2006 REDHAWK FIELD HOCKEY (1-1, 0-0 MAC)

HIT THE ROAD: Miami takes to the road for the first time this season after opening the 2006 campaign with a pair of home contests last weekend. Miami travels to the University of Louisville to take on the host Cardinals on Friday at 3 p.m., before battling Dartmouth on Saturday at 1 p.m.

WEEKEND RECAP: The RedHawks opened the season with a convincing 3-1 victory over Northwestern in the season opener for both teams. Senior **Danielle Perrecone** scored Miami's first goal of the season and assisted on her team's second of the season, which was scored by freshman **Mary Hull**. Sophomore **Elizabeth Gilroy** found the back of the cage with Miami's third goal of the game.

1....2....3....: Miami's first three goals of the season, all in the first game of the year, were scored in order by the players wearing jerseys No. 1, 2, and 3. Senior **Danielle Perrecone**, who wears No. 1, scored the first goal of the season. Freshman **Mary Hull**, who wears No. 2, scored Miami's second goal, before No. 3, **Elizabeth Gilroy**, tallied Miami's third of the game.

PROTECTING HER HOUSE: Freshman goalkeeper **Kelsey Dean** made her collegiate debut in Miami's season-opening 3-1 win over Northwestern, and looked solid in making nine saves to earn the victory. Five of those nine saves came in the second half, including two saves on penalty corners that look destined to find the back of the cage.

TOP OF THE HEAP: In a preseason poll of the Mid-American Conference's head coaches, the Miami RedHawks were tabbed to finish first in the MAC in 2006. Ohio University was predicted to finish second, with Central Michigan, Kent State, Ball State and Missouri State rounding out third through sixth, respectively.

NATIONAL RECOGNITION: For the first time in head coach **Jill Reeve's** tenure at Miami University, the field hockey program received votes in the STX National Coaches Poll, garnering 13 votes in this year's preseason poll. The RedHawks were one of only two MAC schools to land in the poll, with Ohio University earning four votes. Maryland is the No. 1-ranked team in the nation as the 2006 season pushes off this weekend.

STEADY PROGRESS: In 2004, head coach **Jill Reeve** inherited a team that went 1-17 in the year prior to her arrival, including a 0-10 record in MAC play. In the two short seasons since taking over the helm, Reeve's RedHawks have been transformed into

a contender for the MAC title and have placed Miami's field hockey program on the national radar. In 2004, her first season at Miami, Reeve guided the Red and White to a 7-14 record, with the seven wins being one more than the three seasons prior to her arrival combined. Last year, Miami went 5-5 in MAC play, beating each team in the conference once, and advanced to the MAC Tournament final for the first time in program history.

ALL-CONFERENCE RETURNERS: Four RedHawks earned all-MAC status last year and three of those players are back in Oxford for the 2006 season. Junior **Alyssa Nye (Bernville, Pa.)** was a first-team selection as a sophomore after leading Miami in scoring with 20 points on six goals and eight assists. Classmate **Taylor Florence (Louisville, Ky.)** was a second-team performer and was joined by senior **Danielle Perrecone (Carlsbad, Calif.)**. Miami also had three players earn All-MAC Tournament plaudits, including sophomores **Teja Kammler (Telford, Pa.)** and **Courtney Fretz (Oley, Pa.)** helped the Red and White to the MAC Tournament title tilt for the first time in program history.

A NEW STAFF: The Miami field hockey program welcomes three new assistant coaches for the 2006 season. **Katie Kanara** joins the RedHawks after one season at Saint Louis. **Amrit Chima**, a 2003 graduate of Stanford is Miami's second assistant, while **Maggie Giddens** has joined the staff as a volunteer assistant while she pursues her master's degree in physical education, health and sports studies.

A NEW HOME: During the summer of 2006, Miami's received a \$1.25 million upgrade to its field hockey facility, giving the RedHawks one of the finest fields in the nation. Dedicated solely to field hockey, the complex received new turf, a press box and new lights. Saturday's game versus Northwestern will be the first game played on the new surface.

THE SERIES WITH LOUISVILLE: The RedHawks and Cardinals have met 35 times with Miami owning a 23-12 edge. The last meeting between the teams came in 2004 with UL winning 2-1.
