PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Glennis Donnelly, a St. Louis, Mo., product, went 10-for-13 (.769) at the plate in four games for the Utes last week at the Hawaii Invitational in Honolulu, Hawaii. She hit three home runs, a double, knocked in five RBI and scored five runs, while hitting safely in all four games. In Utah's first game against No. 3 California, Donnelly belted a homer and a double, drove in two runs and scored a run of her own. She followed with a 2-for-3 performance from the plate against Hawaii, smashing her second home run of the tournament (a solo shot) and scoring another run. Against No. 25 Northwestern, Donnelly went 2-for-4 with an RBI single, then wrapped up the tournament with a 3-for-3 outing against 21st-ranked Texas. Against the Longhorns, she hit her third homer of the weekend and scored three runs. Defensively, Donnelly compiled a .917 fielding percentage on the week.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Niki Andersen, a Sandy, Utah, native, went 3-1 in four appearances for the Cougars at the San Diego Classic last week, collecting her first career no-hitter in the process. On the weekend, she gave up no earned runs, six hits and three walks, while striking out 26 in 21.1 innings of work. After a strong two-hit, five strikeout outing against San Diego, she relieved Ariel Capra in the fifth inning of a tied contest with Dartmouth, striking out two batters and holding the Big Green hitless and scoreless in two innings to notch the victory in BYU's 10-5, eight inning win. Andersen followed with her first ever no-hitter in an 8-0 win over Central Connecticut State, fanning nine batters and walking three. The no-hitter was only the second in BYU school history and the first since Maryon DeWitt-Wallentine held Utah State hitless on March 21, 2001. Andersen ended her week by collecting her third complete game victory in the 3-2 Cougar win over UC Riverside. Against the Highlanders, she struck out 10, while scattering three hits and walking one. On the season, Andersen is 8-3, with a 1.93 ERA and 59 strikeouts in 56.0 innings.

AROUND THE MWC

BYU

- BYU went 3-1 at the San Diego Classic last weekend, improving its record to 14-7 on the season.
- As a team, the Cougars hit a combined two home runs, four doubles, seven triples and stole eight bases last weekend.
- Sophomore **Ianeta Le'i** was the offensive spark for BYU at the San Diego Classic, hitting .500 (7-for-14) from the plate, with two triples and a stolen base. Freshman **Jodi Norton** and junior **Lauren Watson** also hit well, batting .417 (5-for-12) and 5-for-16 (.313), respectively.
- **Norton** leads the team with seven doubles, while senior **Kate Walker** leads the Cougars in batting average (.346) and home runs (five).
- This week the Cougars will compete at the Stanford Invitational hosted by No. 10 Stanford in Palo Alto, Calif. BYU will face the 10th-ranked Cardinal, Illinois, Hawaii and UC Riverside.

COLORADO STATE

- The Rams are currently riding a season-high six-game winning streak. Over the stretch, the team recorded a .658 batting average, while the pitching staff held opponents to just a .214 batting average. CSU also out-hit opponents 62-44 and out-scored the opposition by a 39-6 margin. Colorado State also recorded 22 extra base hits and held teams to just five.
- The Rams as a team hit eight home runs in the final seven games of the Rebel Spring Games last week, moving the season total to 33 and eclipsing the old mark of 26 with at least 22 games still slated to be played this season.
- The 2004 team currently ranks first in the single season record books at Colorado State with a team batting average of .333, slugging percentage of .539 and home runs (33), ranks second with a .970 fielding percentage, and fourth in both doubles (62) and winning percentage (.710).

NEW MEXICO

- The Lobos finished their first homestand of the season with a 5-1 record. They hit .268 compared to their opponents .200 average and outscored them 19-6.
- Sophomore **Stephanie Kennedy** leads the team with a .325 batting average, 38 hits and 117 at-bats. Sophomore **Iraina Ogas** leads the team in RBI (18) and is tied for the lead in home runs (five) with junior **Cassie Chavez**, while senior **Sabrina Sandberg** leads the team in runs scored (17).
- The Lobos pitching staff has a team ERA of 2.30, with 19 complete games, nine shutouts and six saves. Junior ace **Ashley Perkins** is 10-3 on the season with a team-low 1.45 ERA, while **Iraina Ogas** is 7-2 with a 2.27 ERA.

SAN DIEGO STATE

- Aztec head coach **Kathy Van Wyk** won her 254th game last week with SDSU's 6-0 win over Buffalo, becoming the winningest coach in San Diego State history, breaking former Aztec coach **Linda Spradley's** (1988-94) school record of 253 wins. From 1995-96, the two shared head coaching duties and compiled a 48-69-0 mark.

UNLV

- UNLV has played six of its last eight games against teams ranked in the top 25.
- The Rebels have won seven straight games against unranked opponents.
- Just halfway through the year, senior outfielder **Bridget Byrne** already has more hits (51) than she has ever had in a single season.
- UNLV will play top-ranked Arizona for the third and fourth times this season in a doubleheader this week in Tucson, Ariz. It will mark three games vs. the Wildcats in a nine-day stretch.
- The Rebels will not play another tournament before the Mountain West Conference Championship in May.

UTAH

- Senior Glennis Donnelly leads the MWC in batting average (.476), slugging percentage (.915), doubles (12, tied with CSU's Ricki Walker), and total bases (75).
