UTAH MAINTAINS MWC LEAD

No. 17 Utah defeated BYU last weekend in Salt Lake City to move its league record to 8-0, its best conference start in school history. The Utes, currently riding a 13-match conference winning streak, welcome New Mexico and Air Force to Crimson Court this week as part of the eight-match conference slate. Friday's matches pit Air Force at BYU, San Diego State at No. 9 Colorado State and UNLV at Wyoming, while Saturday's action will see the Rebels at the ninth-ranked Rams, UNM at BYU and the Cowgirls hosting SDSU.

BYU and Colorado State start the week off in non-conference action on Tuesday.

MWC IN NON-CONFERENCE PLAY

The MWC has 46 wins over non-conference opponents, including victories over three ranked teams. So far this season, Colorado State has defeated then-No. 12 Georgia Tech and then-No. 18 Pepperdine, while Utah beat then-No. 6 UCLA. The Mountain West Conference has a five-year record of 390-287 (.576) vs. non-conference opponents.

MWC IN THE NATIONAL STATISTICS

The Mountain West is represented in the national statistics by four of its eight institutions. Ninth-ranked Colorado State is currently fifth in the nation in assists per game (16.08), eighth in kills per game (17.40), 10th in hitting percentage (.292), 16th in win-loss percentage (.889) and 26th in blocks per game (2.92). No. 17 Utah is 10th in blocks per game (3.33) and 19th in win-loss percentage (.842), while BYU is 11th in blocks per game (3.24) and 22nd in hitting percentage (.272). Wyoming also ranks in the top-30 in hitting percentage with an efficiency of .264 (26th).

Individually, the MWC has five players ranked in the NCAA Statistics. In the blocks per game category, BYU middle blocker Lindsay Hartsock currently ranks second at 1.85 per game, while Utah senior middle blocker Lyndsey Henderson is No. 6 on the list at 1.78 blocks per game. Hartsock also ranks fourth in hitting percentage (.416). Colorado State senior middle blocker Katie Jo Shirley-Cahoon ranks in the 26th in hitting percentage with a .385 efficiency, while teammate Melissa Courtney and Wyoming senior Amy Doman are seventh and 23rd in assists per game, respectively. Courtney averages 13.92 assists per set, while Doman has a 13.15 per game average.

ANGERFIELD DIGS A NEW RECORD

Utah sophomore Connie Dangerfield set the MWC all-time single-match record for digs with 33 vs. No. 6 UCLA on Friday, Sept. 17. Her mark broke Adrienne Bradley-Drake's (Utah) record of 31 set on Sept. 9, 2000. Dangerfield was one shy of the Utes' all-time record of 34 digs set by Brenda Barton-Whicker in 1997.

200 Win Club

Colorado State head coach **Tom Hilbert** captured his 200th victory at CSU with a win over Ohio on Sept. 16. Hilbert and Utah head coach **Beth Launiere** are the only two active MWC coaches to reach 200 wins at their respective school. Launiere has 291 wins in 15 seasons as the Ute coach, while Hilbert has 210 in eight seasons.

Quick Hits

AIR FORCE -- AFA's 30-28 victory in the third game of the match against Colorado State snapped the Rams' 36-game win streak over the Falcons -- a span of 12 matches. The only other time Air Force won a game from CSU was in 1999. With two solo blocks last weekend, freshman **Brooke Akers** moved into ninth-place in the Academy's Division I record book for solo blocks in a season with 13.

BYU -- With their five-game victory over Notre Dame last week in the Smith Fieldhouse, the Cougars currently hold the league's best overall home winning percentage mark at .837 (380-74). Sophomore **Lindsay Hartssock** put up 19 blocks in two matches last week, including tying a career-high with 12 against the Fighting Irish. She now averages 1.85 blocks per game on the season which ranks No. 2 in the nation. As a team BYU leads the MWC in blocks per game in conference matches (3.54). Individually, Hartssock leads the league in hitting percentage (.416) and blocks per game, while junior **Lauren Richards'** 0.53 service aces per game is tops in the MWC.

COLORADO STATE -- Junior **Tess Rogers** recorded her 1,000th career kill against Air Force on Saturday. She currently has 1,016 career kills, which ranks 13th on the school career charts. Senior **Melissa Courtney** also made history against the Falcons, recording her 4,000th career assist. She now stands at 4,023 assists for her career which is fourth on the MWC career list. CSU has won its last 43 matches against unranked opponents, with its last loss coming to Washington in the 2002 NCAA Tournament. Colorado State has been ranked in the top-10 nationally for six of the first eight weeks this season. The school record for most weeks in the top-10 in one year is 15, set by the 2000 team.

NEW MEXICO -- The Lobos are currently third in the MWC with 3.11 blocks per game in conference matches. Their 22.5 team blocks against No. 17 Utah on Oct. 2 stands as the most by a MWC team this season. Junior Chelsea Sondrup, the UNM all-time leader in block assists with 274, is currently seventh on the school charts in total blocks with 290. She is 36 blocks behind **Linda Archuleta's** school record of 326. Sondrup is tied for fourth in MWC matches in blocks with 1.39 per game. Junior **Nicole Ryan** leads the Lobos and is ninth in the Mountain West with 3.27 kills per game. In conference matches, she is seventh with 3.39 kills per game.

SAN DIEGO STATE - Freshman **Aime Cordiero** is currently second in the MWC in digs per game in league play (4.36). Since returning to the lineup on Sept. 21 from an abdominal injury, senior **Kara Moriarty** is averaging 3.56 kills per game and two digs per game. Moriarty is the lone returning Aztec starter from the 2003 season.

UNLV -- UNLV hit a season-high .422 as a team in a 3-0 win over San Diego State on Friday. Freshman **Maria Aladjova** knocked down 18 kills against the Aztecs, marking her ninth straight match and 17th match overall on the season that she has had double figure kills. UNLV has won three straight MWC matches for just the third time since joining the MWC. The Rebels have also swept three straight conference opponents for the first time since joining the league.

UTAH -- The 17th-ranked Utes' school record winning streak of 12 matches came to an end with a 3-0 loss to Notre Dame last week. Utah is still riding a 13-match conference win streak. Senior **Liana Bortoto** led the Ute attack last week, turning a team-best 10 kills against the Fighting Irish and a career-high 19 kills against BYU. Her 4.83 kills and 3.5 digs per game average on the week bettered her season averages of 2.67 and 1.89, respectively. Senior Lyndsey Henderson currently ranks sixth in the nation in blocks per game (1.76).

WYOMING -- Senior **Amy Doman** recorded 100 assists last weekend, moving her to 4,591 for her career. She needs just 176 more assists to take over first-place all-time at Wyoming. Senior **Jill Roslund** tied her career-high of 21 digs for the second time this season against Air Force on Saturday. She has recorded double-digits in digs five straight matches and currently leads the team with a 3.52 per game average. Senior Sara Maytorena moved into fourth place all-time in the Wyoming record book in career service aces with 104. She also currently has 1,281 career kills which is fifth all-time. The Cowgirls' road wins over New Mexico and Air Force last week was the first time that Wyoming has swept a road trip in MWC play since the 2001 season.

MWC ON TELEVISION



In conjunction with the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA), College Sports Television (CSTV) will highlight the nation's top women's programs during its fall lineup, including the MWC. Colorado State will appear on CSTV twice this season, while Utah has one appearance. The Nov. 13 match between Utah and Colorado State will appear on CSTV via tape delay on Sunday, Nov. 14 at 2:30



p.m. MT. The Rams also visit Nebraska Nov. 7 for a live telecast at 4 p.m. MT (check local listings for additional match coverage).

The MWC Championship will be televised for the fifth straight year in 2004. This year marks the first time ever that all seven championship matches will be available to a national audience. The MWC is the only conference to have all matches from its conference championship nationally televised.

Quarterfinal matches are scheduled for Thursday, Nov. 18 at 11 a.m., 1:30 p.m., 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. (MT). Semifinal matches will take place Friday, Nov. 19 at 1 p.m. and 3:30 p.m. (MT) and the championship will take place at 3 p.m. MT on Saturday, Nov. 20. The afternoon quarterfinals, the semifinals and championship will appear live on CSTV, while the evening quarterfinals will air tape delayed.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK
NICKI KING - UNLV**

UNLV senior setter Nicki King earned Mountain West Conference Volleyball Player of the Week, marking her first career weekly honor.

King, a Phoenix, Ariz., native, led the Rebels to a conference win over San Diego State last week. In the three game sweep of the Aztecs, she tallied 48 assists, nine digs and four kills in six attacks (.667 hitting efficiency). King averaged 16 assists a game, helping UNLV to a .422 hitting percentage for the match, marking the first time this season the Rebels hit over .400. She also had an average of three digs, 1.33 kills and .667 blocks per game as UNLV won its third straight MWC match for the first time since the 2002 season.
