CSTV TO TELEVISION ALL MATCHES OF 2004 MOUNTAIN WEST CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP All seven championship matches will be available to a national audience

COLORADO SPRINGS, Colo. - For the fifth straight year, the Mountain West Conference Volleyball Championship will be televised, with this season's tournament marking the first time ever that all seven championship matches will be made available to a national audience by College Sports Television (CSTV). The MWC will be the only conference to have all matches from its conference championship nationally televised. The 2004 MWC Volleyball Championship will be held Nov. 18-20 at Moby Arena on the campus of Colorado State University.

To supplement CSTV's national coverage, matches can be seen on over-the-air and cable affiliates throughout the Mountain West Conference region.

The Mountain West Conference Television Network will be the production entity for the 2004 MWC Volleyball Championship. The complete schedule, satellite coordinates and clearances are listed below. Check local listings for match coverage.

Bill Doleman will call the play-by-play and Amy Gant will be the color analyst. A native of Fairbury, Neb., Doleman is a veteran sportscaster whose career as a free-lance announcer has taken him from small-market public television to the national networks and several points in between. Named the Nebraska Sportscaster of the Year in 1998, Doleman has called games for ABC Sports, Fox Sports Net and the ESPN networks. A graduate of the University of Nebraska, Doleman was the play-by-play announcer for the 2002 State Farm NACWAA Volleyball Classic held in Minneapolis, as well as the 2002 and 2003 MWC Volleyball Championships.

Gant, a 1998 graduate of BYU, brings an extensive volleyball background to television. She was a three-time All-American for the Cougars and played for the U.S. National Team from January 1998 to September 1999. An NCAA Woman of the Year top 10 finalist in 1998, Gant was the color analyst for the 2000, 2001, 2002 and 2003 Mountain West Conference Volleyball Championships.
