Athletic Hall of Fame

To date, seven individuals associated with Miami's tennis program have been inducted into the University's prestigious Athletic Hall of Fame, including the program's first head coach Elaine Hieber, head coach of Miami's first four MAC Championship teams Leann Grimes Davidge and standout players Sue Brozovich, Vickie Shields, Jill Joslin, Nicole Catalano and Dale Cohen.

SUE BROZOVICH INDUCTED 2000

A four-year letter winner from 1985-88, Sue Brozovich amassed career records of 103-31 in singles and 92-28 in doubles. In 1988, she finished with a 26-10 singles record and the MAC's No. 1 singles title, making her the only woman in conference history to capture four singles crowns. In her senior year, she was ranked regionally in both singles and doubles while leading the Red and White to its fourth MAC Championship in her four seasons.

VICKIE SHIELDS INDUCTED 2004

A four-year letterwinner from 1981-85, Vickie Shields played No. 1 singles and doubles and helped lead Miami to four straight

MAC titles. Shields twice won MAC singles titles (1982 and 1983) and captured three doubles crowns during her career, while earning all-MAC honors in three of four seasons. In 1982, she competed in the NCAA Championships with her doubles partner Anna VanWallengham.

JILL JOSLIN INDUCTED 2008

A member of four MAC Championship teams (1984-87), Jill Joslin was a six-time MAC Champion, capturing singles and/or doubles titles each year during her Miami career, and was a three-time all-MAC honoree. Joslin was the MAC Champion at No. 3 singles in 1985 and '86 and captured a MAC crown at No. 5 singles as a freshman in 1984. In doubles

play, Joslin earned MAC titles at No. 1, No. 2 and No. 3 doubles. She was the first recipient of the MAC's Leann Grimes Davidge Sportsmanship Award in 1986. Joslin also earned Academic All-MAC honors in 1987.

NICOLE CATALANO INDUCTED 2009

A member of three MAC Championship teams (1991-93), Nicole Catalano was a five-time MAC Champion, winning twice in singles and three times at No. 1 doubles. A three-Time First-Team All-MAC honoree, Catalano was undefeated in MAC doubles action her final three seasons. Following her senior campaign where she captured MAC crowns at No. 1 singles and at No. 1 doubles, Catalano was tabbed

Miami's 1992-93 Leann Grimes Davidge Award Recipient and also was the ITA Midwest Region Arthur Ashe Sportsmanship Award winner.

DALE COHEN INDUCTED 2012

A member of four MAC Championship teams (1991-94), Dale Cohen was a six-time MAC Champion, winning in both singles and doubles three consecutive years. Following her senior campaign where she captured MAC crowns at No. 1 singles and at No. 1 doubles, Cohen was tabbed the 1993-94 Miami Female Athlete of the Year. Cohen spearheaded Miami to a 59-23 (.720) overall mark and an impressive 21-1 (.955) in MAC regular-season play.



ELAINE HIEBER
MIAMI TENNIS COACH
1976-79

One of the pioneers of Miami women's athletics, Elaine Hieber directed the women's tennis program from 1976-79, laying the groundwork for one of Miami's proudest traditions. During her four seasons at the head of the Miami program, Hieber compiled a 43-20 record. She also guided Miami to second-place finishes at the Ohio College Women's Tennis Tournament in 1976, 1978 and 1979.

As associate athletics director in charge of women's athletics from 1974-79, Hieber helped establish seven women's varsity sports to compete at the AIAW Division I level while instituting and expanding grant-in-aid for female student-athletes. Hieber, who also coached volleyball, basketball and softball while at Miami, was honored for her contributions in 1999 when she was inducted into Miami's Athletic Hall of Fame.



LEANN GRIMES DAVIDGE
MIAMI TENNIS COACH
1979-85

Few individuals in Miami's athletic history left as profound an impact in as short a time as Leann Grimes Davidge. From 1979-1985, Davidge guided a Miami women's tennis program that captured four Mid-American Conference titles while compiling a five-year record of 94-53. Selected as MAC Coach of the Year in 1981 and 1983, Davidge guided Miami to a stellar 25-1 league record during her tenure.

Sadly, Davidge lost her life in an auto accident on Jan. 27, 1985. She was just 28 years old. Despite the tragic loss, Davidge's memory lives on in the Leann Grimes Davidge Sportsmanship award presented annually at the MAC Tournament and in Miami's Leann Grimes Davidge Memorial Award presented each year to one female senior student-athlete.
