2007 MIAMI SOFTBALL

2006 SEASON RECAP: Despite narrowly missing the Mid-American Conference Tournament, Miami (21-34; 7-15 MAC) wrapped up its 2006 season by posting its fourth straight season with more than 20 wins. Miami also set three offensive records, including new team benchmarks in home runs and runs-batted in.

TEAM RECORDS: Miami set three offensive records during the 2006 season, one individual and two team records. Junior **Leslie Macedo** set a new Miami single-season record with 37 runs-batted in, and the RedHawks also set new team records with 33 home runs and 188 runs-batted in. Miami also ended the season with a .277 batting average, its highest since the 1991 season. This season was a dramatic turnaround from the 2005 season when Miami batted .231 with 11 home runs and 122 RBIs.

RECORD-SETTING BOMB SQUAD: With two home runs against Toledo (April 14), Miami broke the school record of 27 home runs set in the 2003 season. Junior **Leslie Macedo** hit Miami's 27th four-bagger of the season with her first-inning blast in a 10-2 win over the Rockets, and sophomore **Breanna Robinson** clubbed the record-breaking home run with a third-inning solo shot in a 5-1 loss to the Toledo. Miami finished with 33 home runs during the 2006 campaign, with 11 of Miami's 13 position players hitting at least one home run.

RECORD-SETTING RUN PRODUCERS: With five RBIs in a 6-5 loss to Buffalo (May 6), Miami broke the team record of 186 RBIs set in the 1991 season. Miami tied the team record in the top of the fifth against the Bulls when senior **Kristen Hays** singled up the middle and scored freshman **Ashley Gartland**. Sophomore **Natalie Savona** then provided the record-breaking hit with a two-out, two-run home run in the top of the sixth over the scoreboard at Buffalo's Nan Harvey Field.

TOURNEY TEAMS: Miami finished the 2006 season with three wins over NCAA Tournament teams, the most notable being a 1-0 win over Atlantic Coast Conference Regular Season and Tournament Champion North Carolina State (Feb. 11) at the Auburn Tiger Invitational. Miami also defeated Southern Conference Tournament Champion Georgia Southern, 8-7, on March 3 at the Buzz Classic, and its final win over a national tournament team was a 6-5, eight-inning win over Ohio State (April 19), which earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament.

LEAVING HER MARK: One of the top hurlers in Miami history, senior **Courtney Salmon** left her mark on the Miami career pitching charts during her four seasons in the Red and White. Salmon ended her career ranked among the top five in eight of the nine career pitching



categories. Salmon finished her career ranked second in strikeouts (584) and appearances (127), third in winning percentage (.536; 44-38), wins (44), innings pitched (587) and games started (90), and fourth in shutouts (16) and earned-run average (2.13). In the 2006 season, Salmon compiled a 9-7 record with 125 strikeouts, five complete games and a team-low 2.87 earned-run average in 107.1 innings pitched.

ONE FOR THE RECORD BOOKS: As Miami's big bat in the middle of the batting order, junior **Leslie Macedo** set a new single-season record with 37 runs-batted in. Finishing fourth in the conference in RBIs, Macedo tallied seven multi-RBI games, including a career-high seven against Morehead State (Feb. 17) and a then career-high six against Centenary (Feb. 10). Macedo broke the previous single-season record of 30 RBIs on April 14 against Toledo. After three seasons at Miami, Macedo stands fourth on the career charts with 72 RBIs and is only 12 shy of tying the career record of 84 held by Shawnda Moye (1996-99).

INDIVIDUAL ACCOLADES: After being one of Miami's most consistent hitters, senior **Kristen Hays** capped her three-year career by taking home all-MAC first-team and NFCA/Louisville Slugger All-MidEast Region second-team honors. Hays earned her first career all-conference award as a designated player after leading the team in hitting (.358 BA; 19-or-53) during MAC-only games and then became the eighth player in program history named to an all-region squad, as she was tabbed for the MidEast Region's second team.

FOR ALL YOUR HARDWARE NEEDS: Senior **Courtney Salmon** was the lone Miami hurler to be named as the MAC East Pitcher of the Week this season, winning the award on Feb. 21 and May 1. Salmon earned her first pitcher of the week award after appearing in five games in the Troy Cox Invitational (Las Cruces, N.M.) and notching a pair of wins and a save. Salmon then took home her second weekly conference honor of the season after compiling a 0.37 earned-run average in 19.0 innings against Eastern and Central Michigan during MAC play. During her four-year career, Salmon was honored as the MAC East Pitcher of the Week seven times.

ACCOLADE ALERT: After going all of the 2005 season without having a MAC East Division Player of the Week, Miami had two athletes garner the weekly conference award during the 2006 season. Junior **Leslie Macedo** was the first Miami player to win the award (Feb. 21) after batting .588 with 11 runs-batted in at the Troy Cox Classic, while sophomore **Halle Popson** took home the award (March 6) after batting .545 (6 for-10) with a pair of home runs at the Buzz Classic.

• 2002 Miami Hall of Fame Inductee

As one of the most prolific pitchers in Miami history, former RedHawk standout **Kristy Burch** became the first softball player inducted into the Miami Hall of Fame on Sept. 7, 2002.

Upon the completion of her four-year career (1987-90), Burch owned the Miami record books as she set all 18 school single-season and career pitching marks, including 15 records during her senior campaign. Today, Burch still holds five single season records and three career records.

"It is a tremendous honor for Kristy," said former head coach

Angie Jacobs. "Her records speak for themselves. I can't think of a more deserving person and athlete."

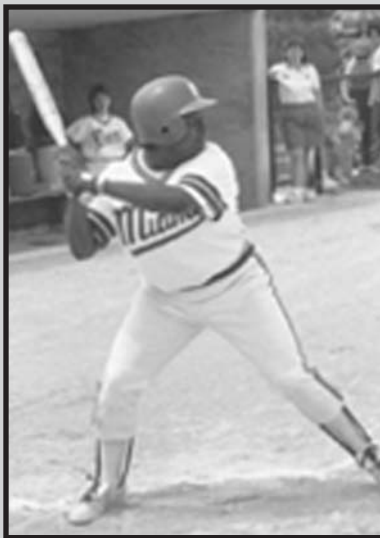
Burch's on-field accomplishments over her last two years at Miami made her the first and only Miami softball player to be named first-team all-MAC two years in a row. In arguably her best season in 1990, Burch compiled a 25-9 record in the circle with an 0.74 ERA and led Miami to a school record 36 wins.

Kristy currently lives in Sterling, Virginia where she is married to Patrick Bergmann. Kristy and Patrick have one son, Sean, who is seven years old.

Monique Abbit

• 2006 Miami Hall of Fame Inductee

Standout outfielder on the Miami softball diamond from 1988-91, **Monique Abbit** remains a powerful presence in Miami's record books. Abbit currently owns four Miami career records—at bats (660), hits (216), doubles (36) and triples (15)—and also ranks second in runs scored (109), third in batting average (.327), ties for third in stolen bases (40) and ranks fourth in home runs (13) and runs batted in (70).

During her career, Abbit also placed her name on eight single-season charts and is the single-season record holder for hits (74 in 1991) and triples (6 in 1991).

As a junior in 1990, she helped Miami to a program record 36 wins—the first 30-win season for the Red and White—and followed with a 34-win season as a senior in 1991, marking the only time in program history with back-to-back 30-win seasons.

Twice Abbit was honored as an All-Mid-American Conference selection, earning second-team honors in 1990 and 1991. Abbit also was a standout in the classroom, garnering Academic All-MAC accolades three times and being tabbed a CoSIDA Academic All-American in 1991, the only Miami softball player to earn Academic All-America recognition.

SO YOU WANT TO BE A REDHAWK...

Miami University prides itself on its adherence to the NCAA rules and regulations that govern recruiting. Here are a few to remember:

1. NCAA Clearinghouse - To be able to compete in college, an athlete needs to be certified through the NCAA Clearinghouse. A form can be obtained through high school guidance offices.

2. Contacts - After July 1 of a prospect's senior year, coaches are allowed to speak with the athlete or her parents face-to-face. If playing in a tournament, coaches are prohibited from visiting with a student-athlete until after her team is finished competing in the tournament.

3. Official Visits - When a prospect visits a campus with all expenses paid by the institution, it is an official visit. A prospective student-athlete may take up to five visits throughout her senior year, one per institution. A typical official visit would include attending a class and/or athletic event, watching practice, seeing the athletic facilities, taking a campus tour, and meeting with academic counselors along with the coaches and teams.

4. Unofficial Visits - Prospective student-athletes may visit a campus unofficially as many times as they desire. They may do almost the same things as an official visit, but the institution cannot pay for any expenses.

5. Phone Calls - After July 1, a student-athlete may receive one call per week from an institution. The only exceptions are during the week of an official visit. Then, an unlimited number of phone calls may be made.



6. Letters - After Sept. 1 of the student-athlete's junior year, they may receive information about the Miami Softball program. E-mail is also considered a letter, so one may send and receive e-mail at any time.

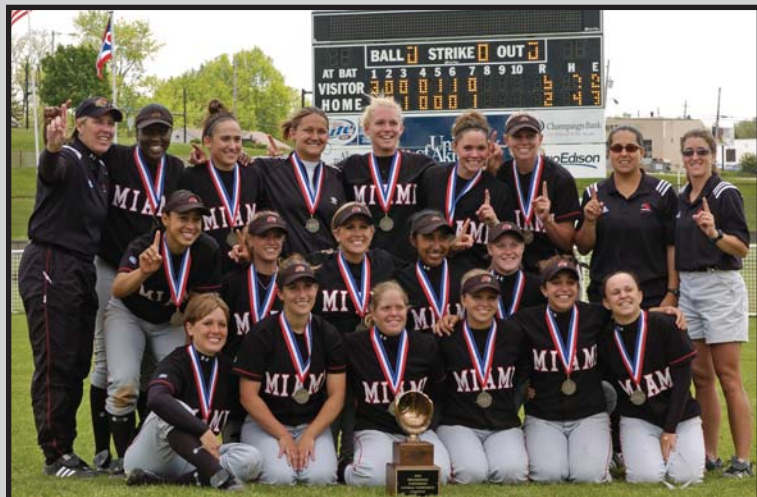
7. Scholarship - A scholarship may be offered at any time during the recruiting process. Miami Softball is fully-funded under NCAA regulations with regards to the amount of scholarships that are available.

8. Signing Dates - Softball has two time periods in which to sign a National Letter of Intent to attend an institution. Softball's early signing period is in November, while the late signing period runs from April to August of the year prior to an athlete's freshman season.

MIAMI SOFTBALL: 2005 MAC TOURNAMENT CHAMPIONS

Under the leadership of head coach **Angie Jacobs**, the winningest coach in Miami history, the 2005 RedHawk softball team capped its season by winning the Mid-American Conference Tournament Championship and qualifying for the NCAA Tournament for the first time in the 31-year history of the program.

After reaching the finals of the MAC Tournament in both 2003 and 2004, the third time was the charm as the 2005 team went a perfect 4-0 in the conference tourney, clinching a trip to the NCAA Regional in Knoxville, Tenn. with a 5-2 win over Marshall in the finals. Miami placed four athletes on the MAC All-Tournament team, including tournament MVP **Jackie Poggendorf**.





Miami Softball received the inaugural "Hal Jasper Community Service Award" for their outstanding commitment to community service activities in 2002. The award honors Mr. Hal Jasper, who served Miami for over 50 years and was the NCAA Faculty Representative in the Athletic Department for almost 15 years.

Since earning the award, the Miami softball team has continued to be active in both the Miami and Oxford communities, helping with various community service projects over the past five years.

During the fall of 2006, the RedHawks participated in numerous community service projects, including the State-to-State Marathon and volunteering to visit patients at the Matrix Health Center in Oxford.
