## Two Titles Propel @GoPSUsports in Winter Division I #LSDC Standings; @theACC with four Institutions in the Top 10

**CLEVELAND** – Stanford builds its lead in the Division I Learfield Sports Directors' Cup winter standings. The Cardinal finished second in women's swimming & diving, third in women's basketball, ninth in fencing, men's basketball and men's swimming & diving and 40<sup>th</sup> in wrestling. They now have 997.75 total points.

**Penn State** now occupies the second spot with 792 points after winning national championships in both fencing and wrestling. Penn State also placed ninth in women's basketball, 17<sup>th</sup> in men's swimming & diving and 18<sup>th</sup> in women's swimming & diving.

**Wisconsin** cracks the top five and is in third place with 680 points. The Badgers reached the Final Four in men's basketball, placed fifth in women's ice hockey, 13<sup>th</sup> in women's swimming & diving, 16<sup>th</sup> in wrestling and 33<sup>rd</sup> in men's swimming & diving.

With 673.25 points, in fourth place, is **Notre Dame**. The Fighting Irish finished second in women's basketball, sixth in fencing, 16<sup>th</sup> in women's swimming & diving and 30<sup>th</sup> in men's swimming & diving.

Rounding out the top five is **North Carolina** with 650 points. UNC finished fifth in women's basketball, 17<sup>th</sup> in men's basketball, 19<sup>th</sup> in both fencing and women's swimming & diving, 25<sup>th</sup> in wrestling and 38<sup>th</sup> in men's swimming & diving.

The **ACC** leads Division conferences with four institutions ranked in the top 10. Notre Dame is fourth, North Carolina is fifth, Duke is seventh and Florida State is eighth.

Eleven winter Division I championships have been completed with the following institutions capturing titles: *women's basketball* – **Connecticut**; *men's basketball* – **Connecticut**; *fencing* – **Penn State**; *women's ice hockey* – **Clarkson** (DIII); *women's swimming & diving* – **Georgia**; *men's swimming & diving* – **California**; *rifle* – **West Virginia**; *skiing* – **Denver**; *women's indoor track & field* – **Oregon**; *men's indoor track & field* – **Oregon**; *wrestling* – **Penn State**.

The Learfield Sports Directors' Cup was developed as a joint effort between the National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics (NACDA) and *USA Today*. Points are awarded based on each institution's finish in up to 20 sports -- ten women's and ten men's.

The next Division I winter standings will be released Thursday, April 17, 2014.
