**FIRST ROUND/QUARTERFINAL MWC CHAMPIONSHIP MATCHES:**

**Nov. 22 (Wednesday)**

**#8 New Mexico vs. #9 Air Force, 3:30 p.m.**

New Mexico leads all-time MWC Tournament series, 1-0. The Lobos and Falcons meet in the MWC Championship for the first time since the quarterfinals of the 1999 tournament. New Mexico is 1-7 all-time in tournament play, while Air Force will be looking for their first-ever win in MWC Championship play.

**Nov. 23 (Thursday)**

**#3 Colorado State vs. #6 TCU, 11 a.m. (the mtn.)**

Colorado State leads the all-time series 7-1, and swept both regular-season meetings this season. The Rams and Horned Frogs are meeting in the MWC Tournament for the first time. Colorado State is 14-4 all-time in conference tournament play, while TCU is 1-1 after competing for the first time last year. The Rams are three-time tournament champions (1999, 2003, 2004), having advanced to the championship match five times (3-2).

**#2 BYU vs. #7 San Diego State, 40 minutes after the end of CSU/TCU (the mtn.)**

The Cougars are 34-14 all time vs. the Aztecs, winning 20 of the last 22 meetings overall. BYU and San Diego State meet in the first round of the MWC tournament for the second time in three years. The Cougars defeated SDSU, 3-0, in the 2004 tournament. The 2000 tournament champion BYU, a No. 2 seed for the second time, is 12-6 all-time in MWC Tournaments, while San Diego State is 3-7.

**#1 Utah vs. Winner of #8 New Mexico/#9 Air Force, 4 p.m. (the mtn.)**

Utah leads the all-time series vs. New Mexico, 37-27 and hold a 19-0 all-time record vs. Air Force. The three-time and defending tournament champion Utes are 15-4 all-time in the MWC Tournament play. Utah is the No. 1 seed for the second time in three years, and is looking to advance to the finals for the sixth consecutive time.

**#4 UNLV vs. #5 Wyoming, 40 minutes after the end of BYU/UNM-AFA winner (the mtn.)**

UNLV has the lead in the all-time series, 12-11, and split the two regular season meetings with Wyoming in 2006. UNLV and Wyoming meet for the second time in MWC Tournament play. The Rebels won the last meeting, 3-1, in the 2004 tournament. UNLV is 3-7 all-time in the MWC Championship, while Wyoming has an all-time mark of 0-7.

**MWC CHAMPIONSHIP TO BE TELEvised**

For the seventh straight year, the Mountain West Volleyball Championship will be televised. The quarterfinals and semifinals will be televised by the mtm. - MountainWest Sports Network. All four of Thursday's quarterfinal matches and Friday's first semifinal contest will be shown live, with the second semifinal to be shown via same day tape delay at 9:30 p.m. (PT). For the third straight season, the MWC Tournament championship match will be shown live nationally on College Sports Television (CSTV). The championship contest will also be streamed live as part of CSTV's All-Access package, available on the CSTV (www.cstv.com) and MWC (www.themwc.com) Web sites.

**MWC PRESENTS JUNIOR VOLLEYBALL DAY**

As part of this week's MWC Volleyball Championship, the Mountain West Conference will be providing a volleyball clinic to Las Vegas area middle school students. The clinic will be open to all area students grade 6-8 and will take place at the Cox Pavilion on Friday, Nov. 24 at 11 a.m. All participants will have an opportunity to meet the student-athletes in person and learn sport tips and skills directly from them. In addition to the clinic, all participants will be given free admission to the Friday volleyball matches, as well as have an opportunity to participate in other events throughout the day. **HOW THE SEEDS FARE IN CHAMPIONSHIP PLAY**

For the second time in seven MWC Championships, the No. 3 seed took home the tournament crown in 2005, as Utah became the second team to win three MWC Tournament championships since the inception of the league in 1999. The Utes join Colorado State as the teams that won the championship three times. Utah is also the only No. 3 seed to win the tournament title, accomplishing the feat twice ('02 and '05). Each of the top four seeds have made it to the finals, while the No. 5 seed has two semifinal appearances. The bottom four seeds have never advanced to the semifinals. Below is a look at MWC Championship results by seed.

## MWC CHAMPIONSHIP FACTS

- The MWC Championship will be played in Las Vegas, Nev., for the second consecutive year. The event has also been played in Fort Collins, Colo., three times, Provo, Utah, twice and San Diego once.
- Utah and Colorado State are the only team to repeat as conference tournament champions. The Utes and Rams are also the only league teams to win the championship three times. Utah won the tournament title in 2001, 2002 and 2005, while CSU took the crown home in 1999, 2003 and 2004.
- BYU is the only No. 4 seed to advance to the championship match (2002), while Utah is the only No. 3 seed to win the tournament title, doing so twice (2002 and 2005). The No. 1 and No. 2 seeds have met in the finals in five of the last seven years, with the No. 2 seed winning four of those matches.
- The MWC Tournament has produced three different champions in seven years.
- Colorado State has played a five-game match in five of the seven MWC Tournaments. The Rams are 2-3 in five-game matches in tournament play, including an 0-2 mark in five-game championship matches.

## NCAA SELECTIONS NOVEMBER 26

Following next week's championship, Mountain West Conference teams will await the at-large announcements to the 2006 NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Championship. The winner of the MWC Tournament will receive the conference's automatic bid. The selections will be shown live Sunday, Nov. 26 between 3 and 3:30 p.m. ET on ESPNEWS.

## PERFECTION

Ninth-ranked Utah became the second Mountain West Conference team to complete a perfect sweep through league play, posting a 16-0 mark. The Utes' join Colorado State's 2003 squad as the only teams to finish conference play undefeated. Utah's 16 conference wins also sets a record for league wins in a single season. Since 1999, the Utes have the second-best league conference record at 93-23, including a 51-7 mark at home.

## ACADEMIC HONORS

Five MWC volleyball student-athletes garnered *ESPN The Magazine* Academic All-District honors. TCU senior Anna Vaughn was named to the District VI first-team, while New Mexico senior Kelly Therkelsen earned second-team honors in District VI. Colorado State junior Katherine Whitney and Wyoming senior Andrea Seele were both third-team honorees for District VII, while BYU senior Lindsay Hartssock earned District VIII first-team honors.

**MWC Quick Hits**

**AIR FORCE** -- Air Force was swept by 20th-ranked BYU and No. 9 Utah last week...The Falcons will enter the MWC Tournament as a No. 9 seed for the second straight season and take on No. 8 New Mexico on Wednesday afternoon...Freshman **Michelle Harrington** has led Air Force in blocks in 11 of the last 14 matches...Freshman **Katie Batchelder** is the only Falcon to pass the 200 kill mark in 2006...She currently has 223 kills on the season...Junior **Rebecca Gerton** is ranked second in the league in services aces, notching 0.39 per game.

**BYU** -- No. 20 BYU went 2-0 to end the regular-season and clinch the No. 2 seed in the MWC Tournament...The last time the Cougars were a No. 2 seed (2000), they defeated Colorado State to win the tournament title...The Cougars have swept 17 of their 24 wins this season and also hold a 5-0 record in five game matches...Junior **Chelsea Goodman** has a league-best 16 double-doubles in 2006...She has a career-total of 32 double-doubles which ranks fourth all-time in MWC history...BYU finished the season with a 12-1 home record and is now 22-1 over the last two seasons at Smith Fieldhouse.

**COLORADO STATE** -- CSU went 0-2 in its last weekend of regular-season play, losing to No. 20 BYU and ninth-ranked Utah...The Rams will be the No. 3 seed in this week's MWC Tournament, and will face sixth-seed TCU in the first quarterfinal match Thursday...Sophomore **Jaime Strauss** notched a career-high 24 kills, and also had 11 digs vs. the Cougars...Freshman **Katelin Batten** tallied 23 kills, marking the third straight match and fourth time in the last five matches she has had 20 or more kills...Colorado State played nine games last weekend, losing in five to BYU and four to Utah...Seven of the nine were decided by the minimum two points...The Rams became the first MWC school to hit 100 conference match wins, doing so against San Diego State on Nov. 10.

**NEW MEXICO** -- The Lobos lost to Wyoming, 0-3, in their last regular season match of the year...New Mexico earned the eighth seed in the MWC Championship and will face ninth-seeded Air Force in the first round match Wednesday afternoon...Senior **Kelly Therkelsen** led UNM with 11 kills and a .333 hitting percentage vs. the Cowgirls...Sophomore **Gayle Tripp** posted a match-high 19 digs...Tripp currently has 415 digs this season which is fourth on the UNM season charts.

**SAN DIEGO STATE** -- San Diego State lost its final match of the regular season to UNLV, 3-0...The Aztecs are the seventh seed in the MWC Championship and will face second-seed BYU Thursday afternoon...Junior **Aime Cordeiro** finished the match with 17 digs and now has a total of 521 on the season, the second-most ever by an SDSU player...She needs just 24 more digs to break the all-time SDSU season mark...Seniors **Melanie Greene** and **Audra Dent** had nine and seven kills, respectively.

**TCU** -- TCU was swept by Wyoming last Thursday night to end its regular season...The Horned Frogs will be the six-seed in the MWC Tournament and face No. 3 seed Colorado State in the opening match of the quarterfinals...Senior **Calli Corley** led the team defensively with 14 digs, while junior **LeMeita Smith** led the team with seven kills...Senior **Agi Nemeth** pitched in with four kills and three block assists.

**UNLV** -- UNLV defeated San Diego State to close out the regular season last week...The Rebels will be the No. 4 seed in this week's MWC Tournament and will face fifth-seeded Wyoming...UNLV is currently riding a three-match winning streak and has won 12 matches by a 3-0 margin this season, tying the 1998 squad for the most sweeps in a season...Junior **Lauren Miramontes** and senior **Michelle Banks** combined for 33 of the team's 49 kills vs. San Diego State, with Miramontes knocking down 18 and Banks with 15...Miramontes hit a match-high .516 with only two errors in 31 attempts...Banks hit .414 for the match.

## MOUNTAIN WEST CONFERENCE PLAYER OF THE WEEK ANDREA SEELE - WYOMING

Wyoming junior middle blocker Andrea Seele earned Mountain West Conference Volleyball Player of the Week accolades, marking her second career weekly honor.

Seele, from Johnstown, Colo., led the Cowgirls to a 2-0 conference record during the final week of the regular season, helping Wyoming clinch the fifth-seed in this week's MWC Volleyball Championship. Against TCU, she had eight kills on 15 attempts for a .476 hitting efficiency. She also collected four total blocks and one dig in the Cowgirls' three-game win. Seele followed that performance by tying her season-best hitting percentage of .500 vs. New Mexico, knocking down 13 kills on 20 swings with only three errors. She also tallied two total blocks, and one dig and service ace, as Wyoming swept New Mexico to secure the No. 5 seed in the MWC Tournament.

On the week, Seele averaged 3.50 kills, 1.00 blocks and 0.33 digs per game, while hitting .486 (21-4-35).
