GAME-DAY PARKING

Memorial Stadium is located on the corner of Stadium Boulevard and Providence Road, in the heart of Columbia. It is about 15 minutes away from the Columbia Regional Airport and about 2 hours from both St. Louis and Kansas City International Airports.

APPROACHING CAMPUS

From Lambert-St. Louis International Airport

When exiting the airport, travel west on Interstate 70 towards Columbia and Kansas City. Exit onto US Highway 63 South towards Jefferson City. Take the Stadium Blvd exit and make a right. Memorial Stadium is located about 2 miles ahead on the left.

From Kansas City International Airport

When exiting the airport, merge onto Interstate 435 East towards St. Louis. Travel on I-435 E and exit onto Interstate 70 East towards Columbia and St. Louis. Take the Stadium Blvd. exit and make a right. Memorial Stadium is located about 5 miles ahead on the right.

From Columbia Regional Airport

When exiting the airport, take a left onto Route H towards US Highway 63. Turn right to travel north onto US Highway 63. Take the Stadium Blvd. exit and make a left. Memorial Stadium is located about 2 miles ahead on the left.

WHERE TO PARK

Handicap-Accessible Parking

Individual handicap-accessible parking is available for a \$15 cash fee on the northwest side of Memorial Stadium at the intersection of Stadium Blvd. and Mick Deaver Dr., with overflow parking on the east side of the Hearnes Center in Lot M. The spaces are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. If you require accessible parking that provides space to enter and exit a vehicle with a mobility aid, please let us know upon entry to the lot so we accommodate you in a stall with access aisles. In addition, please indicate if your vehicle is equipped with a lift system that requires the provision of a "van accessible" 8 Foot access aisle. This information helps us provide the highest level of access to the greatest number of our fans with disabilities as possible.

Parking in these lots will only be available to vehicles that meet all three of these requirements:

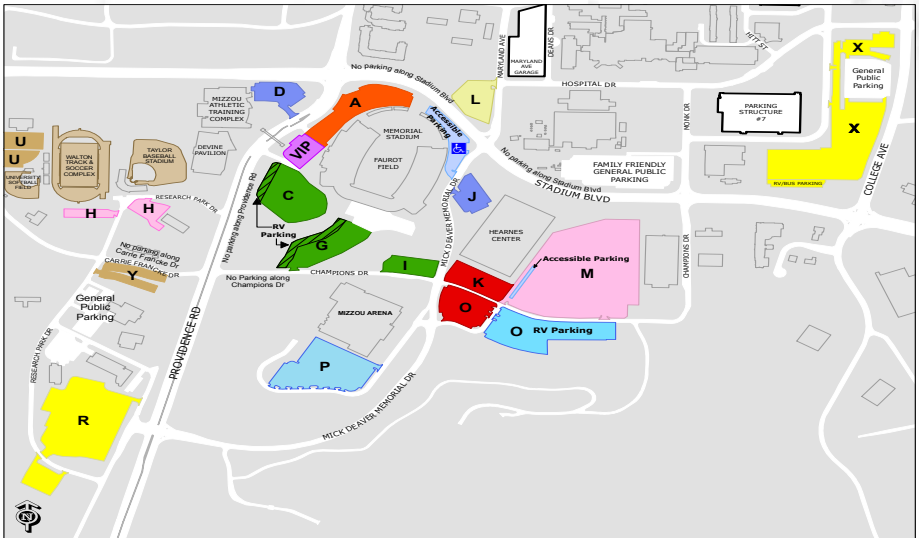
**A disabled placard or plate*

**The person to whom the placard or plate was issued to is in the vehicle*

**The person seeking to park shows the officer a validated application receipt for the placard or plate.*

Reserved/Donor Parking

The colored lots are reserved on game day for donors of the Tiger Scholarship Fund. Parking passes for these lots are only sold to members of the Tiger Scholarship Fund on a season basis. For more information about Reserved/Donor Parking, call the Tiger Scholarship Fund office, Monday-Friday from 8am-5pm at (573) 882-0704.



General Public Parking

Those who wish to park in close proximity of Memorial Stadium have many options from which to choose from. There are seven on-campus garages that are FREE of charge with the exception of the Maryland Avenue Garage located at the corner of Maryland Avenue and Hospital Drive. The fee for the Maryland Avenue Garage is \$15 per vehicle for levels three and above. There is also a general public parking area at the corner of Providence Road and Research Drive as well as along Stadium Boulevard and Monk Drive. Both of these General Public Parking lots are \$15 per vehicle. All the locations listed above are for passenger vehicles only; RVs and buses will not be allowed in these parking areas. 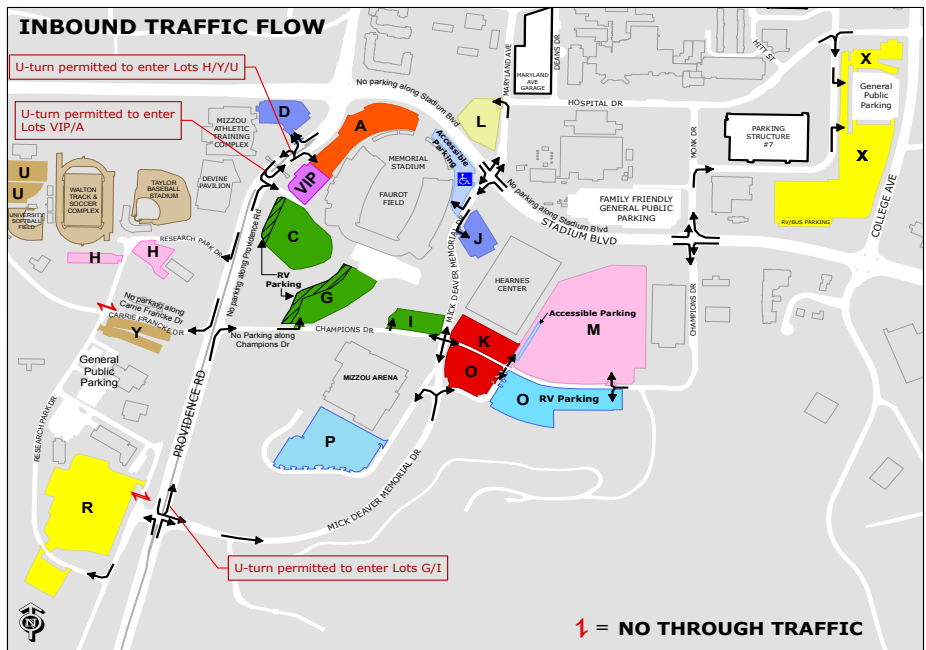
Passenger Drop-Off Zones

Due to pre and post game traffic around the permit lots, it is recommended, but subject to change that guests can drop off or pick up another guest north of Stadium Blvd. on Maryland Ave or on Providence RD. (Near Pedestrian Bridge).

RV and Bus Parking

Parking for RVs and buses (including school buses) will be charged a flat fee of \$150 for the weekend. The parking lot will be open from 6pm-10pm the night before a home football game, and will re-open at 8am the day of the game. The designated lot for RVs is located southeast of the Hearnes Center, with bus and overflow RV parking in the southwest corner of Lot X at the corner of College Avenue and Hospital Drive. RVs and buses are not allowed to park in any campus parking lots except for those designated by sign for RV and/or Bus Parking. ENTERING THE PARKING LOTS

The University of Missouri Athletic Department and local law enforcement authorities work in conjunction to ensure that game day traffic runs as smoothly as possible. Please make a special note of the preferred ways to enter your reserved lot.

Lot A/VIP Lot: If traveling northbound on Providence Rd. turn right/east into Lot A/VIP Lot. If traveling southbound on Providence Rd. make a u-turn at gate in left lane past the pedestrian bridge so that you are traveling northbound on Providence Rd., then turn right/east into Lot A/VIP Lot.

Lot C: If traveling northbound on Providence Rd. turn right/east into Lot C. If traveling southbound on Providence Rd. turn left/east through gate in left lane past the pedestrian bridge into Lot C.

Lot D: If traveling northbound on Providence Rd. turn left/west into Lot D. If traveling southbound on Providence Rd. turn right/west into Lot D.

Lot G: Travel north on Providence Rd. Turn right/east onto Champions Dr. to entrance of Lot G. If traveling south on Providence, make u-turn at intersection of Providence and Mick Deaver Dr. Turn right onto Champions Dr. to entrance to Lot G.

Lot H: If traveling southbound on Providence Rd. turn right/west onto Research Dr. to entrance of Lot H. If traveling northbound on Providence Rd. make a u-turn just past the pedestrian bridge. Turn right onto Research Dr. to entrance to Lot H.

Lot I: Take Stadium Blvd. to Mick Deaver Memorial Dr. Drive south on Mick Deaver Memorial Dr. and turn right/east onto Champions Dr. to entrance of Lot I.

Lot J: Take Stadium Blvd. to Mick Deaver Memorial Dr. Drive south on Mick Deaver Memorial Dr. and turn left/west into Lot J.

Lot K: Take Stadium Blvd. to Mick Deaver Memorial Dr. Drive south on Mick Deaver Memorial Dr. and turn left/west onto Champions Dr. to entrance of Lot K.

Lot L: Take Stadium Blvd. to Maryland Ave. Drive north on Maryland Ave. to entrance of Lot L.

Lot M: Take Stadium Blvd. to Monk Dr./Champions Dr. Drive south on Champions Dr. to entrance of Lot M.

Lot O: If traveling northbound on Providence Rd. turn right onto Mick Deaver Dr. Turn right prior to getting to LOT O follow to entrance of Lot O. If traveling southbound on Providence take a left onto Stadium Dr. and a right onto Mick Deaver Memorial Dr. Take a left at 4-way stop. Entrance to Lot O will be on your right.

Lot P: Take Providence Road to Mick Deaver Drive. Drive north on Mick Deaver Drive. Use left lane to entrance of Lot P.

Lot O-RV: Take Providence Road to Stadium Dr. to Monk Dr./Champions Dr. Drive south on Champions Dr. to entrance of Lot O-RV.

Lot R: Take Providence Road to Mick Deaver Memorial Drive. Drive west on Mick Deaver Memorial Drive. Stay to the left and the entrance of Lot R will be on the right.

Lot X: Take College Ave. to Hospital Dr. Drive west on Hospital Dr. Turn left onto Virginia Ave to entrance of Lot X.

Lot X-Bus/RV: Take Stadium Blvd. to Monk Dr./Champions Dr. Drive north on Monk Dr.. Turn right/east on Virginia Ave. to entrance of Lot X.

Lot U: Traveling south on Providence Rd. to Carrie Francke Dr. Turn right/west on Carrie Francke Dr. to entrance of Lot U. If traveling north on Providence Rd. turn left onto Stadium Blvd. at first light take left onto Carrie Francke Dr. Stay left, entrance to Lot U will be on the left.

Lot Y: Travel south on Providence Rd. Turn right/west on Carrie Francke Dr. to entrance of Lot Y. If traveling northbound on Providence Rd. make a u-turn just past the pedestrian bridge. Turn right/west on Carrie Francke Dr. to entrance of Lot Y.

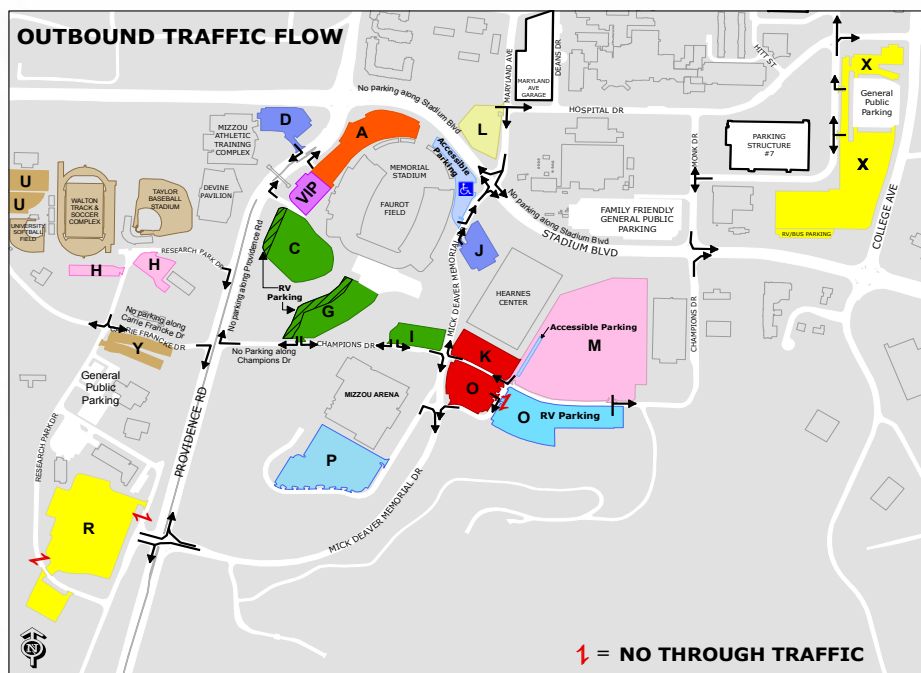
Special Notes

If traveling southbound on Providence Road, left-hand turns will not be permitted onto Champions Drive. If traveling northbound on Providence Road, left-hand turns will not be permitted onto Carrie Francke Drive nor onto Research Drive.

The following roads will be restricted to permit holders only starting three hours prior to kickoff on game day and will remain closed after the game until a time to be determined by law enforcement: Monk Drive, Mick Deaver Drive, Mick Deaver Extension, Research Drive, Champions Drive.

Only emergency vehicles and those with the proper game day permit from the University will be permitted along these roads. These roads will be re-opened at a time after the game as determined by local law enforcement.





PARKING & TAILGATING POLICIES

The University of Missouri encourages fans to arrive early to campus and enjoy the great tradition of tailgating. Please tailgate in a responsible manner, respectful of the campus, and respectful of other Tiger fans and visiting team fans.

PARKING AND TAILGATING REMINDERS

The vehicle and the associated tailgating activities may only occupy one (1) parking space.

No parking or driving on sidewalks, lawns, green spaces, or landscaped area.

Green spaces within 15 feet of parking lots are reserved for fans parking in those lots.

Parking permits will be stubbed upon entry into lot. Once permit is stubbed, fans may not leave and then re-enter the lot.

No overnight occupancy is allowed in tailgating areas. Parking lots will be monitored beginning the evening before a game and, unless otherwise denoted, parking lots will open at 8am on game day for permit holders. Staking perimeters prior to game-day is strictly prohibited.

Tents and canopies are allowed, but cannot exceed measurements of 10ft. by 10ft. Tents and canopies must be an extension off of your vehicle in your parking space and may not obstruct sidewalks, drive lanes, or pedestrian walkways.

Commercial activity or solicitations are not allowed on campus. Please contact the University of Missouri Business Services Department at (573) 882-7254.

Kegs, beer balls, or bulk quantities of alcohol are not permitted in any vehicle, or in any of the parking lots surrounding Memorial Stadium. University regulations and state statutes on drug and alcohol consumption will be strictly enforced. Failure to comply can lead to confiscation of alcohol and fines.

Any person damaging University property will be responsible for the cost of repairs; including damages to grass from cooking grease and sprinkler damage.

BBQ grills and generators are strictly prohibited in all parking garages.

Where allowed, all BBQ grills, propane or otherwise, should be attended to at all times. Grills on trailers may not be driven onto green spaces.

Fires built on the ground and open fire pit devices are strictly prohibited.

The use of motorized recreational vehicles, including four-wheelers, golf carts, gators, scooters, etc. is prohibited.

Pets are not allowed to run at large in tailgating areas and must be on a leash at all times. Animals shall not be left unattended or secured to university property. Please clean up after your pet.

Tailgating amenities, including furniture, grills, generators, or satellite dishes, may not obstruct sidewalks, drive lanes, or pedestrian walkways.

Dispose of all trash in trash or recycling receptacles located throughout the parking lots.

Hot coals must be doused and properly disposed of in specially designed coal bins throughout the parking lots to prevent fires.

The University of Missouri, Mizzou Athletics, and the University Police Department reserves the right to refuse service to anyone at any time--inappropriate behavior will result in the permanent loss of all parking and tailgating privileges.

The University of Missouri is not responsible or liable for accidents, damage, loss or theft of materials/items/personal property.

RV & BUS PARKING & TAILGATING

Lot O-RV

1. Designated for Donor Reserved RV Parking
2. Remaining spaces made available to General Public RV Parking.

Lot X-RV & Bus

1. Designated for Bus Parking.
2. Serves as over-flow for General Public RV Parking.

Entry is permitted into both RV lots beginning at 6pm on the Friday evening before game day. Please, do not block the entrance before entry time or stage on campus prior to 6pm.

On game-day, entry is permitted beginning at 8am. Please be aware of the game-day traffic in and around the parking lots and stadium. PLAN TO ARRIVE EARLY.

RV and bus lots are for Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) recognized recreational vehicles and Commercial Charter/School buses only. Mizzou Athletics reserves the right to remove any vehicle that is not appropriate for the RV/Bus area.

Only cars towed in on a tow-bar are allowed in the RV parking lots.

The RV or bus must be confined to one RV space (4 parking stalls). Only one (1) RV and one (1) tow vehicle or trailer is permitted in each assigned designated space. Amenities such as awnings, grills, and furniture must be utilized within allotted space.

The person(s) occupying a RV space are responsible for the conduct of their guests. No parking accommodations are made for guests in this area. Guests to RV lots must purchase a parking space for their vehicle in areas designated for public parking.

All sidewalks, drive lanes, and fire lanes must be kept clear of all equipment and vehicles. Cords, satellite dishes, etc., must be confined to each allotted space and cannot stretch across drive lanes.

RV & Bus Parking is available for a fee of \$150 per game on a first-come, first-served basis. Please call (573) 882-6501 to reserve your General Public RV or Bus Parking Pass. **MasterCard, Visa, and Discover are accepted.**

The sale of food and/or beverage or other commercial activities (including sales solicitation or advertising) are not permitted without the express written consent of the University of Missouri.

Generators must be equipped with a noise-reducing device (manufacture-approved cover or muffler). Special care should be taken when managing fuel and extension cords affiliated with generators.

Children should be supervised at all times—please use extreme caution when driving into or leaving the parking lots.

Pets are not allowed to run at large in tailgating sites. They must be leashed and kept within the confines of the parking space or remain in the RV or bus. Furthermore, animals should not be left unattended or secured to University property. Please clean up after your pet.

Dispose of all trash in trash receptacles or pack it out. Do not dispose of grease, coals, or hazardous materials onto the grounds or into the storm drains.

There is not a dump station located on the University of Missouri campus.

The University of Missouri is not responsible or liable for accidents, damage, loss or theft of materials/items/personal property occurring in the RV and bus lots.

In case of emergency, call 911. For non-emergencies, call University Police at (573) 882-7201.

TAILGATING Q&A

Why did Mizzou develop a plan for responsible tailgating?

Tailgating and picnicking before Mizzou athletic events has increased in popularity over the last several years and we anticipate that it will continue to grow in the future. Increased participation has led to more safety concerns and damage to the campus. The plan for responsible tailgating was developed to help ensure that the game day experience includes friendly, fun, safe and family-oriented activities celebrating a day of athletic competition.

What steps should I take in setting up my tent/canopy?

Tents and canopies should be anchored appropriately (e.g., sandbags, water barrels, stakes-not in asphalt.) Unanchored tents/canopies easily can blow over and present a safety hazard as well as causing damage to property. Tents and canopies cannot exceed 10 ft. by 10 ft. and must be an extension of your vehicle.

Can you explain the purpose of the alcohol-free zone and tell me where it is?

The alcohol-free zone is meant to prevent the presence of open containers. There is a parking lot on the corner of Stadium Blvd. and Monk Drive that is monitored as a alcohol-free zone. We have increasing interest in the team and pregame activities and want to keep areas as "family friendly" as possible.

If I am not allowed to use a generator, what are my options?

We suggest marine batteries or inverters.

What size pit/grill may I use?

Large pits are not allowed in tailgating areas. As a general rule, if it takes more than 2 people to carry it in, it will be too large for the area. The size and weight of the rigs could cause danger to our greenspace and trees, as well as cause a risk to the pedestrian areas. Our goal is to have as many Mizzou fans as possible enjoying the unique atmosphere of tailgating.

How should I dispose of hot coals?

Hot coals must be doused and properly disposed of in specially designated coal bins to prevent fires. Fires built on the ground and open fire pit devices are prohibited.

Where can people with disabilities park and still have easy access to Memorial Stadium?

Individuals with disabilities may park on the corner of Stadium Drive and Mick Deaver Drive or on the east side of the Hearnes Center in the designated parking areas for \$15 per game. Questions concerning Accessible Parking, please call (573) 882-6501.

Where are restrooms located?

Permanent restroom facilities are located in the Hearnes Center and Memorial Stadium offers bathroom facilities outside gate 2E and 2W up until 15 minutes before gates open. Portable toilets are located throughout the Sports Park.



MEMORIAL STADIUM A-Z GUIDE

ATM Machine

An ATM machine is located outside the stadium on the west side near Gate 3. There is an additional ATM machine located on the west concourse of the Hearn Center.

Bags

All bags and hand-carried items will be inspected prior to entry into the stadium. Items can be no larger than 16" by 18" by 9".

Camera Policy

Cameras are restricted in Memorial Stadium; large-lens cameras with a stand or tripod are not permitted. Video cameras are not permitted. Personal snapshot pocket cameras are allowed in the stadium, however, in no instance may photography interfere with access ways, seat aisles, or other guests' enjoyment of the game. Note: Secondary use of any pictures, audio description, film, tape or drawing of the game are the exclusive rights of the NCAA.

Chairback Rental

For \$35 for the season, enjoy the comfort and convenience of a Tiger Chairback. Tiger Chairbacks are thick cushioned, back supporting seats that are permanently installed at your seating location for the season. To order call 573-884-PAWS or 1-800-CAT-PAWS.

Temporary seat cushion rentals are also available for \$5 throughout the East & West Concourses on game day.

If you wish to bring your own chairback, it may not be larger than the size requirements of 16" by 18" by 9".

Children's Admission/Tickets

MIZZOU Athletics offer complimentary admission to children ages 2 and under, provided they are accompanied by an adult with a valid ticket. These children must sit on a lap and not occupy an additional seat.

Concessions

Stands are located on the North, East, West, and South Concourses. Stands include a variety of menus and are titled Stadium Diner, Sideline Grill, End Zone Grill, Taste of Missouri, and Tiger Treats. In addition there are vendors located on the main concourse.

Courtesy Shuttles

Courtesy Shuttles are available from each lot to the south and east of Memorial Stadium to designated points throughout the stadium. This service will operate ninety minutes before, during half-time, and one hour after the game. Accessible shuttles will operate between the Hearn Center Accessible parking area (east side) and Gate 1. Due to the heavy pedestrian traffic flow, courtesy shuttles will not be able to operate to or from the west side of Memorial Stadium.

Pre-game shuttles are also available from Lot U and Lot X to Gate 1. Lot U and Lot X shuttles will only operate before the game -not after. Look for shuttle pick-up signs at the entrance of your lot.

Disability Services

Accessible Individual Game Tickets

A limited number of accessible individual game tickets are placed on sale in early July through the Mizzou Ticket office. Guests in need of accessible seats may contact the Mizzou Ticket Office at 1-800-CAT-PAWS to place an order for tickets.

Animals

Animals are not permitted in Memorial Stadium with the exception of service animals and service animals in training. Please be sure to check with the stadium before bringing any service animals to the game. For more information, please contact the Department of Athletics at 573.882-6501.

Closed Captioning Service

Closed Captioning is available for guests via the Video Board located at the North end of the stadium.

Disabled Seating Information

There are disabled seats (wheelchair convertible) dispersed throughout the bowl area. Disabled seating and access are fully compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). For further location of access appropriate options, please contact the Mizzou Ticket Office at 1-800-CAT-PAWS.

Restrooms

Restrooms are located throughout the concourse at Memorial Stadium and are all ADA-compliant. Most restrooms throughout the facility are equipped with baby-changing tables.

Ticket Exchange

Should a guest need access to wheelchair space and accessible seating on a temporary basis, accommodations may be made through the Mizzou Ticket Office. Tickets may only be exchanged based on availability of existing accessible seats. Due to high demand, accessible seating will run out. We recommend you contact the Mizzou Ticket Office as soon as you know you will be in need of assistance. Please call the Ticket Office at 1-800-CAT-PAWS to report your need for accessible seating and to check availability.

Wheelchairs

A limited number of wheelchairs are available for transporting guests from the gates to their stadium seating location. Guests are asked to supply their own wheelchair if they need one for the duration of the event. Guests may arrange for wheelchair assistance by contacting an event staff member at any entrance. Guests needing assistance after the event should contact an event staff member, security personnel or visit one of the Guest Services Centers located on the concourse behind Sections OO/PP, O/P. Guests in suite and club areas should contact the event staff on their level to request a wheelchair escort or additional assistance.

Exiting the Stadium

Guests will leave the facilities via the gates in which they entered. No guests are permitted on the field.

Evacuation

In case of evacuation, instructions will be given over the public address system. Gate personnel and ushers will assist directing fans to the appropriate location.

Entry Guidelines

Only guests with valid tickets or credentials are permitted into Memorial Stadium. Mizzou Athletics reserves the right to inspect and remove any bag or its contents.

Electronic Ticket Scanning

All tickets will be electronically scanned to verify authenticity. Tickets must be scanned each time a patron enters or exits the stadium. Tickets which have been logged in upon entry cannot be reused by another guest. Patrons assume all risks for tickets purchased through sources other than the Mizzou Athletics Ticket Office.

First Aid

The emergency first aid station is located on the West Concourse below the John J. Lenox Memorial Press Box. Paramedics are also located throughout the stadium on foot. Please contact the nearest Guest Services Booth, security officer, or usher for assistance.

Gates

Gates will open ninety minutes prior to game time. Reserved ticket holders may enter at any gate, except for Gates 3E and 4E. It is recommended that guests enter the gate closest to their seat location. Family Fun Pass ticket holders should enter at Gates 6E or 6W. Student ticket holders can only enter through Gates 3E, 4E, 5E and 6E. Tiger Lounge ticket holders and suite holders may enter at the John J. Lenox Memorial Press Box, main entrance is located between gate 3W and 5W.



Guest Services

Guests needing assistance are encouraged to speak with one of our Event Staff representatives or visit one of our Guest Services booths located near section P/Q on the west concourse and section RR/SS on the east concourse. These booths are staffed to answer questions about a wide variety of services and items including: Lost and Found Items, Lost Guests, Wheelchair service to and from seats, and Convenience items.

Inclement Weather

In the event of inclement weather, (i.e. dangerous winds, tornado, electrical storm, etc.) all guests will be advised that it is in their best interest to seek shelter. Emergency instructions will be delivered via the public address system and the message boards when possible.

Lost and Found

Lost and found services are maintained at the Guest Services Booths on the east and west concourses during the game. Following the game, found items will be recorded by MIZZOU Athletics and delivered to the University of Missouri Police Department. Please call (573) 882-7201 to retrieve your lost item. If you find a misplaced item, please turn it in to the nearest Guest Services booth or Event Staff representative.

Lost Guests

Children and adults separated from their parties will be escorted to the nearest Guest Services booth. For assistance in locating a lost member of your party, contact the nearest Event Staff representative or security officer. Both Guest Services booths offer wristbands to children and adults that will identify the seat location should you become separated from your party.

Novelties

The Tiger Team Store is located on the North Concourse and is open from 9:00am through the end of the game. Outside access to the store will be changed to inside access at game time. Also, a Nike tent will be set up inside Gate 1 on the North Concourse with the latest Mizzou Nike merchandise. Additional Missouri apparel and novelty items are available on the East and West Concourses.

Programs

Game Day programs are sold inside each gate around the main concourse. The cost is \$5.

Public Telephones

Public Pay telephones are located across from the Guest Services booths on both the east and west concourses.

Radio

Tiger Network broadcasts for all Tiger Football games will begin 60 minutes prior to kickoff with "The Voice of the Tigers" Mike Kelly, Pre-game host, Gary Link, and "Mr. Mizzou" John Kadlec.

Re-Entry

Pass-outs or stamps are available from all gate attendants during pre-game and halftime. During the game, fans can go to Gate 1 on the North side of the stadium for pass-out stamps. On the East side, fans will need to go to Gates 2E and 6E and on the west side, fans will need to go to Gates 2W and 6W to receive pass-out stamps. Both a valid ticket stub and a pass-out stamp are required for re-admission.

Restrooms

Temporary Restrooms are provided in designated parking areas. Stadium restrooms that open to both the concourse and parking areas will be switched from outside access to inside access 15 minutes prior to gates opening. Baby changing stations are available in most restrooms.

Smoking

Smoking is not permitted in Memorial Stadium. In order to promote an enjoyable game day experience for everyone, you must leave the stadium through the specified pass-out gates, obtain a hand stamp/pass out and present a valid ticket stub and pass out for re-entry.

Sportsmanship

The University of Missouri is committed to promoting a positive environment and safety at all home events. In accordance with NCAA and Big 12 rules, we ask that all fans act responsibly and courteously to those around you. Abusive language or disorderly conduct is unacceptable and unwelcome at MIZZOU. Any spectator who interferes with the game by coming onto the field or by throwing objects on the field at any time will be removed from the stadium. Your cooperation is appreciated.

Throwing of Objects

Throwing of items will not be tolerated. The offender will be removed from the stadium and is subject to arrest. Guests ejected from the stadium/venue will not be refunded for their tickets, and may result in cancellation of tickets. A police officer does not have to see the activity to have the individual removed from Memorial Stadium.

MIZZOU TICKET OFFICE

The Mizzou Ticket Office is located on the north side of Mizzou Arena.

The Mizzou Ticket Office is open Monday-Friday, 8am-5pm, except on university-observed holidays.

The Faurot Field-Memorial Stadium and MIZZOU Arena ticket offices open at 8am for games prior to 5pm, and at 12pm for games at 5pm or later.

Both ticket offices close at half-time.

All persons attending must have a ticket (as a courtesy, children age two and under are admitted at no charge, provided they do not take up a seat). Reserved ticket locations are identified by a single letter (West Side), double letter (East Side), or section number (South End zone). All tickets except, Family Fun Pass and hill tickets, are for reserved seating. The Family Fun Pass seating area is in sections 13-18. General Admission ticket seating is on the grass hill overlooking the North End Zone. Handling Fees: \$15 for season tickets. \$8 for home single game tickets.

PLAYER PASS LIST

Mizzou Player Guests and Visiting Team Player Guests enter at Gate 1 near the Faurot Field-Memorial Stadium Ticket Office.

WILL CALL

Will Call is located at the Faurot Field-Memorial Stadium Ticket Office on the north end of the stadium near Gate 1. A photo ID is required for Will Call pick-ups.

All orders placed within 6 business days of an event will be held in Will Call. (For example, tickets ordered on or after Friday, September 3 for a football game on Saturday, September 11, are placed in Will Call.) To pick up tickets at Will Call, all customers must show a valid photo ID. The person ordering the tickets **MUST** be the person picking up the tickets. Any alterations to this policy must be arranged with the University of Missouri Ticket Office in advance of the event. The ticket office and Will Call window will close at the end of halftime.

GROUP TICKETS

Group tickets can be purchased for all games in groups of 25 or more. For more information regarding group ticket sales, contact the MIZZOU Marketing Department by calling (573) 884-7238.

DAY OF GAME PURCHASES

If available, day of game purchases can be transacted at either the Mizzou Arena or Memorial Stadium ticket offices. Game day sales are cash and credit card only. The Mizzou Ticket Office will accept cash, check, and credit card (Visa, MasterCard, or Discover) as a form of payment. Full payment must be received at the time the order is placed. No checks will be accepted on game day. A check returned for insufficient funds, places the ticket holder in jeopardy of losing their seats.

GRASS HILL TICKETS

General admission tickets for home games at Faurot Field are grass hill seating/standing room only on the north end of Memorial Stadium. General admission tickets are available for sale to the public on game day only. If reserved seats are sold out in advance of game day general admission tickets will be sold prior to game day. The University of Missouri Athletic Department reserves the right to sell general admission tickets prior to game day even if reserved seats are not sold out. Please check with the Mizzou Ticket Office as sales for each game vary.

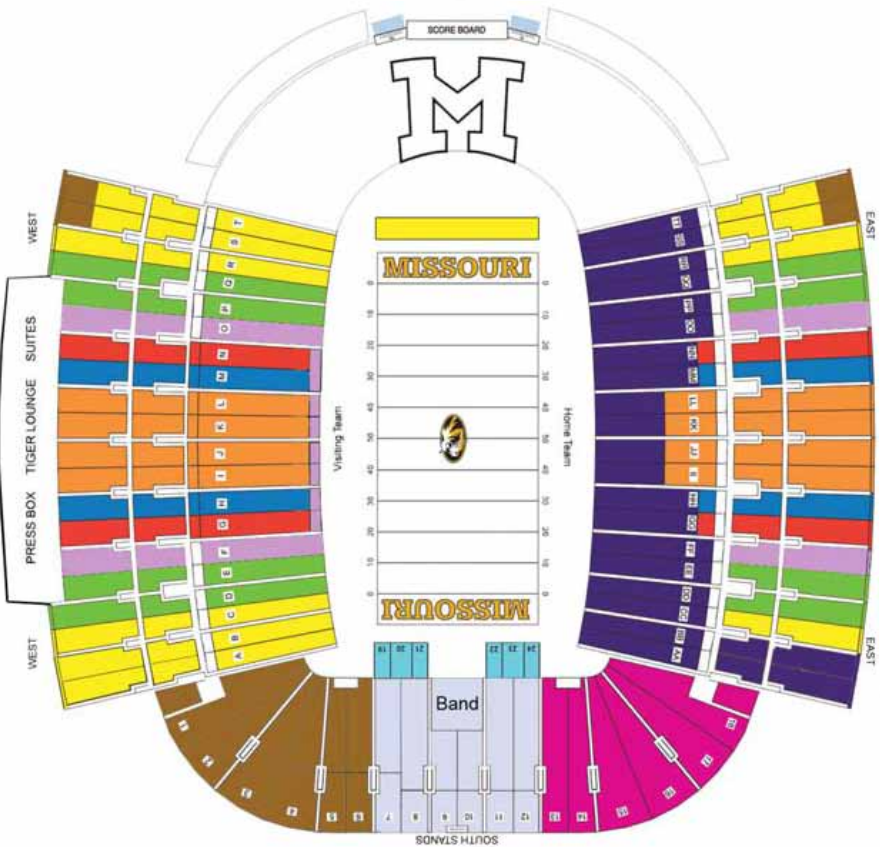
