All-Tournament Team

The All-Tournament Team and Most Outstanding Performer will be made via media release on the Monday following the tournament. MPSF Media Relations Coordinator Darren Preston will organize this process.

Awards Procedure

The first-place team will be presented with the championship trophy. For the trophy presentation, the winning team shall be in official uniform and lined up by cap order (lowest to highest) followed by the coaching staff.

Balls

Kap-7 is the official championship ball and will be used at all practices and competition. Balls will be supplied for each team during warm-ups and must be returned to the **ball bin at the end of the benches** at the conclusion of the warm-ups.

Caps

Higher-seeded teams will wear dark caps. Each team is responsible for supplying light and dark water polo caps and quartered goalie caps, as specified in the NCAA Water Polo rules book.

Championship Financial Policy

All tournament approved host institution expenses plus all approved participating team transportation expenses (not to include lodging or per diem), plus all related Federation expenses shall be deducted from all tournament revenue. Any resulting net loss shall be divided and assessed to all teams participating in Federation conference play in that particular sport. Any resulting net gain shall be divided and distributed to teams participating in the championship tournament based on a formula determined by the MPSF Executive Committee.

Championship Transportation Expenses

The Federation will reimburse transportation based on the daily bus rate below or 21-day advance coach airfare, using the NCAA's 400-mile radius policy. Teams may only be reimbursed for airfare if their institution is beyond a 400-mile radius from the host institution based on zip code to zip code mileage – see below. No teams from this championship qualify for airfare reimbursement. Teams may elect to fly within the 400-mile radius, but will only be reimbursed the predetermined daily bus rate. Teams flying to the championship host site will not be reimbursed for ground transportation. All teams will be reimbursed the daily bus rate or actual expenses, whichever is less, starting with the day prior to competition and ending on the final day of competition – four days.

Changing Area

There are changing tents on the tennis courts adjacent to the pool, available to the participating teams for pre-game meetings. There are also locker rooms available during each team's game. The higher-seeded team will be assigned to the men's team locker room and the lower-seeded team will be assigned to the women's team locker room. As these rooms will not be secured, please carry all valuables with you to one the deck. The MPSF and UCLA are not responsible for any items left unattended.

Credentials

A total of twenty (20) credentials, based on the **Official MPSF Championship Team Roster Form (Appendix A – page 11)** submitted for your team, will be provided for each team. Sixteen (16) credentials are for the student-athletes listed on your official travel form. Four (4) non-participant bench credentials shall be issued for coaches and trainers. Should a team wish to have its team doctor in the bench area, he/she must have one of the four

non-participant credentials. Additional non-bench credentials may be requested for a team doctor, videographer and administrators by contacting Gavin Crew at gcrew@athletics.ucla.edu; however these individuals will not be allowed in the bench area during competition. Please be advised that if a participant credential is found to be in the possession of anyone other than the intended participant, that credential will be confiscated and the participant to whom the credential belonged shall gain entry thereafter only by purchasing a ticket. **A replacement for a lost credential will cost \$45 (the cost of an all-session ticket).**

Directions

From Los Angeles International Airport to Spieker Aquatic Center: Follow signs exiting LAX to the 405 Fwy North. From the 405 Fwy: Exit Sunset Blvd and head EAST for approximately one (1) mile. Turn RIGHT onto Bellagio Drive for about 100 yards, then LEFT onto De Neve Drive. Down the hill will be the turn-off for the Spieker Aquatics Center/Sunset Canyon Recreation Center and RC Lot, turn RIGHT.

From Westwood: head Northwest on Veteran Avenue, to Sunset Blvd and turn RIGHT. Turn RIGHT onto Bellagio Drive for about 100 yards, then LEFT onto De Neve Drive. Down the hill will be the turn-off for the Spieker Aquatics Center/Sunset Canyon Recreation Center and RC Lot, turn RIGHT.

Games Committee

A Games Committee (to include the Executive Director, Coordinator of Officials and one other at-large selection) will be determined to handle protests and other situations which need to be addressed during the course of the tournament.

Hospitality Area

- Athlete Hospitality: Snack baskets will be provided in each team area. Snacks will include fruit, granola bars and fluids.
- Administrators & Coaches Hospitality: Snacks and beverages will be provided for administrative representatives and team coaches only in the area behind the scorer's table. Proper credentials must be displayed for entrance.
- Officials Hospitality will be provided in the officials' changing room.

Directions from Spieker Aquatics Center: Coming out of the RC Lot, turn right on De Neve Drive North, and take to the bottom of the hill. Turn right on Charles E Young Drive. This will take you directly to the Emergency Room entrance off of Gayley and Charles Young Drive South.

Directions from the hotel: Exit the Courtyard by Marriott and take a right onto Bristol. Turn right onto West Centinela Ave and a right on Sepulveda Blvd. Turn left onto West Slauson Ave. and left onto Jefferson Blvd. Merge onto Interstate 405 North. Exit on Wilshire Blvd. East (Westwood). Turn LEFT on Westwood Blvd. (heading north) and turn left on Charles E Young Drive South. The entrance of the emergency room is ahead on the left-hand side.

Media and Sports Information

Please provide **Alex Timiraos, Assistant Sports Information Director (atimiraos@athletics.ucla.edu)** with an accurate numerical roster (with cap, numbers, name, height, position, year, hometown and high school) as soon as possible for the game program. Each SID should advise Alex Timiraos of the number of media credentials required **by Friday, November 18**, as well as any contact numbers of media outlets or email addresses that will need to receive game results.

The host institution sports information contact shall be responsible for scorekeeping, providing online scoring updates and results on the host institution's webpage dedicated to the championship tournament, coordinating with the Federation media relations coordinator and administering the All-Tournament Team. If technology is readily available and budget permitting, the host shall provide live streaming video as well as Live Game Tracker updates.

National Anthem

The national anthem will be played before the first game of each day and prior to the championship game. The pregame countdown will be adjusted to start 2 minutes later for games without the national anthem.

Officials

Officials are selected and assigned by the MPSF Executive Director and Coordinator of Officials. Two goal judges will be assigned to each game.

Parking

Parking for teams will be available in the RC Lot (see attached map). Five parking passes will be sent via overnight delivery to each team by Tuesday, November 23. Please note that these passes **MUST** be displayed on the dashboard and shown to the attendant at the lot. UCLA Game Management for vehicles that display their parking passes incorrectly. Please refer to the information packet that you receive along with your parking permits.

Penalties and Suspensions

Student-athletes, coaches and/or team staff removed from games for the receipt of a red card (Rule 7-4) or for flagrant misconduct or other reasons (Rule 21-11) shall sit in the spectator stands for the remainder of the game. Those serving suspensions for red cards shall serve a minimum one-game suspension in addition to the remainder of the game in which the penalty occurred. Those penalized for flagrant misconduct shall serve a minimum two-game suspension in addition to the remainder of the game in which the penalty occurred. Participants may be subjected to more severe penalties and suspensions than those minimally provided by NCAA and MPSF water polo rules depending on the nature of the conduct involved. Such authority is provided to the MPSF executive director by Federation bylaws. Spectators removed from any games will be escorted out of the facility. Players or coaches serving game suspensions may not communicate in any manner with the team bench or make any attempt at coaching the team during the contest(s) or communicate in any way with game officials. Any violation of this regulation will result in immediate and uncontestable forfeiture of that team's game(s) in question.

Post-Game Interviews

Post-game interviews will be conducted by media request only. It is mandatory that coaches and designated players participate in interviews if requested. Alex Timiraos will coordinate all post-game interviews.

Practices

Each team will have an opportunity for a 60-min practice time on Thursday, November 24 at the Spieker Aquatics Center, if needed. Times will be allocated based on arrival times and needs. Please submit your

requested practice time to [Gavin Crew \(gcrew@athletics.ucla.edu\)](mailto:gcrew@athletics.ucla.edu) by **Friday, November 18**. If we do not hear from you, we will assume you do not want to practice on Thanksgiving.

Protests

Per NCAA Rule 7-10, protests may be lodged during tournament games or up to five (5) minutes after the conclusion of the game, with the written protest completed within 15 minutes after the completion of the game. To lodge an in-game protest the head coach should notify the nearest referee as soon as possible after the event at the next normal stoppage of play without taking advantage away from either team and inform the referee of the rule or event which the coach is protesting. The Tournament Games Committee shall be immediately notified and render a decision. If the protest is upheld, the clocks shall be reset to the time of the event protested. The coach must file a brief written protest after the game signed by the referees and attached to or written on the official scoresheet. If the situation is a correctable error, as defined in Rule 7-9, referees will correct that at the time and make any necessary clock adjustments. Otherwise, protests will be resolved immediately by the Tournament Games Committee.

Noisemakers

Artificial noisemakers are not allowed at MPSF sporting events. Anyone using an artificial noisemaker will be asked to cease. If they fail to do so the noisemaker will be confiscated and/or the individual may be escorted from the venue.

Sports Medicine

An athletic training area will be set up on site with a treatment table, injury ice, hydroculator packs and coolers of water and Gatorade. A certified athletic trainer will be on deck during competition. Water, cups and injury ice will be set-up for scheduled practices and competition. If your team has additional needs, please contact Jeremy Vail (310) 882-8416 prior to your arrival to UCLA.

A team physician (Dr. Stephan Sweet – 310.882.0494) will be available on call during competition and practices. If a team wishes to have a team physician present at the bench during competition, the doctor must occupy one of the bench seats and count within the 20 persons allowed in the bench area.

Sportsmanship and Conduct

It is fully expected that all student-athletes and institutional athletic department staff personnel will maintain the highest level of sportsmanship and decorum while participating in the MPSF Men's Water Polo Championship. Please be reminded that any conduct related issues shall be reviewed by MPSF Executive Director, Al Beard, for additional sanctions over and above those mandated by NCAA Water Polo Rules should a breach of good sportsmanship and professionalism occur during this event. All such issues will be forwarded to the Athletic Directors of the teams involved.

Squad Size

Each team is allowed a total of 20 members in the bench area during competition. The squad size for the Conference Championship is limited to a maximum of 16 student-athletes and four bench personnel.

Team Roster

Coaches must turn in their Official [Championship Team Roster Form \(Appendix A, page 10\)](#) to the scorer's table no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of each contest. The roster turned in to the desk prior to each team's first tournament game shall constitute that team's tournament roster for the duration of the tournament. No substitutions on that roster shall be allowed during the tournament after that point.

Team Benches

Thirteen (13) chairs will be provided in the bench area. All student-athletes must be in official school uniform and remain seated during competition, with the exception of the Head Coach who may stand per NCAA rules. Coaches and athletic trainers must also be in appropriate team attire. If a team wishes to have a team physician present on the bench during competition, the doctor must occupy one of the bench seats and count within the 20 persons allowed in the bench area. The higher seed team will occupy the bench on the east end of the pool and will be designated the home team on the scoreboard.

Tickets

Tickets may be purchased in advance through the UCLA Ticket Office by calling (310) UCLA-WIN from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. There will be 40 deck tickets (2 per official party) held until November 15, for each team. Please notify Gavin Crew ASAP of your intention to use these tickets.

Advance tickets purchased prior to November 15 can be sent via mail. Tickets purchased after November 15 must be picked up at will call the day of the event.

Player Guest Ticket List

The MPSF does not provide complimentary tickets to championship events, however, teams may elect to purchase tickets for team guests. Teams purchasing tickets for team guests must complete and submit the attached **Player Guest List Form (Appendix C - alphabetized and typed) to Gavin Crew via email (gcrew@athletics.ucla.edu) or fax (310-206-7527) by Wednesday, November 23.** Per NCAA Bylaw 16.2.1.1.1., a complimentary ticket list must be completed and submitted for each day. Each school will be billed for the number of tickets on the list each day. Recipients of player-guest tickets will be required to present proper photo identification to pick up the tickets. The player-guest tickets will be distributed beginning 60 minutes prior to the start of competition each day. All player guest tickets will be on the deck level.

Transportation

Each team is responsible for making its own ground transportation arrangements. Ample rental vehicles are available at each airport. Ground transportation to/from airports is not reimbursable.

Videotaping

Each team may videotape from the reserved area located on the diving platform. Only MPSF teams shall be allowed to videotape during this tournament – representatives of non-MPSF teams shall not be permitted to videotape at any time during this championship event. Coaches of non-MPSF teams seen recording games in the stands will be asked to cease and if they refuse will be asked to leave.

Warm-ups – Pre-game Countdown

Each team will receive 25 minutes to warm-up in the pool prior to each game. If there is an overtime situation in the game prior to yours, you will be allotted 20 minutes for warm-up or a time mutually agreed upon by the coaches. A warm-up pool will be available for teams participating in the next game. Goals will be available in the warm-up pool. This is a sample countdown for the first game each day.
