

Camp Details

Junior Spartan Little League Camp (Grades 1-8) (June 23-26, August 4-7)

Open to players ages 6-12 years, all campers will learn the basic fundamentals of baseball through individual and group instruction and play multiple games daily. Each day will bring a new focus on different areas of the game, fine tuning and teaching the right approach to pitching, hitting and defense. Games will be the main focus of the end of each camp day and emphasize the fundamentals learned in daily instruction.

Daily Schedule: 9am to 3pm (must bring own lunch) Cost: \$250

Spartan Pitching and Catching Camp (Grades 9-12) (July 14)

Open to all high school students who want to learn and fine tune their pitching and catching mechanics. Pitchers will learn the fundamentals that will maximize their performance in games by learning new pitches and the proper fundamentals of pitching. Catchers will learn the fundamentals of the three primary focus areas of catching: receiving, throwing and blocking. The skills developed in this camp will serve as the foundation for future development in high school and beyond. This camp is for the serious ballplayer.

Spartan Hitting and Fielding Camp (Grades 9-12) (July 15)

Open to all high school students who want to learn the proper fundamentals of hitting and fielding. Campers will also focus on drills and techniques to enable you to learn the fundamentals and proper technique to make defensive plays consistently and become a complete player that can compete at the next level. Site & Facility

The setting for the 2008 David Grewe's Top 9 Baseball Summer Camps is Kobs Field on the campus of Michigan State University. In the summer of 2006, Kobs field received a face lift as a new sod playing surface was installed. All Campers will also use MSU's brand new 1.5 million dollar indoor hitting and pitching facility. This new facility (less than a year old), which is located down the left-field line at Kobs Field, houses two indoor clay mounds, four 70-foot long hitting cages, an automatic pitching machine and a 150-foot long throwing lane. All campers will also use the MSU baseball clubhouse. **Free parking is available on campus at lot 63 East and West. The closest available parking is pay lot 62 which is located north of IM West.
