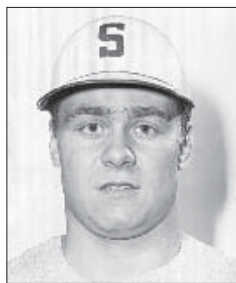
Spartan All-Americans

ELITE SPARTANS

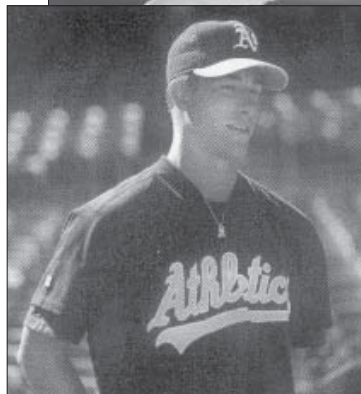
Kirk Gibson

- Joined the Spartan baseball team as a junior in 1978, hitting .390 with 16 home runs and 52 RBIs.
- Four-year football letterwinner amassed 122 career receptions for 2,347 yards and 24 touchdowns.
- Named to the All-America football and baseball teams.
- Detroit Tigers No. 1 draft pick in 1978 (No. 12 overall).
- Hit 20 home runs and stole 20 bases in helping lead the Tigers to the 1984 World Series title.
- Joined the Dodgers in 1988 and picked up his second World Championship ring and hit one of the most memorable home runs in baseball history in Game One of the World Series.
- Named National League MVP in 1988 after hitting .290 with 25 home runs and 76 RBIs.
- Played 17 major league seasons for the Tigers, Dodgers, Pirates and Royals, batting .268 with 255 home runs and 870 RBIs.
- In his first full season as a manager in 2011, led the Arizona Diamondbacks to the NL West title and was named the National League Manager of the Year.
- One of just four people in Major League Baseball history to win both an MVP Award and a Manager of the Year Award.
- Inducted into the MSU Athletics Hall of Fame in 1994.
- One of four Spartans to have his number (30) honored.



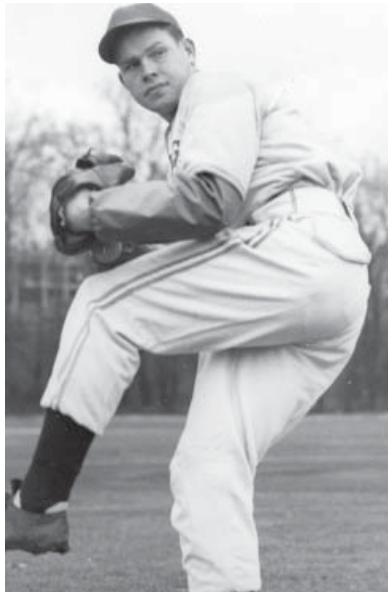
Mark Mulder

- Earned first-team All-Big Ten honors as a sophomore, going 7-2 with four saves and the second-lowest ERA in the Big Ten at 2.26.
- Third-team All-America selection from the NCBWA and Louisville Slugger and first-team All-Big Ten as a junior.
- Went 6-6 with a 3.40 ERA his junior year while hitting a team-best .355 with 11 doubles, five home runs and 30 RBIs.
- Still holds the MSU single-season record with 113 strikeouts.
- Second overall pick in the 1998 MLB draft.
- Made major league debut in April of 2000 at the age of 22.
- Finished second in the Cy Young Award balloting in 2001 and led the AL with 21 wins.
- Went 19-7 in 2002 and 15-9 in 2003 en route to his first All-Star Game appearance.
- Won 17 games in 2004 and started the All-Star Game.
- Signed as a free agent with the Cardinals in 2005 and tallied a 16-8 record that year.
- Earned a World Series ring with the Cardinals in 2006.
- Collected a 103-60 record in nine seasons in the Major Leagues (2000-08).



ELITE SPARTANS

Robin Roberts



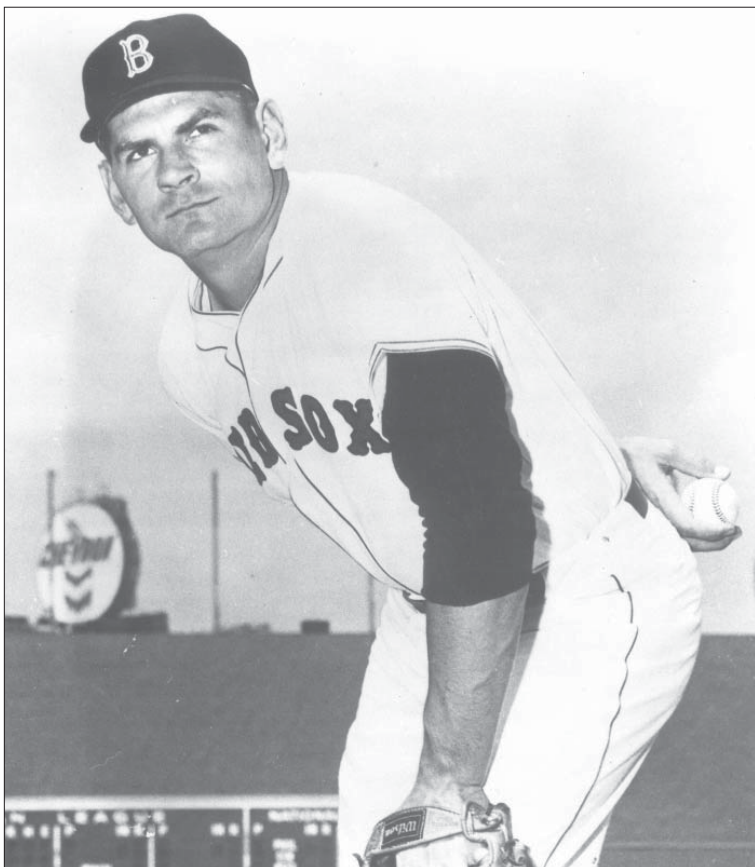
Roberts was honored at the 2008 All-Star Game in New York.

- Came to MSU on a basketball scholarship and joined the baseball team his junior season in 1946.
- Went 9-6 in two seasons for the Spartans while hurling a school-record six shutouts his junior year.
- Made his MLB debut in 1948 with the Philadelphia Phillies.
- Led the Phillies to the NL pennant in 1950 - the team's first pennant in 35 years.
- Won 20 games every season from 1950-55 and led the league in wins four consecutive years starting in 1952.
- Elected to the All-Star team each year from 1950-1956.
- Inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame in 1976.
- Played 19 seasons for the Phillies, Orioles, Astros and Cubs, compiling a 286-245 career record with 2,357 strikeouts, a 3.41 ERA, 305 complete games and 45 shutouts.
- No. 36 was retired by the Phillies.
- Part of the MSU Athletics Hall of Fame inaugural class in 1992.
- One of four Spartans to have his number (36) honored.
- Passed away at the age of 83 on May 6, 2010.

Dick Radatz

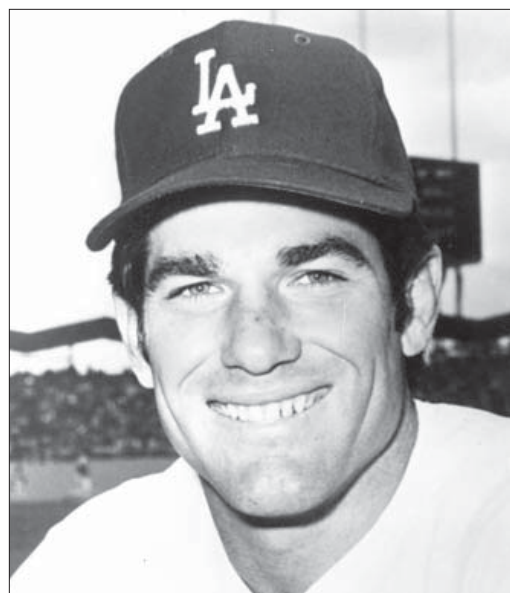


- Three-year letterwinner for the Spartans from 1957-59.
- Went 5-0 as a sophomore and was named second-team All-Big Ten.
- In 1959, he earned first-team All-Big Ten and second-team All-America accolades. He pitched one of the finest single-seasons in school history, going 10-1 with a 1.12 ERA, while striking out 106 batters.
- Signed as a free agent with the Red Sox in 1959 and made his debut as a closer in 1962 where he led the league in saves (24), games (62) and relief wins (9).
- Went 15-6 in 1963 with a 1.97 ERA and 25 saves. Also made his first first All-Star game appearance and finished fifth in the AL MVP voting.
- Led the league in saves (29) in 1964 and recorded 16 wins while posting a 2.29 ERA and earning his second All-Star selection. Racked up 181 strikeouts which still stands today as a relief pitcher record.
- Played seven seasons with the Red Sox, Indians, Cubs, Tigers and Expos. Totaled a 52-43 career record with 122 saves.
- Inducted into the Boston Red Sox Hall of Fame in 1997.
- Posthumously named Michigan State Baseball Distinguished Alumnus of the Year in 2006.

ELITE SPARTANS

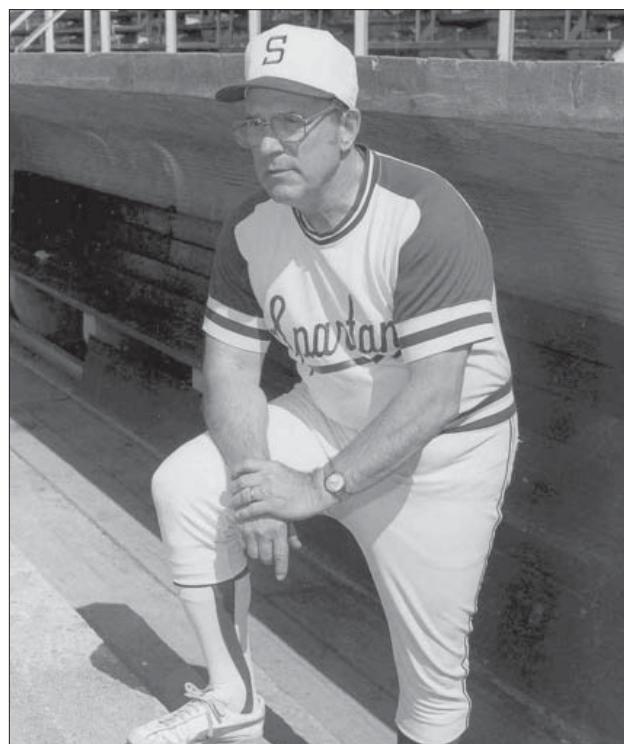
Steve Garvey

- Originally recruited to Michigan State as a baseball player but played one season on the football team, earning a letter as a defensive back in 1967.
- Hit .376 with nine home runs and 38 RBIs in his only season (1968) at MSU and earned All-Big Ten and All-America honors.
- Four-time Gold Glove winner.
- 1974 NL MVP and two-time NLCS MVP (1978 & 1984).
- 10-time All-Star and two-time All-Star MVP (1974 & 1978).
- Played in five World Series.
- Received the Roberto Clemente Award for Humanitarian Service in 1981.
- Won the Lou Gehrig Award in 1985.
- No. 6 was retired by the San Diego Padres.
- Inducted into the MSU Athletics Hall of Fame in 2010.



John Kobs

- Kobs, the winningest coach in program history, coached the Spartans for 39 years - over five decades - and compiled a 576-377-16 record that included 34 winning seasons.
- Led the 1954 team to the only College World Series in program history. Also captured the Big Ten and NCAA District IV titles.
- Coached at least 18 players that made major league rosters - including greats Robin Roberts, Dick Radatz, Ron Perranoski and Tom Yewcic.
- Also served as the head basketball and hockey coach as well as assistant football coach.
- MSU dedicated its baseball facility to Kobs in 1969, a year after his death.
- Inducted into the MSU Athletics Hall of Fame in 1993
- One of four Spartans to have his number (25) honored.



Danny Litwhiler

- Guided the Spartans for 19 seasons, amassing a record of 489-362-8 and capturing Big Ten titles in 1971 and 1979.
- Thirteen of his players went on to the major leagues, including Kirk Gibson, Rick Miller and Steve Garvey.
- Played 11 seasons in majors for Phillies, Cardinals, Braves and Reds with a .281 career average; named an All-Star in 1942.
- Was the first Major Leaguer to play an entire season without committing an error (handling 317 chances in 151 games in 1942).
- Conducted clinics in over 10 countries and contributed in several other ways other than coaching, including the development of the radar speed gun, with the first prototype used at Michigan State now residing in the Baseball Hall of Fame.
- Inducted into the MSU Athletics Hall of Fame in 1994. Also a member of the hall of fame at Bloomsburg University, Florida State University, the Helm Foundation, the Royal Dutch Baseball Association, the American Association of College Baseball Coaches and the state of Pennsylvania.
- Received the "Lefty Gomez Award" for his outstanding contributions to college baseball.
- One of four Spartans to have his number (1) honored.
- Passed away at the age of 95 on Sept. 23, 2011.

Distinguished Alumnus of the Year

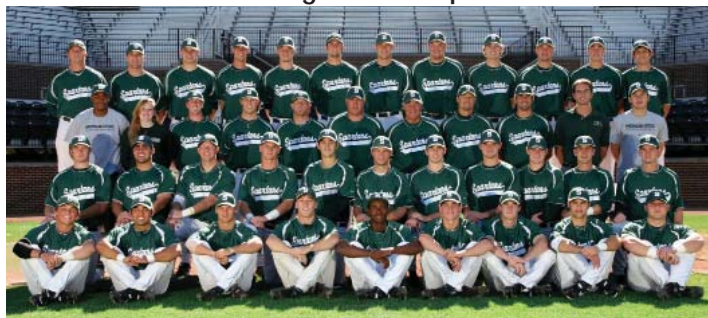

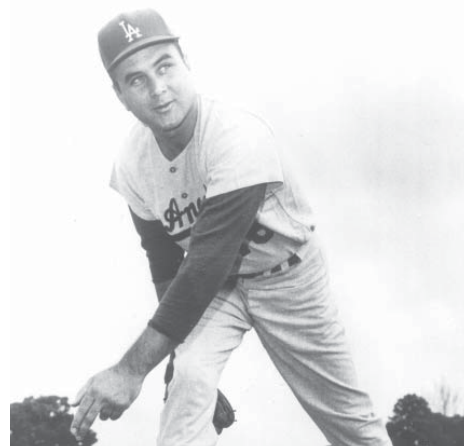
