DAN BOYLE '98 (TAMPA BAY), RANDY ROBITAILLE '98 (PHILADELPHIA), PAY LEAHY '01 (NASHVILLE), MIKE GLUMAC '02 (ST. LOUIS), AND ANDY GREENE '06 (NEW JERSEY),
- THE HURRICANE'S KEVYN ADAMS '96 BECAME THE SECOND REDHAWK TO HAVE HIS NAME ENGRAVED ON THE STANLEY CUP, FOLLOWING IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF DAN BOYLE '98 (TAMPA BAY).
- THE NEW GOGGIN ICE CENTER, A STATE-OF-THE-ART 175,000 SQUARE-FOOT ICE ARENA, IS NOW IN ITS FIRST SEASON OF EXISTENCE.
 - SOME OF THE AMENITIES INCLUDE:
 - TWO NHL-SIZED ICE SHEETS
 - CAPACITY OF 4,000 IN THE MAIN ARENA
 - A VARSITY LOCKER ROOM THAT IS MODELED AFTER THE CURRENT TORONTO MAPLE LEAFS LOCKER ROOM
 - A PLAYER'S LOUNGE, EQUIPPED WITH TWO TELEVISIONS, AND COMFORTABLE SEATING AREAS FOR PLAYERS
 - A SECOND-TO-NONE VIDEO SYSTEM, ALLOWING COACHES AND PLAYERS TO WATCH GAME VIDEO WITH THE LATEST TECHNOLOGY
- THE 2006-07 REDHAWKS RETURN 21 PLAYERS FROM LAST SEASON INCLUDING THREE ALL-LEAGUE SELECTIONS (NATHAN DAVIS, RYAN JONES, MITCH GANZAK) AND THE CCHA'S BEST GOALTENDER (CHARLIE EFFINGER). IN ADDITION, SEVEN OF THE CURRENT REDHAWKS HAVE BEEN DRAFTED BY NHL TEAMS, INCLUDING JONES (MINNESOTA), DAVIS (CHICAGO), JEFF ZATKOFF (LOS ANGELES), JUSTIN MERCIER (COLORADO), MATT CHRISTIE (ANAHEIM), MARTY GUERIN (LOS ANGELES), AND JOE COOPER (OTTAWA).

FOUNDED IN 1809, MIAMI IS THE SEVENTH-OLDEST STATE ASSISTED UNIVERSITY IN THE UNITED STATES.

- MIAMI UNIVERSITY IS COMMITTED TO UNDERGRADUATE EDUCATION
 - 104 BACHELOR DEGREES AVAILABLE
 - A FULL-TIME STUDENT TO FULL-TIME FACULTY RATIO OF 18-1
 - AVERAGE CLASS SIZE OF 24
 - SENIOR FACULTY TEACH FIRST-YEAR COURSES
- MIAMI UNIVERSITY IS RECOGNIZED BY MANY NATIONAL MEDIA PUBLICATIONS
 - THE *FISKE GUIDE TO COLLEGES 2005* AWARDED MIAMI 4.5 STARS FOR ACADEMICS (OUT OF A POSSIBLE FIVE-STAR RANKING), PRAISING MIAMI AS A "RISING STAR AMONG STATE UNIVERSITIES."
 - THE 2007 *U.S. NEWS & WORLD REPORT* COLLEGE RANKINGS LISTS MIAMI UNIVERSITY 21ST AMONG THE TOP PUBLIC UNIVERSITIES IN THE NATION BASED ON ACADEMIC QUALITY.
 - MIAMI WAS NAMED ONE OF 30 SCHOOLS IN THE UNITED STATES THAT OFFERS "AN EDUCATION COMPARABLE TO THAT AT IVY LEAGUE UNIVERSITIES AT A FRACTION OF THE PRICE" IN THE BOOK *THE PUBLIC IVIES: AMERICA'S FLAGSHIP UNIVERSITIES*.
 - MIAMI'S RICHARD T. FARMER SCHOOL OF BUSINESS IS THE SEVENTH-RANKED PUBLIC BUSINESS SCHOOL IN THE NATION.
- ACCORDING TO NCAA DATA, MIAMI'S GRADUATION RATES ARE AMONG THE HIGHEST NATIONALLY, NINTH AMONG NCAA DIVISION I PUBLIC UNIVERSITIES (80 PERCENT), AND FIRST IN OHIO. (2005)
- 41 PERCENT OF 2005 FRESHMAN RANKED IN THE TOP 10 PERCENT OF THEIR HIGH-SCHOOL CLASS.
- OF ALL QUALIFIED STUDENTS APPLYING TO MEDICAL SCHOOL, 67 PERCENT OF MIAMI STUDENTS ARE ACCEPTED, COMPARED TO 50 PERCENT NATIONALLY.
- 25 PERCENT OF 2005 FRESHMEN SCORED BETWEEN 30-36 ON THE ACT, WHILE 50 PERCENT SCORED BETWEEN 25-29.
- SOME NOTABLE MIAMI ALUMS INCLUDE THE 23RD PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, BENJAMIN HARRISON 1852, CURRENT PRESIDENT OF SMUCKER'S BRAND FOODS, RICHARD SMUCKER '70, AND CHAIRMAN AND CEO OF NESTLE, BRAD ALFORD '78.
