# About the MWC

The Mountain West Conference was formed in the spring of 1998, when the presidents of eight institutions - Air Force, Brigham Young, Colorado State, New Mexico, San Diego State, UNLV, Utah and Wyoming - met in Denver and decided to form the MWC.

The cornerstone of the conference's formation was the maintenance of long standing athletic rivalries and the common vision of academic and athletic success among its member institutions.

The Mountain West Conference is consistently represented at NCAA Championship competition, sending teams and individuals to compete for national titles. MWC student-athletes have garnered numerous athletic awards, including All-America honors. Academically, MWC student-athletes have received conference and national honors, including NCAA postgraduate scholarships.

The Mountain West Conference is noted for its geographic diversity. Some of the most beautiful geography in the nation can be found within the Mountain West Conference boundaries, including the unparalleled Rocky Mountain range, which borders four MWC schools (Utah, BYU, Air Force and Colorado State). The high plains of Wyoming (elevation 7,000 feet) contrast with the desert city of Las Vegas (the fastest growing metropolitan area in the West), the balmy weather and Pacific Ocean locale of San Diego State and the southwestern flavor of New Mexico.
