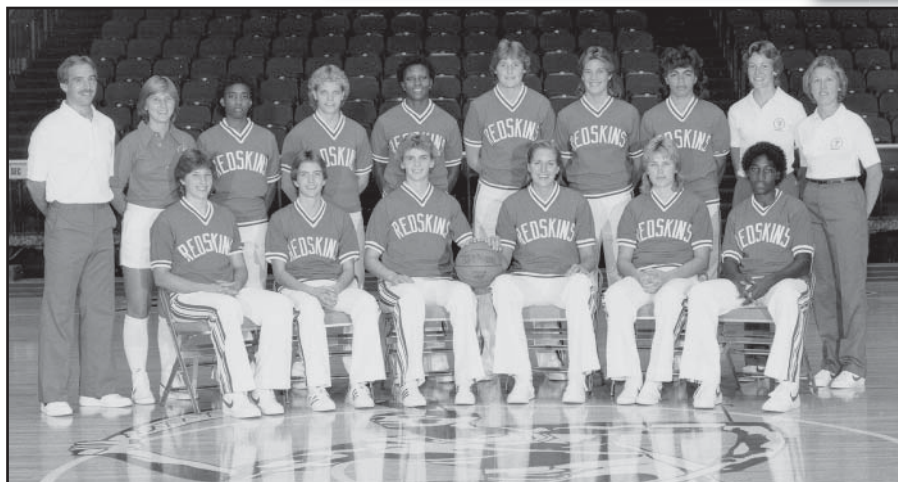

MARY ANN MYERS
(1978-82)

Former Miami basketball great Mary Ann Myers ('82) was the first female athlete in school history to have her jersey retired. After finishing her career as Miami's all-time leading scorer with 1,600 points, the Miami Athletic Advisory Board voted to

retire Myers' No. 20 in the spring of 1982.

Though she played in the early days of Miami's women's basketball program, Myers' marks have stood the test of time. The native of Swannanoa, N.C., still ranks among Miami's all-time top three in points (3rd-1,600), field goals (2nd-594), free throws (2nd-412), steals (1st-409) and 20-point games (2nd-18). Her records for career and single-season steals (124) stand as two of the most imposing records in the Miami annals and have never seriously been challenged in the 23 seasons since Myers' remarkable career concluded.

During the 1981-82 campaign, Myers set herself apart with a remarkable season in which she tallied a Miami season record of 524 points while nabbing 97 steals. Myers' efforts led the Red and White to the first Mid-American Conference Championship and an appearance in the Association of Intercollegiate Athletics for Women (IAAW) Tournament Quarterfinals (the NCAA Women's Tournament began the following year), which was Miami's only appearance in a national postseason tournament until 2003-04. Along the way, Myers and her teammates won 13 consecutive games and a program-record 24 games overall.

A two-time first-team all-MAC selection, the 5-foot-4 point guard was named to the IAAW Kodak All-Region 5 team, as well as the Midwest Regional all-tournament team. She was named Miami's Female Athlete of the Year in 1982 and was inducted into Miami's Athletic Hall of Fame in 1989.



HEATHER CUSICK
(1999-2003)

One of the most successful and durable players in Miami women's basketball history, Heather Cusick finished her RedHawk career ranked among Miami's top five all-time in 11 of the 15 categories tracked by Miami Athletic Media

Relations and is the only player in program history to earn all-MAC recognition in each of her four seasons.

An honorable mention all-MAC and MAC all-freshman honoree during her rookie campaign, Cusick assumed Miami's starting point guard duties just three games into her career and would never relinquish the responsibility. Over four seasons, Cusick appeared in 116 contests—never missing a game—and made 113 consecutive starts.

She was twice named honorable mention all-MAC and twice honored as a first-team all-league selection. During a remarkable junior season in which she tied Miami's single-season scoring record while averaging a program-record 17.5 points per game, Cusick was honored as the 2002 MAC Player of the Year—only the second Miami player to earn such an honor. As a senior, Cusick, who led the Red and White to its first MAC East Division title, finished second in voting for the MAC's Player of the Year and earned Kodak/WBCA All-Region accolades.

Cusick, a Kokomo, Ind., native, finished her career as Miami's all-time leader in career points (1,728), field goals (604), 3-point field goals (230), assists (596) and 20-point games (32).

In the history of the MAC no player has been able to match the versatility of Cusick, who is the only player in league history to amass 1,700 points, 500 assists, 400 rebounds, 300 steals and 200 3-point field goals.

Cusick's jersey was retired in 2003, making her the second Miami women's basketball player to earn the honor.





KRIS LIVINGSTON
(1979-83)



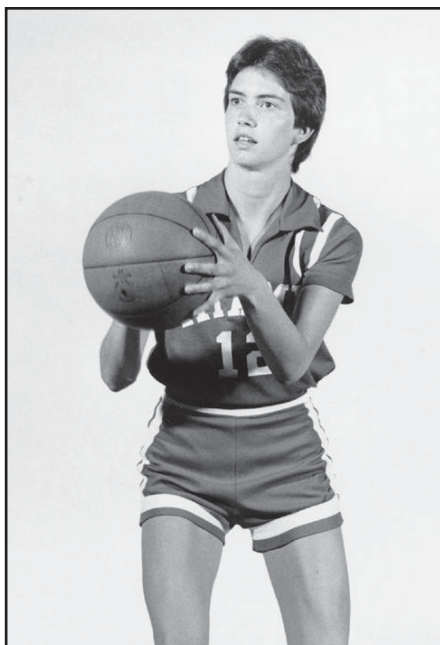
Kris Livingston, a four-year letterwinner in women's basketball from 1979-83, was only the second women's basketball athlete to be inducted into Miami's

Athletic Hall of Fame. Livingston was inducted on August 30, 1997.

Livingston still ranks among Miami's career leaders in three different career categories. She currently ranks sixth at Miami in career scoring (1,226), ninth in career field goal percentage (.489) and seventh in career steals (211).

Livingston, a Millbury, Ohio, native, was a first-team all-MAC selection as a junior and earned academic all-conference recognition as a senior.

Miami posted an 81-41 record during her four years, including a 45-15 mark and two MAC championships her last two seasons. During the 1981-82 season, Livingston was a key part of a team that advanced to the AIAW National Quarterfinals—one of only two Miami teams to advance to a national postseason tournament.



JULIE HOWELL
(1988-92)



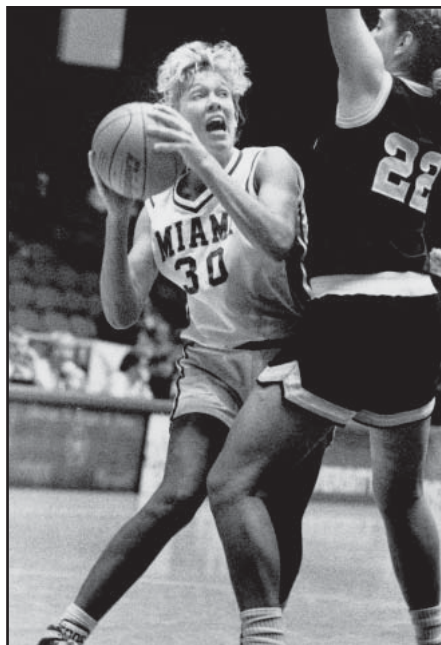
Julie Howell was an imposing figure in the Miami post from 1988-92, scoring 1,227 points and snaring more than 600 rebounds while becoming one of just seven Miami players

to merit first-team all-MAC status during her career.

A first-team all-MAC honoree in 1992 and second-team all-league honoree in 1991, Howell was part of Miami's 1989-90 MAC Championship team. A South Lyon, Mich., native, Howell still ranks statistically among the top interior players in program history, ranking among Miami's all-time Top 10 in nine different categories.

A dangerous shooter from both the floor and the free throw line, Howell's .510 career field goal percentage ranks fifth all-time at Miami, while her .835 free throw percentage ranks second all-time. Howell also ranks seventh all-time in scoring (1,227), seventh in rebounding (600) and seventh in blocked shots (66).

She was inducted into Miami's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2004.



MONICA NIEMANN
(1991-95)



Miami basketball great Monica Niemann helped put excitement into Miami basketball in the 1990's.

A four-year starter at forward from 1991-95, Niemann

finished her career as Miami's all-time leading scorer and rebounder. Niemann's 1,608 points currently rank second all-time in the Miami annals, while her 923 rebounds still stand as an imposing record. Niemann, a Cincinnati native, also ranks among Miami's career leaders for field goals (4th/577); field goals attempted (3rd/1,219); free throws (1st/450); free throws attempted (1st/609); steals (3rd/284); and blocked shots (6th/66).

During Niemann's tenure, Miami advanced to four MAC tournaments. Niemann, a first-team all-MAC honoree in 1995, was named to three all-Mid-American Conference tournament teams along the way.

Niemann received the Leann Grimes Davidge Memorial Award for excellence in 1994-95. She is a member of Miami's 2005 Hall of Fame class.

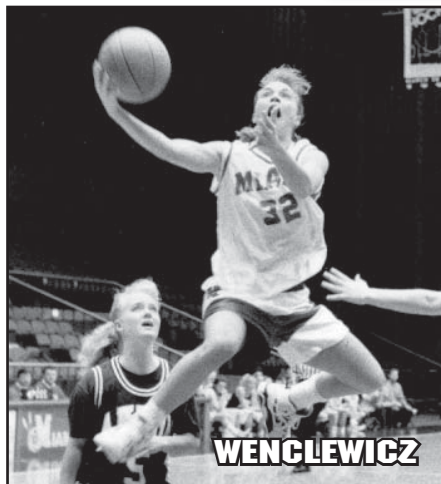

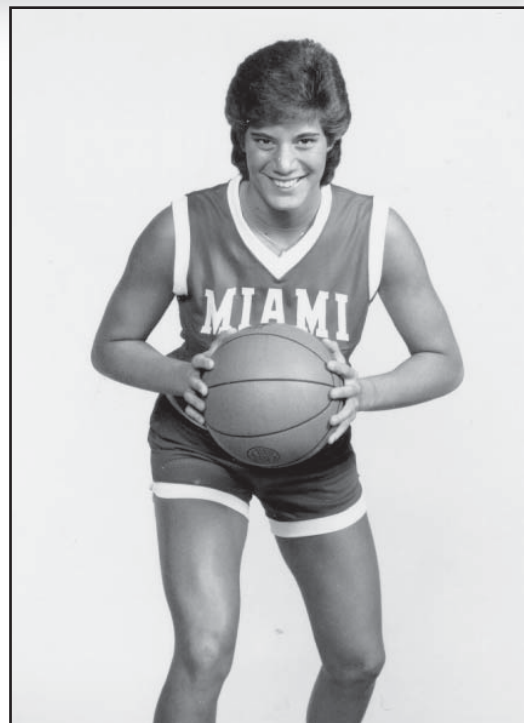
LINDA MALLENDER - 1983 THIRD-TEAM WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NEWS ALL-AMERICAN

Linda Mallender is the first Miami women's basketball player to be named an All-American, earning third-team plaudits from Women's Basketball News in 1983.

During that memorable season, Mallender led Miami to a 21-6 overall record, including a near-perfect 17-1 MAC record, and a regular-season MAC Championship. The Red and White won a program-record 14 consecutive contests until falling to Central Michigan in the MAC Championship game. During the course of the year, she was named MAC Player of the Week three times during the season.

Mallender also etched her name all over the Miami single-season record books, contributing top 10 single-season performances for points (499), assists (140), field goals made (211), field goal percentage (.566), steals (85) and blocked shots (39). Her 499 points still stand as Miami's sophomore scoring record.

Mallender, a first-team all-MAC selection, was the first Miami player to be named MAC Player of the Year and stood as the only Miamian to be named league MVP until Heather Cusick captured the award in 2002.



COLLEEN DAY - 2005 SECOND-TEAM COSIDA ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICA

Colleen Day became the first Miami player to earn Academic All-American status during her senior campaign in 2003-04. A stellar performer on the court and in the classroom, she also went on to be named Miami's Female Scholar-Athlete of the Year.

A three-time team captain, Day guided Miami to its first Mid-American Conference championship in 14 years by leading the RedHawks in scoring and rebounding. Miami posted a 22-9 record and 14-2 league mark on the season, including a 12-game conference winning streak. Day went on to lead the RedHawks in their first Postseason WNIT appearance, as the Red and White advanced to the second round.

Among her honors, Day was twice named MAC East Player of the Week and twice named MAC Scholar-Athlete of the Week on the way to first-team all-MAC and academic all-MAC plaudits. She was runner-up for MAC Player of the Year. Day, who was a third-team CoSIDA All-District IV honoree as a sophomore, was a first-team honoree in 2004 and went on to earn CoSIDA Academic All-America Second-Team honors.

Statistically, Day ranked fifth on Miami's single-season scoring charts (465) and third in rebounding (259). She totaled eight 20-point games and eight double-doubles during the season.
