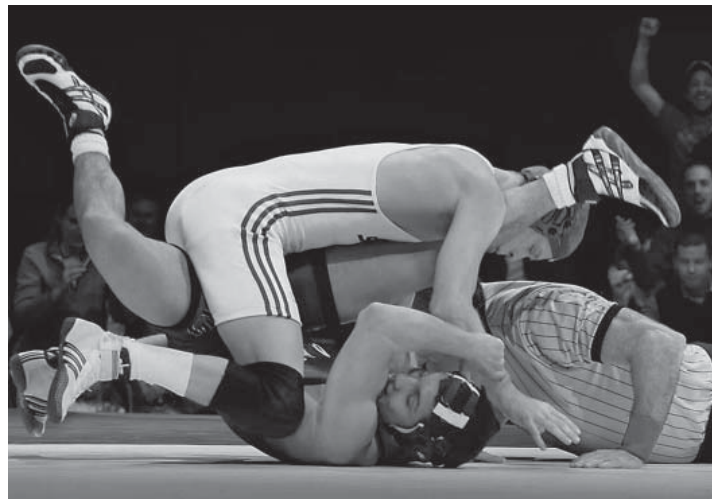

2006 NCAA Championships: Took fourth for the second straight season with a 4-2 record...awed the Oklahoma City crowd by pinning his first three opponents of the tournament: Northern Iowa's Seth Wright in 44 seconds, Lock Haven's Obenson Blanc in one minute and All-American Chad Mendes of Cal Poly at the 6:44 mark...fell in the semifinals of Cornell's Troy Nickerson, 2-1, but rebounded against Oklahoma State's Coleman Scott to reach the consolation finals...fell to Oklahoma's Sam Hazewinkel in the third-place match for the second straight year, 6-2.
