MOUNTAIN WEST CONFERENCE SOCCER TEAM NOTES

AIR FORCE (4-15-1, 0-7-0 MWC)

- * Air Force is the No. 8 seed in the MWC Championship and will open up against No. 1 Utah at 2 p.m., Nov. 2.
- * The 3-0 loss to Wyoming marks the second-consecutive season that the Falcons have failed to win a conference game.

BYU (15-1-3, 4-1-2 MWC)

- * BYU is the No. 3 seed in the MWC Championship and will open up against No. 6 San Diego State at 4:30 p.m., Nov. 2.
- * The Cougars have allowed only seven goals this season.
- * BYU's attendance of 3,083 against Utah is the third best in school history, as well as the third highest this season.
- * The tie between BYU and Utah was only the third time in history that the teams went into overtime. Both previous games were played at BYU and resulted in Cougar losses.

NEW MEXICO (6-6-4, 3-3-1 MWC)

- * With the win over TCU, UNM ended the season with an even record of 6-6-4, 3-3-1 in the Mountain West Conference, making it the best record since 2002 when the Lobos went 12-8-1, 3-2-1 in the MWC (head coach Kit Vela's second season).
- * The Lobos ended the season with a 4-2-3 (.611) home record, making it the best winning percentage at home since 1997 when New Mexico went 6-3 (.677).
- * New Mexico has seven shutouts, making it the most shutouts since 2002 when the Lobos notched 10 on the season.
- * New Mexico's senior goalkeeper Kristen Winters has six shutouts to her name this season, boosting her all-time career shutout count to 23. She ends the regular season No. 1 on the all-time career shutout list at UNM.
- * The Lobos head into the conference championship with a two-game winning streak. The last time New Mexico entered the conference tournament with a two or more win streak was in 1997 when the Lobos went into the WAC Championships with four straight victories.

SAN DIEGO STATE (10-8-2, 2-3-2 MWC)

- * SDSU is 8-2 when freshman Erika Sutton records at least one point
- * Aztec sophomore goalkeeper Cat Burson's 85.5 save percentage is second best in school history.

- * SDSU has scored 18 of its 25 goals (72 percent) in the second half.
- * The Aztecs have started 21 different players so far this season and only senior Alexis Solovij has started all 20 games. Solovij has 57 consecutive starts for SDSU.
- * The Aztecs are 12-6-1 (.658) all-time in conference tournament games, including the WAC (1995-98) years.

TCU (6-10-0, 1-6-0 MWC)

- * The Frogs scored only two goals in conference play this season.
- * Katy Buchanan set a new career high with 83 saves.
- * Bjarnveig Birgisdottir has had a hand in the last seven goals the Frogs have score (5 goals, 2 assists)
- * The postseason tournament will be the first the Frogs have appeared in since the 2003 campaign and the sixth overall in their history.

UNLV (10-6-3, 5-2-0 MWC)

- * UNLV finishes second in the conference, its second-straight top-two finish.
- * The Rebels posted their fifth MWC shutout win with a 3-0 victory over SDSU. UNLV finishes with just two goals allowed in league play, lowest in the conference.
- * Tanya Roberts became the fourth Rebel to score twice in the same game in a year with two against SDSU in the 3-0 win.
- * Both of UNLV's goalies have a GAA under one, as senior Jenna Huff has a 0.27 and freshman Ciera Nero has a 0.81 GAA in 13 games played.
- * The Rebels reached double digits in season wins for the second straight year, and fifth time in the last six years.

UTAH (13-5-1, 6-0-1 MWC)

- * The Utes have won four of the last five regular-season and tournament championships in the Mountain West Conference. Utah won both the regular season and tournament titles in 2003, the tournament championship in 2004, and regular-season crown in 2005.
- * Utah's 13 wins this season equal the second-best mark in the 11-year history of the program. The Utes also got 13 wins in 2004 (13-6-3), 2002 (13-4-3), 2000 (13-7-1) and 1999 (13-7-0). Utah set the school single-season wins record with 16 victories in 2004.

- * Utah went undefeated in conference play for the second time. The Utes finished undefeated and untied in league play in 2003, going 6-0 in 2003.
- * Utah is 5-5-1 against NSCAA/adidas Top 25 teams in four seasons under Rich Manning. In the Utes' four games against a ranked teams this season, Utah lost at No. 22 Arizona (1-0 OT) Sept. 16, fell to No. 9 California (1-0 2OT) at home Sept. 25, lost at No. 10 Pepperdine (1-0) Sept. 30, and tied No. 12 BYU (1-1) on the road Oct. 28. In 2004, the Utes won at No. 7 UCLA (2-1) on Oct. 1. Utah was 2-1 against NSCAA/adidas Top 25 teams in both 2002 and '03.
- * The Utes have shutout nine teams this season. Ashley Mason has seven complete-game shutouts and shared two others with Emalee Rogers. Utah has allowed just four goals in seven conference games.

WYOMING (9-6-3, 4-3-0 MWC)

- * The Cowgirl defense has allowed just 1.01 goals a game thus far this season. They have shutout their opponents seven times and have allowed just one goal on six other occasions.
- * The Cowgirls enter the MWC Championships on a four-game win streak. Over that span, the Cowgirls have outscored their opponents, 8-1.
- * The Cowgirls enter the MWC Championships as the fourth-ranked team in the conference. The seed is the second highest in UW history. In 2003, the Cowgirls were the third seed but were upset by New Mexico 2-1 in double overtime. Last year, the Cowgirls entered the tournament as the five seed and lost to fourth seeded Utah, 1-0.
- * The Cowgirls are undefeated in overtime this season, as they are 1-0-3 in extra periods.
- * Senior Mercy Adetoye tied the UW single season goals scored record with her 10th in UW's 2-1 win over Northern Colorado. Adetoye is the UW all-time career leader in goals (24), assists (10), shots (165) and is tied for the second most game-winning goals (5)
- * Senior Kara Walters has started 59 consecutive games and a total of 70 career games. Her 70 starts are the third most in UW history. She also has played in a school record 77 games.
