TCU, NEW MEXICO IN NCAA BASEBALL TOURNAMENT

New Mexico and No. 7 TCU each received invitations to the NCAA Division I Baseball Championship. The MW tournament champion Lobos earned one of 30 automatic bids, while the Horned Frogs captured one of 34 at-large berths in the 64-team postseason bracket. The Mountain West received an at-large bid for the third straight year and is one of 10 conferences with multiple representatives in the NCAA Tournament.

Making its eighth consecutive postseason appearance, sixth-ranked TCU (42-17) is slated to host a regional for the third straight year. The Horned Frogs will open against No. 4 seed Oral Roberts (36-20) on Friday, June 3, at 7 p.m. CT at Lupton Stadium. The first match-up at the Fort Worth Regional will feature No. 2 seed Oklahoma (41-17) against No. 3 seed Dallas Baptist (39-17) at 2 p.m. CT.

New Mexico, competing in its second straight NCAA Regional after winning its first MW tournament title, will be the No. 4 seed in the Tempe Regional at Winkles Field-Packard Stadium at Brock Ballpark in Tempe, Ariz. The Lobos (20-39) will take on No. 1 seed and host Arizona State (38-16) at 7 p.m. PT, while No. 2 seed Arkansas (38-20) faces No. 3 seed Charlotte (42-14) in a 2 p.m. PT contest.

The national top eight seeds are: 1. Virginia (48-9), 2. Florida (44-16), 3. North Carolina (45-14), 4. South Carolina (45-14), 5. Florida State (42-16), 6. Vanderbilt (47-9), 7. Texas (43-15), 8. Rice (41-19).

The 16 regional sites, with host institutions and records, are as follows: Georgia Tech (40-19), Atlanta, Ga.; Texas (43-15), Austin, Texas; Cal State Fullerton (39-15), Fullerton, Calif.; North Carolina (45-14), Chapel Hill, N.C.; Virginia (48-9), Charlottesville, Va.; Clemson (41-18), Clemson, S.C.; Texas A&M (41-18), College Station, Texas; South Carolina (45-14), Columbia, S.C.; Oregon State (38-16), Corvallis, Ore.; **TCU (42-17), Fort Worth, Texas**; Florida (44-16), Gainesville, Fla.; Rice (41-19), Houston, Texas; UCLA (33-21), Los Angeles, Calif.; Vanderbilt (47-9), Nashville, Tenn.; Florida State (42-16), Tallahassee, Fla.; and Arizona State (38-16), Tempe, Ariz.

Each regional field features four teams, playing a double-elimination format. All 16 regionals are scheduled to be conducted from Friday, June 3, to Monday, June 6. Selection of the eight super regional hosts will be announced on www.ncaa.com on Monday, June 6 at approximately 9 p.m. MT. The 65th Men's College World Series begins play Saturday, June 18, at the new TD America Park in Omaha, Neb.

MOUNTAIN WEST CHAMPIONSHIP RECAP

The 2011 Mountain West Baseball Championship returned to Tony Gwynn Stadium in San Diego, Calif., with No. 6 seed New Mexico stunning each of the top three seeds en route to capturing its first MW tournament title. The Lobos opened the championship with a 5-4 win in 11 innings over No. 3 seed BYU, and followed with a 4-3 victory against regular-season champion TCU. New Mexico edged No. 2 seed Utah, 6-5, before clinching the 2011 tournament crown with a 4-2 win over the top-seeded Horned Frogs.

TCU RANKED IN NATIONAL POLLS

TCU, who became the first team in the 12-year history of the Mountain West Conference to earn a No. 1 preseason ranking, remains in the Top-11 of all four national polls for the third straight week. The Horned Frogs are ranked No. 6 in the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) poll and No. 7 in the Collegiate Baseball listing. The USA Today/ESPN Coaches' rankings have TCU listed at No. 10, while Baseball America has the Frogs at No. 11.

MW DUO IN RUNNING FOR NATIONAL AWARDS

TCU junior righthander **Kyle Winkler** and Utah junior first baseman **C.J. Cron** are among 30 semifinalists for the 2011 Golden Spikes Award. The Mountain West is one of eight conferences with multiple semifinalists for this year's award, presented to the top amateur baseball player in the nation. Cron is also a semifinalist for the 2011 Dick Howser Trophy.

RECORDS WATCH

▫ New Mexico's **D.J. Peterson** has hit 31 doubles in 2011, which is one shy of the Mountain West single-season record of 32, set by former Lobo Justin Howard in 2010. Peterson's 31 doubles is a new MW single-season record for a freshman.

▫ New Mexico junior reliever **Gera Sanchez** picked up his 12th career save at the MW Tournament last week, moving him into a tie for sixth place on the league's list for career saves.

▫ TCU reliever **Trent Appleby** added to his Mountain West record for career appearances, pitching in his 94th career game last week during MW Tournament action. The senior righthander eclipsed the previous record of 92, which was shared by UNLV's Koji Pupo (2004-07), San Diego State's Royce Ring (2000-02) and Air Force's Michael Ruvolo (2007-10).

▫ TCU starter **Kyle Winkler** enters NCAA Tournament action with league-record marks of 2.95 ERA and .239 opposing batting average for his career. The junior righthander already holds the Mountain West mark for career victories, currently at 27. Fellow Frog hurlers **Matt Purke** and **Steven Maxwell** are tied for seventh on that same list with 21 career victories each.
