**PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**Ricki Walker**, an Aurora, Colo., native, led the Rams to conference series sweeps over BYU and Utah last week, batting .500 (6-for-12) from the plate, with six RBI, two runs scored, a home run and a double. In the BYU series, she went 2-for-6 from the plate, with an RBI single and a run scored. Walker went 1-for-3 with two RBI in game one vs. Utah, and concluded her weekend with a 3-for-3 performance in game two against the Utes. Walker gave CSU an early 2-0 lead with her two-run homer in the bottom of the first. She also added an RBI single as Colorado State beat Utah, 4-1, for its sixth straight win in MWC play. On the season, Walker is batting .425, with four home runs and 31 RBI.

**Genevieve Kelly**, from Rio Rancho, N.M., went 2-0 for Colorado State last weekend, tossing a complete game in the process. In CSU's game two win over BYU, Kelly fanned eight batters, while scattering three hits, in her fourth complete game victory of the season. In 4.2 innings of work in game two against Utah, she struck out three and gave up a run (on a passed ball), earning her eighth victory of the season.

**AROUND THE MWC  
BYU**

- BYU is 22nd in the nation in scoring (5.05 runs/game) and 28th in batting average (.292).

**COLORADO STATE**

- With four wins this weekend, head coach Mary Yori now holds a 96-96 career record at CSU, which is the first time she has been at the .500 level since taking over in Fort Collins.
- Six Rams hit .400 or better last weekend, including **Ricki Walker** (.500), **Genevieve Kelly** (.500), **Megan Masser** (.500), **Brittany Burtner** (.462), **Jessica Strickland** (.455) and **Kerry Farrell** (.400). Each of these players, along with freshman **Brittany Huerta**, slugged over .500 on the weekend, led by Walker's .833 slugging percentage.
- **Brittany Huerta** hit her 11th home run of the season in game one vs. BYU last weekend, tying her with **Holly Schmillen** (2000) and **Sarah Fredstrom** (1998) for the CSU single season home run record.
- The Rams added two home runs and doubles to its school record total of 41 and 73, respectively, and increased their MWC-leading batting average to .333 and team slugging percentage to .522 on the season. This season's team also became only the second team in school history to reach the 200 RBI plateau, and currently ranks second all-time with 217 runs scored, a .973 fielding percentage and a .732 winning percentage.

**NEW MEXICO**

- The Lobos earned their first conference win of the season last weekend, beating Utah, 7-6.
- Sophomore **Iraina Ogas** was the workhorse for New Mexico over the weekend. She pitched 18 of the 24 innings played, going 1-2 with a 0.78 ERA. She allowed just two earned runs on 12 hits with 11 strikeouts.
- Sophomore **Stephanie Kennedy** leads the team with a .322 batting average and 47 hits. Junior **Cassie Chavez** leads the Lobos in at bats (154) and is tied with **Iraina Ogas** for the most RBI (20), while senior **Sabrina Sandberg** has scored a team-high 23 runs and has a team-best seven homers.

**SAN DIEGO STATE**

- San Diego State has won 15 consecutive home MWC games, adding to the previous school record of seven, from March 30-May 4, 2002.
- The Aztecs' current seven-game winning streak is their longest since a school-record 13-game win streak last season.
- Sophomore pitcher **Celena Velasquez** has settled into the "closer" role on the SDSU team, having come into all of San Diego State's last six games from the bullpen and earning two wins and four saves, the team's first four of the season.
- Catcher **Danielle Touhey** (Fresno, Calif.) went 2-for-3 in game two vs. UNLV, her first two-hit performance since March 15, 2003, when she was 2-for-4 against Eastern Kentucky.
- San Diego State embarks on perhaps the most challenging road trip of the season this week, playing at New Mexico on Friday and at second-place Colorado State on Sunday. The Aztecs (29-18-0, 8-2-0) are one game ahead of the Rams (30-11-0, 6-2-0 MWC) in the MWC standings.

**UNLV**

- UNLV plays six of its last 10 regular season games at home.
- The Rebels's 6-1 win over UC Riverside marked the 600th win the program's 23-year history.

**UTAH**

- Senior **Glennis Donnelly** needs just one more double to tie the Ute single season record of 17 set by **Sunny Smith** in 2000. Her 16 ranks fourth in the NCAA for doubles per game (0.42), while her 12 home runs ranks 12th for homers per game (0.32).
- The last time Utah and BYU played there were 15 extra base hits between the two teams so look for another slugfest at Ute Field this weekend.
- Freshman **Devina Quintero** leads the league with a .438 average, an .813 slugging percentage, 14 hits and 12 RBI, while being tied for first with three home runs in league game only rankings.

The two top teams in the MWC, San Diego State and Colorado State, will battle for the MWC lead on Sunday in Fort Collins, Colo., headlines this weekend's schedule.
