**NCAA SELECTIONS NOVEMBER 28**

Following this week's competition, Mountain West Conference teams will await the at-large announcements to the 2004 NCAA Tournament. Colorado State earned the MWC automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament after winning the MWC Tournament last week. The selections are scheduled for Sunday, Nov. 28 at 6:40 p.m. ET on ESPNEWS.

In the first five years of the league's existence, four teams (BYU, Colorado State, San Diego State and Utah) have earned invitations to the NCAA Tournament with three advancing to the Sweet 16. BYU has made it to the NCAA's 21 of the past 23 years. Utah has six straight NCAA appearances, while CSU will make its 10th straight appearance this season. SDSU has made four appearances in the last 11 years. Overall, the MWC has an 18-15 record in NCAA Tournaments since the league was formed in 1999.

**ACADEMIC HONORS**

Three MWC volleyball student-athletes garnered CoSIDA Academic All-America District honors, including two first-team honors. New Mexico senior **Adah Burke** was a District VI first-team selection, while Wyoming senior **Amy Doman** earned first-team honors in District VII. New Mexico sophomore **Kelly Therkelsen** was a third team honoree in District VI. Burke and Doman will be forwarded to the national Academic All-America ballot.

**MWC IN NON-CONFERENCE PLAY**

The MWC has 48 wins over non-conference opponents, including victories over three ranked teams. So far this season, Colorado State has defeated then-No. 12 Georgia Tech and then-No. 18 Pepperdine, while Utah beat then-No. 6 UCLA. The Mountain West Conference has a five-year record of 392-289 (.576) vs. non-conference opponents.

**NATIONAL STATISTICS**

The Mountain West is represented in the national statistics by three of its eight institutions. Ninth-ranked Colorado State is currently eighth in the nation in assists per game (15.82), 11th in kills per game (17.15), 19th in blocks per game (3.04), 18th in hitting percentage (.278) and tied for 11th in win-loss percentage (.893). No. 19 Utah is 11th in blocks per game (3.24) and 26th in win-loss percentage (.821), while BYU is fifth in blocks per game (3.37) and 20th in hitting percentage (.275).

Individually, the MWC has four players ranked in the NCAA statistics. In the blocks per game category, BYU middle blocker **Lindsay Hartsock** currently ranks second at 1.83 per game, while Utah middle blocker **Lyndsey Henderson** is No. 7 on the list at 1.71 blocks per game. Hartsock also ranks 24th in hitting percentage (.387). Colorado State senior middle blocker **Katie Jo Shirley-Cahoon** ranks 22nd in hitting percentage with a .387 efficiency, while teammate **Melissa Courtney** is 13th in assists per game (13.60).

**ANGERFIELD AND EVANS DIG A NEW RECORD**

Utah sophomore **Connie Dangerfield** and BYU freshman **Lindsey Evans** set the MWC all-time single-match record for digs with 33. Dangerfield set the record against then-No. 6 UCLA on Sept. 17, while Evans set her mark on Nov. 5 vs. UNLV. Their mark broke Adrienne Bradley-Drake's (Utah) record of 31 set on Sept. 9, 2000. Dangerfield was one shy of the Utes' all-time record of 34 digs set by Brenda Barton-Whicker in 1997, while Evans was two digs shy of the Cougar all-time mark set by Socorro Leal in 1984.

**200 WIN CLUB**

Colorado State head coach **Tom Hilbert** captured his 200th victory at CSU with a win over Ohio on Sept. 16. Hilbert and Utah head coach **Beth Launiere** are the only two active MWC coaches to reach 200 wins at their respective school. Launiere has 299 wins in 15 seasons as the Ute coach, while Hilbert has 219 in eight seasons.

## Quick Hits

**AIR FORCE** -- The Falcons fell to 0-6 in MWC Tournament play with their loss to top-seeded Utah. As a team, AFA had a .030 hitting percentage vs. the Utes, marking the sixth time in 10 matches and the ninth time overall on the season that Air Force hit under .100.

**BYU** -- BYU's 3-0 win over San Diego State in the quarterfinals of the MWC Tournament was its 11th sweep of the season. Several Cougars achieved milestones in the MWC tournament. Freshman **Erica Lott** recorded her 300th career kill, sophomore **Lindsay Hartsock** posted her 400th career kill and 300th career block, junior **Kim Wilson** notched her 300th kill for the season and senior **April Varner** picked up her 500th career dig. With 44 assists in the match, All-MWC setter **Lauren Richards** reached 2,711 career assists, moving her into sixth place all-time at BYU.

**COLORADO STATE** -- Senior **Melissa Courtney** led the Rams to the MWC Tournament title last week, averaging 13.30 assists, 1.70 kills and 2.20 digs per game. She tallied a .660 hitting percentage for the tournament and had zero hitting errors. She was named Tournament MVP, as well as AVCA National Player of the Week for her performance. CSU became the first host team to win an MWC Tournament. The Rams also became the second straight team to repeat as MWC Tournament champions (Utah won in 2001 and 2002).

**NEW MEXICO** -- Sophomore **Kelly Therckelsen** led the Lobos with a .429 hitting percentage in their opening round loss to Colorado State at the MWC Tournament. As a team the UNM hit .093, which marked the second time in three matches that the Lobos hit under .100 vs. the Rams. Junior **Chelsea Sondrup** recorded three blocks in the match, giving her 313 for her career, which ties **Robyn Wentworth** for third best on the all-time charts at UNM. Senior **Monica Meihack** dished out 24 assists in her final match as a Lobo. She closed out her career sixth all-time in the school record books with 2,840 assists.

**SAN DIEGO STATE** - The Aztecs lost in the first round of MWC Tournament play for the first time since 2001. Junior **Melissa Stapley** collected 13 kills in the three-game loss to BYU, while senior **Kara Moriarity** had a team-best 13 digs. As a team, SDSU had 53 digs in three games for an average of 17.67 per game.

**UNLV** -- The Rebels tallied a MWC Tournament record 96 digs in their 3-2 semifinal round loss to Utah. Senior **Nicki King** tallied 54 assists, 15 digs and eight kills in the loss to Utah. As a team, UNLV averaged a tournament-best 18.56 digs per game. Individually, freshman libero **Jada Walker** had a tournament-high 43 digs in nine games played (4.78 per game average) on her way to being named all-tournament libero. She was also awarded the first-ever MWC Sportsmanship Award at the conclusion of tournament play.

**UTAH** -- The Utes scooped up an MWC Tournament record 96 digs in the five-game win over UNLV in the MWC semifinals. Senior **Kelsie Kartchner** turned in her 10th double-double of the season against UNLV. She also led the team with 33 assists and a career-high 24 digs. The 24 digs was one shy of the MWC Tournament single-match mark. Junior **Shelly Sommerfeldt** led Utah with 3.18 kills and 1.91 digs per game while hitting .222 for the tournament. She currently averages 3.02 kills and 1.71 digs per game for the season, while hitting at a .206 clip.

**WYOMING** -- Freshman libero **Michelle Weydert** recorded a career-high 17 digs in the quarterfinal loss to UNLV at the MWC Tournament. Senior **Amy Doman** recorded 56 assists during the final weekend of the regular season, taking over first-place all-time at Wyoming. She ended her Cowgirl career with 4,832 after collecting 41 against the Rebels in the MWC Tournament. She also finished her career tied for 10th place in service aces with 92. Senior **Sara Maytorena** finished her career fourth place all-time at UW in career service aces (110). She also finished at 1,304 career kills (fourth all-time) and ninth in digs (865).

## MWC ON TELEVISION



In conjunction with the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA), College Sports Television (CSTV) will highlight the nation's top women's programs during its fall lineup, including the MWC. Colorado State will appear on CSTV twice this season, while Utah has one appearance. The Nov. 13 match between Utah and Colorado State will appear on CSTV via tape delay on Sunday, Nov. 14 at 2:30



p.m. MT. The Rams also visit Nebraska Nov. 7 for a live telecast at 4 p.m. MT (check local listings for additional match coverage).

The MWC Championship will be televised for the fifth straight year in 2004. This year marks the first time ever that all seven championship matches will be available to a national audience. The MWC is the only conference to have all matches from its conference championship nationally televised.

Quarterfinal matches are scheduled for Thursday, Nov. 18 at 11 a.m., 1:30 p.m., 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. (MT). Semifinal matches will take place Friday, Nov. 19 at 1 p.m. and 3:30 p.m. (MT) and the championship will take place at 3 p.m. MT on Saturday, Nov. 20. The afternoon quarterfinals, the semifinals and championship will appear live on CSTV, while the evening quarterfinals will air tape delayed.

**MOUNTAIN WEST CONFERENCE  
PLAYER OF THE WEEK  
MELISSA COURTNEY**

Colorado State senior setter Melissa Courtney earned Mountain West Conference Volleyball Player of the Week, marking her second honor of the season and her career.

Courtney, a Lakewood, Calif., product, led the No. 2 seed Rams to the Mountain West Conference Championship last week, and was named Tournament MVP, beating New Mexico, BYU and 19th-ranked Utah. She recorded a season-high six kills in nine attempts (.667 efficiency), with a team-high 39 assists vs. the Lobos in the quarterfinal round of tournament play, followed by posting 57 assists and putting down six more kills against BYU in the semifinals. In the championship vs. Utah, Courtney recorded 37 assists, along with five digs and five kills for a .714 hitting percentage.

For the tournament, Courtney averaged 13.30 assists, 1.70 kills, 2.20 digs and 0.30 blocks and blocks per game, while hitting a combined .660 (17-0-26) in the three matches.

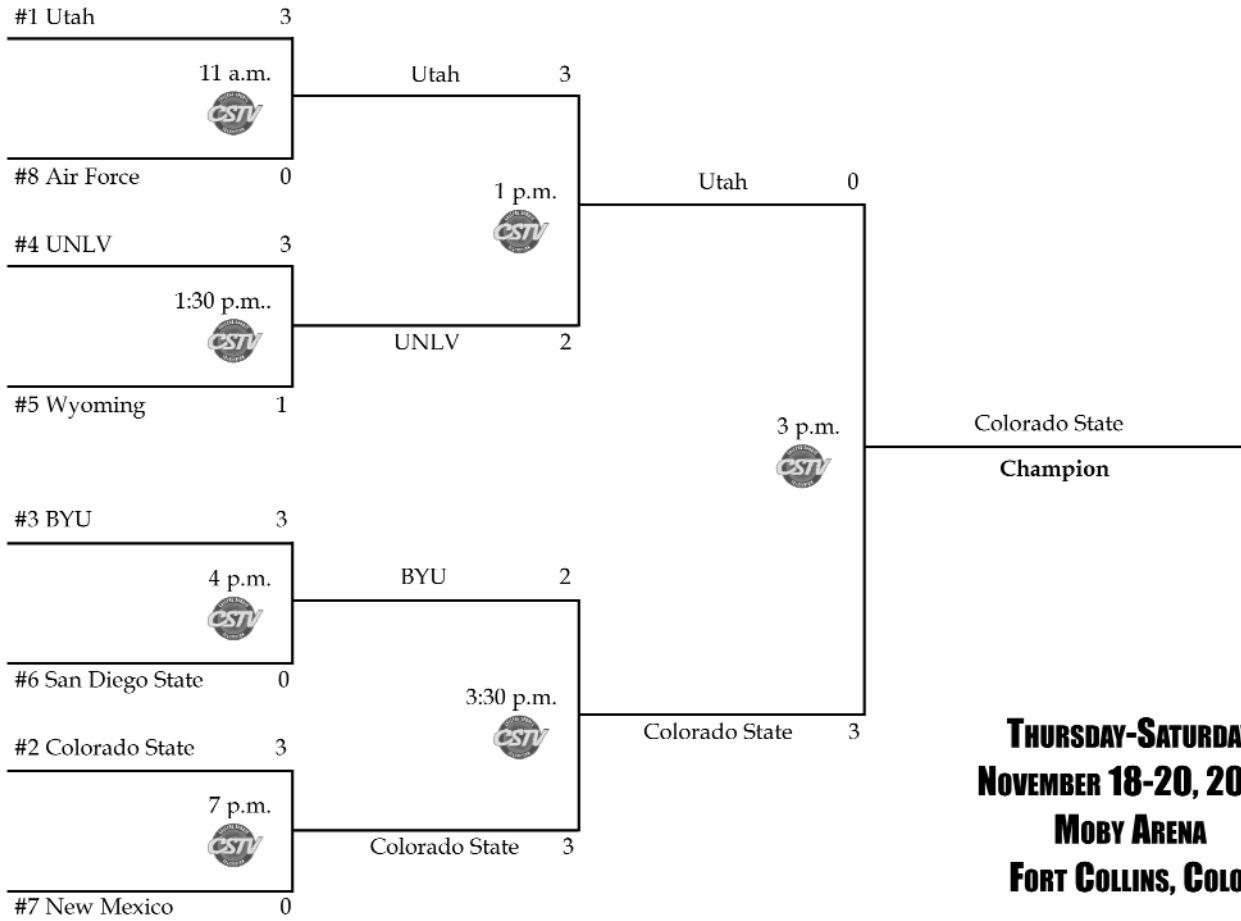
