

## Quick Guide to NCAA Academic Eligibility Rules

UM student-athletes must meet the following NCAA rules to remain eligible:

- Earn at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA
- Declare a major before the 3rd year (see your team's academic advisor if you want to change your major)
- Be enrolled in at least 12 credits at all times during the autumn and spring semesters (to stay on track to graduate in 5 years, complete 12 credits per semester with C's or better, or 15 credits a semester to graduate in 4 years)
- Pass 24 credits during the first year
- Complete at least 24 credits toward your degree, during the autumn, spring, and summer, including 18 credits only in the autumn and spring semesters
- Pass a minimum of 6 credits each semester (autumn and spring)
