THE GRIZ COACHING STAFF

Jerry Wagner: The 2011 Season marks Jerry Wagner's sixth year as head coach at the University of Montana. Wagner was hired in 2006 to complete a circuitous return to the program that gave him his first NCAA Division I assistant coaching position in 1988. Montana has gone 44-36 in Big Sky Conference matches and become one of the Big Sky Conference's elite teams. Montana has been above .500 in Big Sky play five of six seasons under Wagner and advanced to four postseason conference tournaments. The Grizzlies have also had 24 Academic All-Big Sky Conference selections under Wagner.

Gina Schmidt: The 2011 season marks Gina Schmidt's fourth year as an assistant coach with the University of Montana volleyball program. She joined the Grizzlies in 2008 following a six-year professional playing career as a setter and outside hitter in Europe and with the Canadian National Team. In her four seasons at Montana, Schmidt has helped coach the Grizzlies to three Big Sky Conference tournament appearances and a 37-27 record in league play. Schmidt, originally from Beaverlodge, Alberta, was a four-year letter-winner at Oregon State (1998-2001) and was an All Pac-10 selection as a junior in 2000.

Allison Lawrence: The 2011 season marks Allison Lawrence's second year as an assistant coach with the University of Montana volleyball program. In Lawrence's first season as an assistant, Montana advanced to its third straight Big Sky Conference tournament. Lawrence, from Alta Loma, Calif., was a four-year starter at outside hitter for Oregon State (2001-2004).
