Air Force freshman forward **Jennifer Rowland** has been named the Mountain West Conference Women's Soccer Player of the Week after helping the Falcons post two conference victories vs. UNLV and San Diego State last week. This is Rowland's second weekly honor of the season.

Rowland, a product of La Canada, Calif., netted two goals on four shots this past week as the Falcons swept conference foes UNLV and San Diego State at home. In Friday's 3-2 victory over the Rebels, she scored the first goal of the match, while collecting the third goal in the Falcons 3-0 shutout of the Aztecs Sunday.

MWC QUICK HITS

AIR FORCE

- The Falcons concluded their home schedule this past weekend with a sweep of conference foes UNLV, 3-2, and San Diego State, 3-0. It was just the second time in school history Air Force has won two conference games over a weekend and the first win over the Aztecs in four tries.
- After losing their last three regular season conference matches by a single goal, the Falcons tallied three goals in back-to-back MWC games for the first time.
- Air Force improved to 6-0 when leading at the half this season. The Falcons are also 6-0 when scoring the first goal of the contest.

BYU

- BYU lost its first match vs. a MWC opponent in 13 contests, 1-0, to New Mexico Friday. It was also the Cougars first home conference loss since Oct. 24, 1998 (1-0 to San Diego State).
- BYU was shutout this past week by Nebraska (2-0) and New Mexico (1-0). It was the second time in the program's seven-year history it has been blanked in back-to-back matches (lost 2-0 to SMU and 1-0 to Santa Clara in 1997).

NEW MEXICO

- New Mexico ended a five-match losing streak to BYU with its 1-0 victory Friday. The Lobos were the first team to blank the Cougars on their home field since Sept. 24, 1999 when Washington posted a 3-0 win over BYU, a span of 23 home games.
- Senior goalkeeper Shelly Hammock leads the conference with 5.53 saves per game and a total of 83.

SAN DIEGO STATE

- The Aztecs tied Wyoming Friday, 1-1, marking their first tie in 63 matches.
- San Diego State lost to Air Force for the first time in four meetings, 3-0.
- Sophomore Kim Castellanos currently leads the MWC in goals (10) and points (22).

UNLV

- Senior midfielder **Anita Pedford** is currently the Rebels' all-time leading scorer with 21 goals and 15 assists for 57 points. She is also first on the UNLV career list for assists (15) and tied with teammate Janae Sims for the most goals scored (21).
- UNLV is the only team in the MWC to score a goal in every match this season. It also holds the longest current scoring streak in the league at 20. The last time the Rebels were shutout was 5-0 by BYU Oct. 14, 2000.

The NCAA Executive Committee approved the expansion of the Division I women's soccer field from 48 to 64 teams, effective with the 2001 tournament. This is the second expansion since 1998 for women's soccer when the field went from 32 to 48 teams.
