PLAYER OF THE WEEK
COOKIE DAY
So., M, MANSFIELD, TEXAS

Air Force sophomore midfielder **Cookie Day** has been named the Mountain West Conference Women's Soccer Player of the Week for her career-best five-point performance in the Falcons 5-4 comeback victory over UNC Greensboro. This is her first career weekly honor.

Day, a Mansfield, Texas, native, scored two goals (also a career-best), including the game-winner, and added an assist for her five points. She gave Air Force a 1-0 advantage with a goal (assisted by Raegan McDowell) in the 15th minute. After four consecutive goals by the Spartans and a Falcon goal by Raegan McDowell, she assisted Mary Cholko's game-tying goal in the 69th minute then knocked in the unassisted game-winner from the top of the box in the 86th minute, securing the victory. On the season, Day leads the Falcons with five goals, three game-winning, and 12 total points.

MWC QUICK HITS
AIR FORCE

- Air Force's five goals in the win over UNC Greensboro are its most in a match since scoring 14 against Youngstown State in 2000.
- Junior midfielder **Cookie Day's** five points against UNCG are the most by a Falcon player this season. Her two goals tied the most by a Falcon this season.
- The Falcons posted a season high in goals (five), assists (three), points (13), shots (31) and shots on goal (15) against the Spartans.
- AFA's 8-1 loss to UC Santa Barbara was its worst since a 7-0 loss to BYU last season.

BYU

- Six different Cougars have scored a goal in BYU's last two games.
- BYU is currently on a three-game winning streak with wins over St. Mary's, Washington State and Montana.
- The Cougars continue their six-game road swing this week with conference games at Air Force and Wyoming.

NEW MEXICO

- Sophomore goalkeeper **Kristen Winters** has 53 saves on the season, along with four shutouts.
- New Mexico concludes its five-game road trip this week with conference games at San Diego State and UNLV.
- Sophomore forward **Marte Dolva** and junior midfielder **Erchen Theys** are currently tied for the team lead in points with 13. They both have five goals and three assists on the season.

SAN DIEGO STATE

- Senior forward **Nicole Findlay** is the third Aztec to score multiple goals in a match this season. Junior forward **Kim Castellanos** and freshman midfielder **Lisette Martinez** each scored a pair of goals in the Aztecs season opener vs. UC Riverside.
- San Diego State leads the MWC in assists (23) and assists per game (2.30) and is third in total points (63).
- **Kim Castellanos** leads the MWC in points per game (2.00) and assists per game (0.50) and is second in total points (16), goals (6), goals per game (0.75) and assists (4).

UNLV

- The Rebels claimed their fifth shutout of the season with the 2-0 win over Houston.
- Freshman goalkeeper **Jenna Huff** has tallied a 6-1 record so far this season, with an impressive 0.80 goals against average in nine games played. The shutout against Houston was her third of the year.
- Senior midfielder **Kelly Janke** currently has five assists on the year, which is one off the school individual season record of six (held by **Anita Pedford** and senior midfielder **Cristyn Enea**).

UTAH

- Junior forward **Missy Dennis** leads the Utes in goals (six) and points (12), despite not starting a game this season.

WYOMING

- Wyoming outshot North Texas 22-15, marking only the fourth time this season the Cowgirls have outshot an opponent.
- The Cowgirls had a team season high two assists in its 3-1 victory over the Mean Green. They also recorded the second highest point total (eight), goals (three), shots (22) and shots on goal (13) in school history against UNT.
