MWC's Top Two Teams To Battle On CSTV: AVCA Match of the Week; 15th-Ranked BYU Maintains Conference Lead

MWC Volleyball will be featured on the CSTV: AVCA Match of the Week for the second time in three weeks as first-place and No. 15 BYU (15-0, 8-0 MWC) and second-place UNLV's (9-9, 5-1 MWC) Saturday night match at Smith Fieldhouse in Provo, Utah, will be shown via tape delay on Sunday at 4 p.m. MT.

The 15th-ranked Cougars (15-0, 8-0 MWC) maintain the lead in the MWC race, with the Rebels (9-9, 5-1 MWC) in second place, Colorado State (11-4, 4-1 MWC) trailing close behind in third place and San Diego State (12-7, 4-2 MWC) in fourth.

The conference slate kicks off on Thursday with New Mexico hosting Wyoming. Friday's matches will see San Diego State at BYU, UNLV at Utah and Colorado State at Air Force. The Rebels at Cougars, Aztecs at Utes, Rams at Lobos and Cowgirls at Falcons concludes the week's league matches on Saturday.

Air Force, BYU and TCU will see non-conference action this week, highlighted by the Horned Frogs at the Texas-Pan American Tournament in Edinburg, Texas, on Saturday.

MATCHES TO WATCH THIS WEEK:

Oct. 21 (Friday)

UNLV at Utah, 7 p.m. MT

Series: Utah leads 18-1.

The Rebels and Utes will meet for the first time since their five-game battle in the semifinals of the 2004 MWC Tournament. UNLV is looking for its first win over Utah since both schools were members of the WAC (Nov. 28, 1998).

San Diego State at No. 15 BYU, 7 p.m. MT

Series: BYU leads 30-15.

First meeting of the 2005 season between SDSU and BYU. Since the Aztecs swept the season series from the Cougars in 2002, BYU has reeled off five straight wins.

Oct. 22 (Saturday)

UNLV at No. 15 BYU, 7 p.m. MT

Series: BYU leads 15-2.

The league-leading Cougars and second-place Rebels battle for a share of the MWC lead. UNLV is looking for its first victory over BYU in six matches (last Rebel victory was a four-game win on Oct. 25, 2002).

BYU ONE OF FOUR ACTIVE UNDEFEATED TEAMS IN THE NATION

BYU is one of only four active undefeated teams in the nation as of Tuesday, Oct. 18. The 15th-ranked Cougars (15-0 overall, 8-0 MWC) join No. 1 Nebraska, No. 2 Washington, No. 6 Louisville and New Orleans* as the only teams yet to lose a match on the season. Included in the Cougars 15 wins on the season is a 3-2 upset victory over No. 14 Ohio State in Columbus, Ohio, on Sept. 17. BYU also has wins over Kansas and Nevada, Reno, which were both ranked higher than BYU in the top-25 poll at the time.

**The University of New Orleans is 4-0 on the season. Due to Hurricane Katrina, the remainder of the Privateers schedule has been cancelled.*

MWC IN THE NCAA STATISTICS

The MWC is represented in the national statistics by four of its nine institutions. Colorado State is currently third in blocks per game (3.81), 20th in assists per game (15.09) and 28th in kills per game (16.20). No. 15 BYU is tied for first in win-loss percentage (1.000) and 13th in hitting percentage (.287), while Utah is 11th in blocks per game (3.29) and TCU is ranked ninth in service aces per game (2.34).

Individually, BYU's Lindsay Hartssock leads the nation in hitting percentage (.475), Colorado State's Dre Downs is 8th in blocks per game (1.70) and BYU's Lauren Richards is 27th in assists per game (12.84).

SAN DIEGO STATE'S CORDEIRO AND WYOMING DIG NEW RECORDS

San Diego State sophomore Aime Cordeiro set a new MWC all-time single-match record with 35 digs vs. UNLV on Friday, Oct. 7, surpassing Wyoming freshman Carissa Lee's record of 34 digs set earlier this season on Sept. 3 vs. Northern Colorado. Wyoming set the MWC all-time single-match record for digs with 106 vs. Northern Colorado on Saturday, Sept. 3. The Cowgirls' mark broke BYU's record of 102, set on Nov. 23, 2001 vs. Cal Poly.

MWC ON TELEVISION



In conjunction with the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA), College Sports Television (CSTV) will highlight the nation's top women's programs during its fall lineup, including the MWC. BYU, Colorado State, UNLV and Utah will appear on CSTV during the regular season, and seven MWC Championship matches will be shown nationwide.



The Oct. 9 Utah at Colorado State match will be broadcast live at 4 p.m. MT, while the Oct. 22 match between BYU and UNLV will appear on CSTV via tape delay on Sunday, Oct. 23 at 4 p.m. MT. The 2005 MWC Volleyball Championship will take place in Las Vegas, Nev., Nov. 22-26.

A new era begins in the fall of 2006 as CSTV becomes the official television partner for the Conference. The MWC-CSTV agreement incorporates all Conference-related media and marketing rights, including all television, national over-the-air and satellite radio, video-on-demand, and online and broadband rights. The multi-media partnership also includes Mountain West TV, the first-ever regional sports network dedicated solely to an intercollegiate athletic conference.

Quick Hits

AIR FORCE -- Air Force posted an 0-2 record in conference play last week, losing to then-No. 16 BYU in three games and Utah in four games...The Falcons are 0-8 in conference play this season and have lost 22 consecutive league matches overall...Air Force tallied just two kills (10 errors) on 28 attempts in the third game vs. BYU for their lowest attacking percentage of the year (-.009)...With 184 kills this season, senior **Rebecca Gallegos** has surpassed her kill total (178) from the previous two years of her career, combined...Senior **Kristin Hamlett** has 1,054 career kills, 38 shy of cracking the all-time Air Force career kills list...Senior **Carly Siefken** moved into fourth on the AFA Division I single-season assists list with 812, surpassing her previous single-season best of 805 from last year.

BYU -- BYU went 2-0 in MWC play last week, sweeping Air Force and New Mexico...The Cougars have swept their last five matches...The Cougars are now 15-0, which ties their best start to a season since 1977 when they started the season with 23 straight wins...BYU is one of four active remaining undefeated teams in the nation...The Cougars are ranked 15th in the current CSTV/AVCA Top-25 Poll, their highest ranking since being ranked 13th the week of Oct. 15, 2001...Junior **Lindsay Hartsock** is currently leading the nation in hitting percentage (.475) and has recorded efficiencies of .500 or better in eight matches on the year, including a season-best .800 percentage vs. TCU on Sept. 30...Sophomore **Erica Lott** has recorded double-digit kills in every match this season...Senior Lauren Evans leads the MWC and is 27th in the nation with 12.84 assists per game.

COLORADO STATE -- CSU swept Texas Tech in their only action of the week...With her last kill of the match, senior **Tess Rogers** moved into fourth place on all-time MWC career kills chart with 1,381...Rogers is 45 kills short of passing former Ram teammate **Courtney Cox** for third place on the list...In conference-only matches, Rogers is the only active player ranked in the top 10, ranking fifth with 577 kills...Against the Red Raiders, CSU did not allow a service ace in a match for the first time since Nov. 20, 2004, while recording a season-high nine in the process...Senior **Dre Downs** recorded her 1,000th career kill vs. the Red Raiders, becoming the 17th player in school history to accomplish the feat...Downs is the third MWC player this season and the 17th player overall in league history to surpass the grand mark...Colorado State is averaging 4.45 blocks per game in conference play, which is on pace to break the all-time record of 4.12 held by the 1999 BYU team.

NEW MEXICO -- New Mexico went 0-2 in MWC play last week, losing to Utah and then-No. 16 BYU...Senior **Chelsea Sondrup** recorded six block assists last weekend, breaking into the all-time Lobo top-10 and currently sitting in eighth place with 210...She needs just four blocks to take over seventh place...Freshman **Sarah Kwasigroch** has dished out 819 assists so far this season (11.07 per game average) and is on pace to accumulate 1,150 on the season which would place fourth on the all-time UNM single-season list...The Lobos are currently 11-7 on the season and, with nine games left on the schedule, need just three more wins to assure them their first winning season since 1996.

SAN DIEGO STATE -- The Aztecs went 1-1 last week, losing to then-15th ranked San Diego and beating TCU...Senior **Lindsey Noll** notched a career-high 12 total blocks vs. the Toreros...Her four solo blocks vs. USD were a career high as well...She followed with her first career double-double vs. the Horned Frogs, tallying 11 kills and tying her career high with 12 total blocks...Sophomore **Aime Cordeiro** leads the MWC in digs with an average of 4.77 per game...In MWC play, Cordeiro averages 4.67 digs per game which also ranks first.

TCU -- TCU went 1-2 in conference play last week, sweeping Wyoming and losing to UNLV and San Diego State in three and four games, respectively...With 107 assists last week, freshman **Nirelle Hampton** currently sits at 806 for her career which is fifth place all-time in the TCU record books...She needs 28 assists to move into fourth place all-time...Junior **Anna Vaughn** currently leads the MWC in service aces per game (0.49), is third in the MWC in kills per game (3.89) and fifth in hitting percentage (.312).

UNLV -- UNLV went 1-1 last week, sweeping TCU at home and losing to in-state rival Nevada, Reno, in five games...The loss to the Wolfpack ended a four-match winning streak...UNLV out hit the Horned Frogs .208-.152...Junior **Lauren Miramontes** led the Rebels with 15 kills and a .324 hitting percentage vs. TCU, while freshman **Melody Nua** had 40 of UNLV's 43 assists...Nua currently has a team-best 826 assists (11.63 per game), which ranks second in the MWC...Sophomore **Jada Walker** collected 39 digs vs. the Aztecs, giving her 715 for her career and moving her into fourth place on the all-time UNLV digs charts.

UTAH -- Utah went 2-0 in conference play last week, defeating New Mexico and Air Force in four games...Freshman **Airial Salvo** led the Utes with a hitting percentage of .371 (27-4-62), while netting 3.86 kills per game...The Utes recorded their best hitting weekend of the conference season last week, recording a .302 efficiency (.274 vs. New Mexico and .333 vs. Air Force)...Utah's top two hitting performances this season have come vs. the Falcons...In their first meeting of the season, the Utes hit .374 vs. AFA...Sophomore **Emillie Toone** has recorded six or more blocks in four of the last five matches, including 12 vs. Colorado State and seven vs. TCU...She is averaging 1.79 blocks per game during this span and currently ranks second in the MWC in blocks per game (1.40).

WYOMING -- Wyoming went 0-3 last week, including a conference loss to TCU...Sophomore **Rachel Smith** tallied a career-high 27 kills, along with 16 digs vs. Utah Valley State last Friday and followed with another double-double (12 kills, 10 digs) vs. Texas Tech on Sunday...Freshman **Carissa Lee** had one double digit-digs match last weekend and has now collected double-digit digs in 13 of 17 matches this season...Lee is currently fifth in the MWC in digs per game (3.54)...Freshmen **Samantha Eley** ranks second in the league in service aces per game (0.48).

MOUNTAIN WEST CONFERENCE PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

LINDSEY NOLL - SAN DIEGO STATE

San Diego State middle blocker Lindsey Noll earned Mountain West Conference Volleyball Player of the Week, marking her first career award.

Noll, a senior from St. Louis, Mo., helped the Aztecs to a 1-1 record last week, losing to No. 15 San Diego in five games and defeating TCU in four. Against the 15th-ranked Toreros, she notched a career-high 12 total blocks to go along with seven kills, three digs and a service ace. Her four solo blocks vs. USD were a career-high as well and is currently tied for the second most solo blocks by an MWC player this season (TCU's Anna Vaughn had a conference season-best five solo blocks vs. New Mexico on Oct. 8). Noll followed with her first career double-double vs. the Horned Frogs, tallying 11 kills and tying her career high with 12 total blocks (1 solo and a career-best 11 assists). She also had three digs, an assist and a service ace, while hitting .391 vs. TCU.

On the week, Noll averaged two kills per game on .341 hitting, 2.67 blocks, 0.67 digs, 0.22 service aces and 0.11 assists per game. She is currently second in the MWC in hitting percentage (.335) and third in blocks per game (1.38).
