MOUNTAIN WEST CONFERENCE SOCCER TEAM NOTES

CONFERENCE QUICK HITS

- Utah clinched its second consecutive MWC regular-season title with a 2-0 win over San Diego State. Utah has a perfect 6-0 record in conference play and has not allowed a goal.
- The MWC's unprecedented women's soccer television coverage continues as the mtn. and CSTV will feature the San Diego State at New Mexico Soccer Insider, a behind-the-scenes look at the events leading up to the game. The documentary-style show will air Sat., Oct. 28 at noon p.m. MT on the mtn., and Sun., Oct. 29 at 6 p.m. MT on CSTV. The mtn. will also feature the UNLV vs. BYU matchup via tape delay on Oct. 29 at 2 p.m. MT.
- This week rounds out the final weekend of conference play. The MWC Championship will be held Nov. 1-4 in Salt Lake City, Utah. Tournament seedings will be announced on Sunday, Oct. 29.

TEAM QUICK HITS

- **Air Force** sophomore GK **Erin Wallace's** five shutouts is second all-time in a season at the Academy. Her 1,619 minutes logged is an Air Force sophomore record.
- **BYU's** **Erika Woodbury's** shutout against Wyoming was her 10th of the season, moving her into the No. 1 spot at BYU for shutouts in a single season. She is three shutouts away from the all-time shutout record
- **New Mexico's** 1-1 tie with No. 16 BYU was the seventh overtime match of the year for the Lobos. UNM has a 0-3-4 overtime record this season but have tied four of this last five matches in golden goal action.
- **SDSU's** **Jen Mello** has tied a career-high in goals (8) and set a career-high in points (19) and assists (3) this season.
- **TCU's** freshmen duo of **Lizzy Karoly** and **Michelle Nguyen** leads the conference in shots with 62 and 58 shots, respectively.
- Eight of **UNLV's** last 10 games have been decided by just one goal, and the Rebels are 5-3 in those eight games.
- **UNLV's** junior class has scored 11 of the team's 23 goals, and has 10 of UNLV's 18 assists.
- After going 4-4 through its first eight games, **Utah** has reeled-off nine wins in a row for the longest winning streak in school history.
- The **Utes** have also held their last eight opponents scoreless to set a school record while climbing to their highest national ranking ever of No. 11 in the NSCAA/adidas poll.
- **Wyoming** defeated UNLV in Las Vegas for the first in school history. With the win, the Cowgirls clinched a postseason berth into the MWC Championship.
