## STORYLINES



**1. UP AHEAD:** Miami will make the quick trip to the Nutter Center to take on local rival Wright State Wednesday at 7 p.m. Bill Douglas has the call, and it can be heard on the Miami Sports Network Internet Channel ([www.miamisportsnetwork.com](http://www.miamisportsnetwork.com)).

**2. BALANCED SCORING:** The RedHawks have received scoring contributions from several sources this season, with seven players currently averaging 5.0 points per game or greater. In Miami's first five games, the team has had four different leading scorers, with only sophomore guard **Courtney Osborn** leading the team in scoring twice. Osborn (14.0 points per game) and junior guard **Maggie Boyer** (11.0 points per game) are the only two RedHawks averaging in double figures, but junior guard/forward **Rachael Hencke** (9.8), sophomore forward **Kirsten Olowinski** (8.6) and freshman guard **Hannah Robertson** (8.6) are each very close to reaching it.

**3. SUCCESS IN OHIO NON-CONFERENCE EDITION:** While the MAC boasts six schools (including Miami) from the state of Ohio, there are seven other NCAA Division I schools located throughout the state. The RedHawks boast an impressive 70-51 (.578) record in their nonconference action all-time against Ohio schools. That includes a 19-4 record against Wright State, 7-0 vs. Cleveland State, 5-2 vs. Youngstown State, 10-7 vs. Xavier 13-15 vs. Cincinnati, 13-16 vs. Dayton and 3-7 vs. Ohio State. When you add in the MAC Ohio schools, Miami is 230-189 (.549) all-time in Division I games against the state.

### WRIGHT STATE

**LAST GAME:** Miami jumped out to a 47-22 first-half lead and turned away a Stetson run in the second half to take a 77-60 win Saturday at Millett Hall. The RedHawks (2-3) improved to 3-0 all-time against the Hatters (1-3).

In the first half, the RedHawks hit 50 percent of their field goals, including 70 percent from beyond the arc, making 7-10 from long range. On the other end of the floor, the Red and White held Stetson to just 26.1 percent field goal shooting.

In addition to the hot shooting, the RedHawks dominated on the glass all game, grabbing 41 rebounds, led by sophomore Kirsten Olowinski's 14, to the Hatters' 25. In the first half alone, Olowinski had almost as many rebounds (10) as the entire Stetson team (11).

Four RedHawks scored in double-figures, led by sophomore Courtney Osborn's 17 points. Juniors Rachael Hencke and Maggie Boyer added 13 and 12, respectively, and freshman Hannah Robertson chipped in 11 - nine of which came in the second half. Osborn also led the Miami defense as she made a career-high six steals.

Freshman Kelsey Simon made the first basket of her Miami career when she hit a short jumper at the first-half buzzer to put the RedHawks up by 25 heading into the locker room.

The RedHawks stretched the lead to 29 points at 53-24 two minutes into the second half, but Stetson switched to a full-court press and used a 20-5 run to cut into the Miami lead and make it 58-44 with 10:48 to go.

A steal and breakaway layup by Junior Lillian Pitts with 8:56 to play ended a three-minute Miami scoring drought and sparked the RedHawks to a 12-0 run over the next four minutes to secure the win.

**ABOUT THE RAIDERS:** Wright State is 2-2 on the season. The Raiders are coming off a 91-61 defeat to Dayton on Wednesday. They previously played a MAC team on Nov. 14, when they fell to Ball State, 64-63. Wright State is led by senior guard LaShawna Thomas. She is averaging 16.0 points per game. Junior forward Molly Fox has also been a significant contributor to the stat sheet. She is averaging a double-double, with 11.5 points and 10.8 rebounds per game.

**THE SERIES WITH WRIGHT STATE:** Miami has dominated the series with the Raiders, leading 19-4. However, Wright State defeated the RedHawks in their last meeting, 75-68, on Dec. 9, 2009. Courtney Osborn scored a then career-high 26 points, while, Kirsten Olowinski recorded 14 points and eight rebounds, but it was not enough to overcome a 53 percent shooting night from the Raiders.

**MIAMI VS. HORIZON LEAGUE:** The Horizon League is made up of 10 schools in the same geographical footprint as the MAC. With so many of the schools located rela-

## Head Coach Maria Fantanarosa

Head coach **Maria Fantanarosa** begins her 13th year in charge of Miami women's basketball. She leads a youthful but talented team that is looking to regain its position at the top of the MAC.

Since returning to her alma mater as head coach prior to the 1998-99 season, Fantanarosa has guided a resurgent program to nine winning seasons in the past 12 years, including two Mid-American Conference East Division crowns, the 2003-04 MAC regular-season championship and the 2008 MAC Tournament championship.



Fantanarosa became Miami's all-time winningest coach in program history with her 132nd win, an 87-79 victory over IUPUI on Dec. 30, 2006, passing Pam Wettig, who previously held the mark with a career record of 131-103. Fantanarosa's all-time record at Miami now stands at 188-173.

Critical to the program's success has been an impressive recruiting effort that has brought six of the program's top 10 career scoring leaders, as well as four of the top 10 career rebounding leaders to campus during her tenure. Under her tutelage, Miami has produced 45 MAC Players of the Week, 18 all-MAC selections, six MAC All-Freshman honorees, one MAC Player of the Year in Heather Cusick (2002), one MAC Tournament MVP in Amanda Jackson (2008) and last season, the program's first MAC Freshman of the Year in Courtney Osborn.

Fantanarosa's RedHawks have been consistently recognized for their outstanding achievements and contributions on and off the court. As a result, Director of Athletics Brad Bates recently extended Fantanarosa's contract through the 2013-14 season, noting that the mentor of the Red and White continues to attract and produce high-quality student-athletes.

Fantanarosa insists her players take advantage of all Miami has to offer academically. Since she has been in charge, six players have been named Academic All-MAC and two have earned CoSIDA Academic All-District honors. In 2004, senior Colleen Day became the first RedHawk to win a major national academic honor when she was named to the CoSIDA Academic All-America Second-Team.

A fiery competitor as both a player and a coach for the Red and White, Fantanarosa has been instrumental in directing the dramatic turnaround of a program that was coming off its first losing season in 10 years when she was hired in the summer of 1998.

Since taking the reins in 1998, Miami has been one of the most consistent powers in the Mid-American Conference, winning an impressive 104 conference games and finishing among the top three in the MAC East Division in all but four seasons.

The pinnacle arrived in 2003-04, when Miami stormed through the league by reeling off 12-straight wins in the heart of the MAC season and capturing the overall MAC Championship. Fantanarosa was named MAC Coach of the Year, and the program made its first appearance in the Postseason WNIT, where they advanced to the second round of the tournament.

With an 11-9 record after 20 games in the 2007-08 season, the RedHawks caught fire and won nine of their final 10 regular-season contests to earn the third seed in the MAC Tournament. The momentum continued as Miami battled for close victories in the quarterfinals and semifinals over Western Michigan and Toledo. In the championship game, MAC Tournament MVP Amanda Jackson scored 19 points to lead the RedHawks to a 67-56 victory over Ohio and a spot in the NCAA Tournament. Earning a No. 13 seed, Miami would battle tough against fourth seeded Louisville in the first round, eventually falling, 81-67.

In her 12 seasons, Fantanarosa's Miami squads have battled to a 186-170 (.522) overall record and 104-88 (.542) league mark. In addition to being the career wins leader at Miami, she ranks among the MAC's top 10 in career league wins.

No stranger to awards and honors, Fantanarosa's playing career is marked with numerous accomplishments. With the Red and White she was twice named an All-MAC performer. Known for her competitiveness, Fantanarosa remains among Miami's top 10 career assist leaders (323) and ranks 15th on the all-time scoring list with 1,086 points.

During a prolific prep career at Mt. Carmel Area High School, Fantanarosa set Pennsylvania state records for most points in a career - male or female - (3,823) and most points in a single season (1,318). That career mark still ranks 13th nationally among all girls. The single-season mark was the second-best total nationally among girls at the time, and still ranks eighth today. She was inducted into the Pennsylvania Sports Hall of Fame in the fall of 2005.

A native of Kulpmont, Pa., Fantanarosa earned her bachelor's degree in speech communication with a minor in coaching science from Miami in 1990. She received her master's degree in sports administration from Xavier in 1993. Fantanarosa and her husband Tim Morrow have two daughters, Lauren (eight) and Allison (five).

tively close to Miami, the RedHawks will often schedule them for non-conference tilts. Miami is an impressive 53-13 all-time against Horizon League schools. In addition to the 19-4 record against Wright State, the RedHawks are 10-3 vs. Butler, 7-0 vs. Cleveland State, 3-2 vs. Detroit, 1-0 vs. Green Bay, 0-1 vs. Loyola, 1-1 vs. Milwaukee, 1-0 vs. UIC, 6-0 vs. Valparaiso and 5-2 vs. Youngstown State.

**UP NEXT FOR THE REDHAWKS:** While the game against the Raiders is the RedHawks only contest this week, next week will prove to be challenging with three games in six days. It starts on Monday, Dec. 6 when Miami hosts former MAC rival Marshall for a 7 p.m. game. On Thursday, Dec. 9, the RedHawks will travel to Indiana for a 7 p.m. tip against the Hoosiers. The week concludes on Saturday, Dec. 11 back at Millett Hall when Miami welcomes Cal State Bakersfield across the country for a 2 p.m. game.

**OSBORN PICKS UP WHERE SHE LEFT OFF:** After a record setting freshman campaign, sophomore guard **Courtney Osborn** (Fishers, Ind.) has had a strong start to the 2010-11 season. She is the team's leading scorer with 14.6 points per game and also leads the team with 21 assists and 10 steals. Against No. 9/10 Kentucky (Nov. 14), she led the team with 18 points and six rebounds. She set a career high with 12 assists in the victory over Eastern Kentucky (Nov. 17). In her last game, Osborn scored 17 points in a win over Stetson (Nov. 27) and had a career-high six steals.

**OLOWINSKI ON THE BOARDS:** With mostly sophomores and freshmen making up the rotation last season, the Miami RedHawks struggled on the glass. Last year's team was outrebounded by an average of 6.4 caroms per game and gave up an average of nearly 16 offensive rebounds per game. This season, Miami is the one outrebounding its opponents. It is doing so by an average of 2.4 caroms per game through five games. One of the main reasons for that is sophomore forward **Kirsten Olowinski** (Erie, Pa.). She is leading the team with an average of 10.5 rebounds per game. That includes a team leading 14 against Eastern Kentucky (Nov. 17), 12 against Miami (Nov. 20) and 14 against Stetson (Nov. 27). Olowinski has also continued to improve as a scoring threat, as she ranks fourth on the team with an average of 8.6 points per game.

**TWINS BREAKOUT:** One of the positives of the game against Duquesne (Nov. 24) was the performance of the freshmen Robertson twins. **Hannah Robertson** (New Albany, Ohio) led the RedHawks with 13 points on 6-for-13 shooting. She also had six rebounds in 29 minutes of action. **Haley Robertson** (New Albany, Ohio) joined her sister in double-figures with 10 points in 28 minutes of action. She also contributed a team-high seven rebounds and five steals. Hannah continued her strong play in the last game against Stetson (Nov. 27). She scored 11 points and had three assists in 22 minutes against the Hatters.

**OSBORN AND BOYER NEAR TOP 50 IN SCORING:** Despite still being relatively early in their respective Miami careers, junior guard **Maggie Boyer** (Lebanon, Ind.) and sophomore guard **Courtney Osborn** (Fishers, Ind.) are both close to entering Miami women's basketball's all-time top 50 scoring list. Boyer is the career leader in points scored among active RedHawks with 595. Osborn is right behind her with 586 career points scored. **Stephanie Ford** (2005-09) and **Amy Franz** (1984-88) are currently tied for 50th in school history with 605 points scored during their careers.

**PLUS MINUS STATS:** As statistics gathering has gotten more advanced over the years, one of the new ways of analyzing a player's performance is their plus-minus rating. The plus-minus rating measures how many points are scored while they are on the court, as well as how many are given up. It is not a perfect way of analyzing performance, as it does not take into account any opponent factors (i.e., were the starters or the bench in for the opposition, it might be easier to for a player to score when the other team's best player is sitting on the bench). It does give a very general look as to how effective a team is in both scoring and defense when that particular player is on the floor, as well as which lineup combinations are best at scoring and which hold the

opposition down.

The losses against Miami (Fla.) and Duquesne hurt the RedHawks in plus-minus overall. The Red and White will use their remaining non-conference games to try and get back on the plus side of the category. The team has been most successful this season when **Kristin Judson** (Bloomington, Ill.) is on the court. During the 71:12 she has played, the RedHawks have scored 127 points, while they have given up 133. That gives her a plus-minus rating of -6. The most effective lineup combination so far has been one featuring Judson, Courtney Osborn, Maggie Boyer, Lillian Pitts and Hannah Robertson. As a group they have been on the court for 4:14. They have scored 20 points, while allowing only 11 for a plus-minus rating of +9.

**NEW PLAYERS:** Four freshmen join Miami for the 2010-11 season. For the first time in school history, the RedHawks welcome identical twins to the women's basketball program in **Hannah** and **Haley Robertson** (New Albany, Ohio). Both players were McDonald's All-America nominees, while Hannah was named First-Team All-Ohio in 2010. Haley was named District 10 Co-Player of the Year in 2010. **Erica Almaday** (Cleveland, Ohio) experienced tremendous success during high school career. After leading Lakota West to the runner-up position in the state championship in 2008, she moved to Cleveland and enrolled in the Hathaway Brown School. Rounding out the freshman class is center **Kelsey Simon** (Vernon Hills, Ill. ).

**INTERESTING BACKGROUND FOR SIMON:** Basketball success is abundant in freshman center **Kelsey Simon's** family. Her father, Cliff Livingston, played in the NBA for four teams from 1982-95 and won two NBA Championships with the Chicago Bulls (1990-92). Her brother, David Simon, was a four-year letterwinner in basketball for IPFW and has played in the European Pro-A League since 2005. Simon herself set the career record for blocks at Stevenson High School.

**WHAT'S BACK--THE STATISTICAL STORY:** Miami returns six letterwinners this season, all of whom were significant contributors to the stat column in 2009-10. The RedHawks return 77.2 percent of their scoring, 61.2 percent of their rebounding, 71.5 percent of their assists, 83.0 percent of their blocks and 67.4 percent of their steals from a season ago.

**FANTANAROSA NEARING 200 WINS:** Head Coach Maria Fantanarosa has a 188-173 record at Miami and is only 12 wins away from becoming the first women's basketball coach in school history to reach 200. She personally is approaching 200 wins as a coach when you add in her one season at Western Carolina. Her overall record of 195-193 puts her only five wins away from her overall 200th victory.
