PLAYER OF THE WEEK

KRISTEN WINTERS
So., GK, LAKEWOOD, COLO.

New Mexico sophomore goalkeeper Kristen Winters has been named the Mountain West Conference Women's Soccer Player of the Week after notching 1-0 shutouts against conference foes San Diego State and UNLV. This is the first weekly accolade of her career and the second for a goalkeeper in the four-year history of the MWC.

Winters, a product of Lakewood, Colo. (Green Mountain HS), recorded 14 saves off of 26 shots to help the Lobos (9-5-0 overall) to a 2-0 record in conference play. In New Mexico's win over the Aztecs, she saved six shots, including four in the second half. Against UNLV, Winters had eight saves (five in the second half), holding the MWC's second-highest scoring team without a goal in the process. On the season, she leads the Mountain West in shutouts (six) and is second in saves (66).

MWC QUICK HITS

AIR FORCE

- Air Force has lost three straight matches and five of its last six.
- After scoring a season-high five goals in the win over UNC Greensboro on Oct. 4, the Falcons have scored just three goals in the last three games.
- AFA has been outscored 20-6 in the first half this season.
- Junior midfielder **Cookie Day** and senior forward **Mary Cholko** lead the team with five goals each. Day has 12 total points while Cholko has 11.

BYU

- BYU is currently on a five-game winning streak, four of which were on the road.
- During the win streak, the Cougars have outscored their opponents 15-4.
- BYU concludes its six-game road swing this week with games at New Mexico and #23 Notre Dame.
- Eleven different Cougars have scored at least one goal this season.

NEW MEXICO

- Sophomore midfielder **Rachael Addison** scored both goals (game-winners) in the Lobos victories over San Diego State and UNLV last week.
- Sophomore goalkeeper **Kristen Winters** has an MWC high six shutouts this year.
- Junior midfielder **Erchen Theys** currently leads New Mexico in points with 14 (5 goals, 4 assists).

SAN DIEGO STATE

- Senior forward **Nicole Findlay** is second or tied for second on the Aztecs in goals (4), assists (three) and total points (11).
- San Diego State leads the MWC in assists (25) and assists per game (2.08), and is third in total points (75).
- Junior forward **Kim Castellanos** is second in the MWC in total points (16), points per game (1.60), assists per game (0.40) and goals per game (0.60) and third in goals (6) and assists (4).

UNLV

- UNLV leads the MWC in goals per game (2.23) and is second in points (78), goals (29) and goals against average (1.12)
- Senior midfielder **Kelly Janke** currently has five assists on the year, which is one off the school individual season record of six (held by **Anita Pedford** and senior midfielder **Cristyn Enea**).

UTAH

- Junior forward **Missy Dennis** leads the Utes in goals (seven) and points (16), despite not starting a game this season.

WYOMING

- Saturday's 1-0 loss to BYU marks the fifth time this season that Wyoming has been shutout.
- Junior goalkeeper **Lori Scheider** has fifteen more saves than her opponents this season (78-63).
