Entry Limit: There is a limit of 15 boys and 15 girls teams at the True Team Invite. To reserve your team's position at the True Team Invite please complete the Team Registration Form at the link below. A contract for your business office will be sent by Grand Ledge High School, the meet host.

Team Entry: Team entry is full, please contact Andy Marsh with questions. If your team is already registered for the True Team Invite, please register your athletes by the given deadline on Athletic.net.

Entry Fee: \$300 per school --- Each gender from a school must attend to be accepted into the meet.

Admission: \$5.00 – Pre-school free.

T-Shirts: Meet t-shirts and MSU Track and Field merchandise will be available at the competition.

Parking: ** Buses may drop off at Jenison and proceed to MSU Parking Lot 16 by entering the parking lot off Kalamazoo Street. [Bus Parking Map](#)
** Spectators can park in MSU Parking Lot 62W, 63W, and 79. Parking Ramp 7 will be FREE during the True Team Invite.

Awards: Winner and runner-up trophies will be awarded in each boys and girls division. The top three individuals in each event and relay will receive awards.

Entries: Three athletes per individual event and one relay team. The event entry deadline will extend until Monday, March 26 @ 7:00 PM using www.athletic.net. The entries will be closed for 1 hour and then reopened until 11:00 AM on the day of the meet. Teams will not be able to add entries during this extension, only swap runners for each event and make necessary scratches and lineup changes. **Please have all of your final changes made before this deadline.**

Scoring: Individual events score the maximum number of possible entries in each race. Relays will be scored with teams receiving points in multiples of 6. These point totals will be adjusted depending on the number of teams present at the meet. If 13 teams are present then 39 places will score in every individual event and 13 teams in relays with the first place team scoring 78 points. FAT timing will be used for all races under 3200 meters

Coaches will time and keep track of their own runners in the 3200 meter run and the 3200 meter relay. Official time sheets will be distributed to record an athlete's performance in each event.

Events: **High Jump / Pole Vault:** five alive and [the bar may be raised and lowered](#), because of time restraints, until the last few jumpers or vaulters are left.

Only two Pole Vaulters will be allowed to compete from each team.

Long Jump will be open pit with four (4) jumps, no finals, 2 hours per gender!

Shot Put will be four (4) puts and no finals, from shortest to farthest seeds.

Event Schedule: The time schedule will vary depending on the total number of teams and will run ahead of schedule if at all possible. Athletes should listen to True Team Announcer.

Track Events are all timed finals with no prelims or semis. FAT timing will be used except for the 3200 meter run & 3200 meter relay where the coaches will time their individuals.

Only two 3,200 Runners will be allowed to compete from each team.

Notes: The opposite gender will receive a 30 minute warm-up period for each field event after the completion of the previous gender.

Warm-up Jenison Field House will be open for warm-ups starting at 2:30 P.M. Team's arriving before this time will be asked to stay in upper bleachers.

The running events will begin at 3:30 P.M. and maintain a rolling schedule throughout meet. Athletes should listen to all P.A. announcements and show up to the "North" end of Jenison Field House (Playmakers Flag) to check into their running event when they are called.

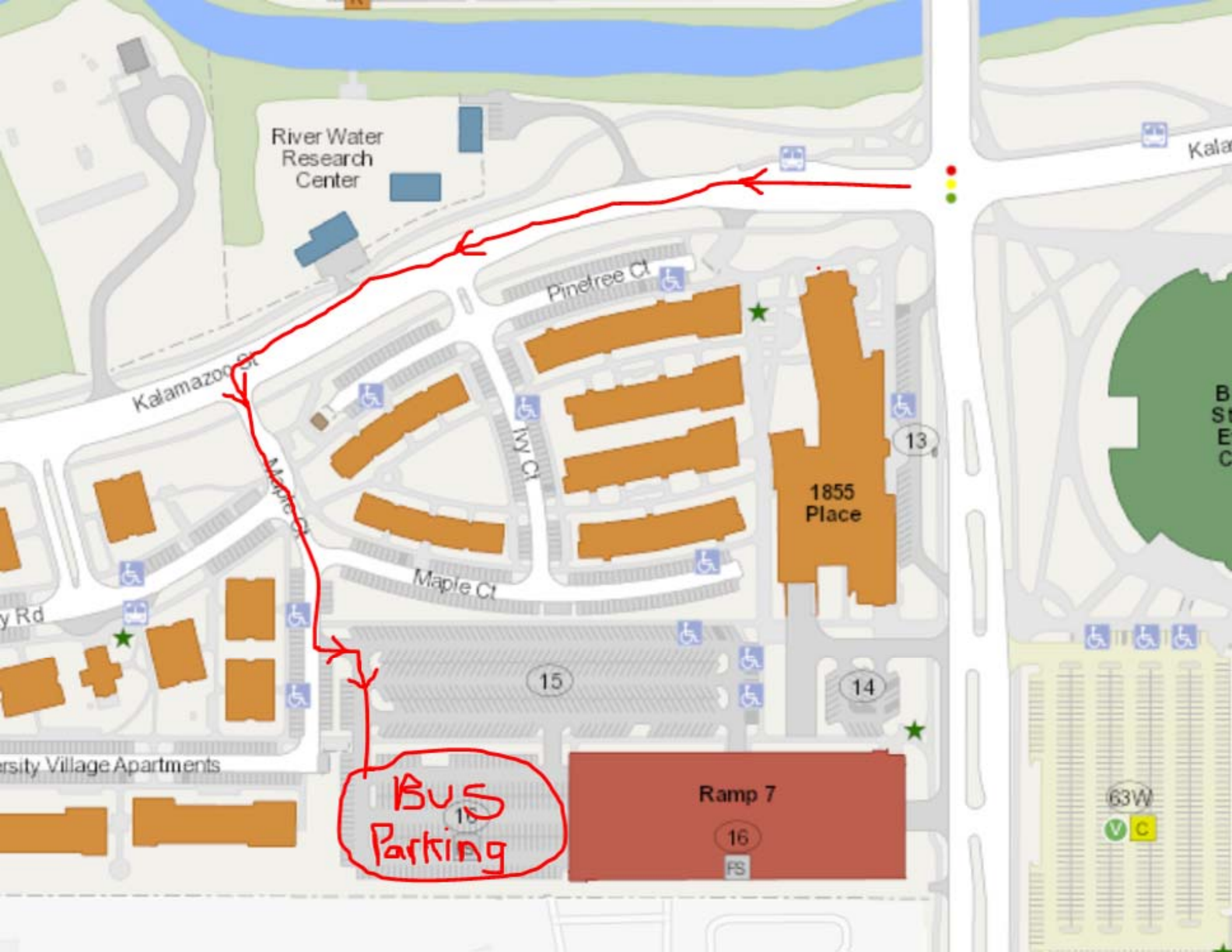
