General Camp Information

Emphasis: Camp activity will center around basketball fundamentals and competition. In addition, we hope to instill in each camp enrollee a better knowledge and appreciation of the game as well as a tougher mental approach to both preparation and competition.

Facilities: Camp facilities will include: 2 courts on the new permanent floor in Adams Center, 1 court in the West Auxiliary Gym, 1 court in the East Auxiliary Gym and 2 courts in the new Campus Recreation Center.

Camp Staff: The camp staff will include Lady Griz Head Coach Robin Selvig, along with Lady Griz assistant coaches, current and former Lady Griz Basketball Players, and area High School and College Coaches.

Campers will be divided according to age, size and ability.

Trainers: There is a training staff member available throughout the camp.

Transportation: Transportation to and from camp will be the individual's responsibility. However, campers arriving by bus or plane will be met by one of the coaches. Call or email with details.

Confirmation: When we receive your application we will send you a confirmation letter with details on clothing, equipment needed, etc.

Overnight Camp Information

Dates: June 17-20 (completed) Grades 5-11

Cost:

- \$300 includes regular camp activities, 3 meals per day, and lodging on campus
- \$225 includes regular camp activities, lunch and dinner each day (no lodging)
- \$185 includes regular camp activities (no meals or lodging)

Housing: All overnight campers will be housed in "Knowles" (campus dormitory) two to a room by age groups. Bedding will be furnished, but everyone should bring towels and wash cloths. Athletes will be under constant supervision as coaches will live with the girls while they are at camp.

Training Table: Participants will eat at the University Center staffed by trained dietitians. A balanced nutritional diet will be provided. Monday's dinner will be a pizza picnic for all campers.

Deposit: A \$50 deposit must accompany Overnight Camp applications.

Physical: A statement of physical fitness to participate in sports is required from your doctor. (For overnight and team camps only.) A copy of your school physical or the doctor's health certificate (on the left) must be submitted with your application.

Deadline: The deadline for Overnight Camp Registration is June 1st.

Arrival and Departure: Check in at Knowles on Sunday, June 17th between **11:00 am and 12:30 pm**. Overnight camp ends Wednesday, June 20th at approximately 12:00 noon. Dinner will be the only meal provided on Sunday, June 17th.
